Lesson #126: “At Capernaum”, Part 6

Malachi 4:2 (KJV)

But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

*This week boys and girls, we end with part 6 in our lesson entitle, “At Capernaum”
of our study book Desire of Ages!*

Isaiah 42:2 (KJV)

He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #26, page 260 - 261

In the excitement which then pervaded Capernaum, there was danger that the object of His mission would be lost sight of. Jesus was not satisfied to attract attention to Himself merely as a wonder worker or a healer of physical diseases. He was seeking to draw men to Him as their Saviour. While the people were eager to believe that He had come as a king, to establish an earthly reign, He desired to turn their minds away from the earthly to the spiritual. Mere worldly success would interfere with His work. {DA 260.2}

Question: What danger to Christ's mission did the excitement among the people of Capernaum cause, as they regarded Christ's power as healer of their diseases? And, what was His mission for men?

Answer: His mission would be lost sight of He was not satisfied to attract attention to Himself. And, He was seeking to draw men to Him as their Saviour; He desired to turn their minds away from the earthly to the spiritual

And the wonder of the careless crowd jarred upon His spirit. In His life no self-assertion mingled. The homage which the world gives to position, or wealth, or talent, was foreign to the Son of man. None of the means that men employ to win allegiance or command homage did Jesus use. Centuries before His birth, it had been prophesied of Him, "He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed shall He not break, and the dimly burning flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth judgment unto truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till He have set judgment in the earth." **Isaiah 42:2-4**, margin. {DA 260.3}

Question: What did not mingle in Jesus' life? And, what had been prophesied of Him Centuries before His birth that confirms that?

Answer: The spirit of self-assertion. And, "He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed shall He not break, and the dimly burning flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth judgment unto truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till He have set judgment in the earth."

Song: *Let's learn beautiful song dear ones, from the book of Isaiah about these truths!*

The Pharisees sought distinction by their scrupulous ceremonialism, and the ostentation of their worship and charities. They proved their zeal for religion by making it the theme of discussion. Disputes between opposing sects were loud and long, and it was not unusual to hear on the streets the voice of angry controversy from learned doctors of the law. {DA 261.1}

Question: In what ways did the Pharisees seek their distinction? And, how did they prove their zeal for religion?

Answer: Their scrupulous ceremonialism, and the ostentation of their worship and charities. And, making it the theme of discussion Disputes between opposing sects were loud and long, and it was not unusual to hear on the streets the voice of angry controversy.

In marked contrast to all this was the life of Jesus. In that life no noisy disputation, no ostentatious worship, no act to gain applause, was ever witnessed. Christ was hid in God, and God was revealed in the character of His Son. To this revelation Jesus desired the minds of the people to be directed, and their homage to be given. {DA 261.2}

Question: How was the life of Jesus in marked contrast to that of the Pharisees? And, where was His life hid so that Who could revealed?

Answer: In that life no noisy disputation, no ostentatious worship, no act to gain applause, was ever witnessed. And, Christ was hid in God, and God was revealed in the character

So did the Sun of Righteousness arise, "with healing in His wings." **Malachi 4:2. {DA 261.3}**

Question: What is written of Christ as the Sun of Righteousness? And, what did the Sun of Righteousness arise with?

Answer: “His going forth is prepared as the morning.” **Hosea 6:3.** Quietly and gently the daylight breaks upon the earth, dispelling the shadow of darkness, and waking the world to life. And, with healing in His wings.

2. Applied to God, the perfection or holiness of his nature; exact rectitude; faithfulness.

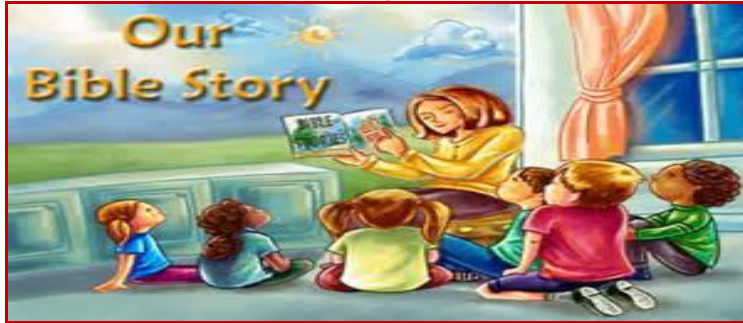
3. The active and passive obedience of Christ, by which the law of God is fulfilled. **Daniel 9:7.**

The Word of life is given to us to study and practice. Our actions are to be in strict **conformity** to the laws of the kingdom of heaven. Then heaven can approve our work; and the talents we employ in His service will multiply for greater usefulness. The consecrated life will shine amid the **moral** darkness of the world, guiding perishing souls to the truth of the Word. . . . {SD 42.4}

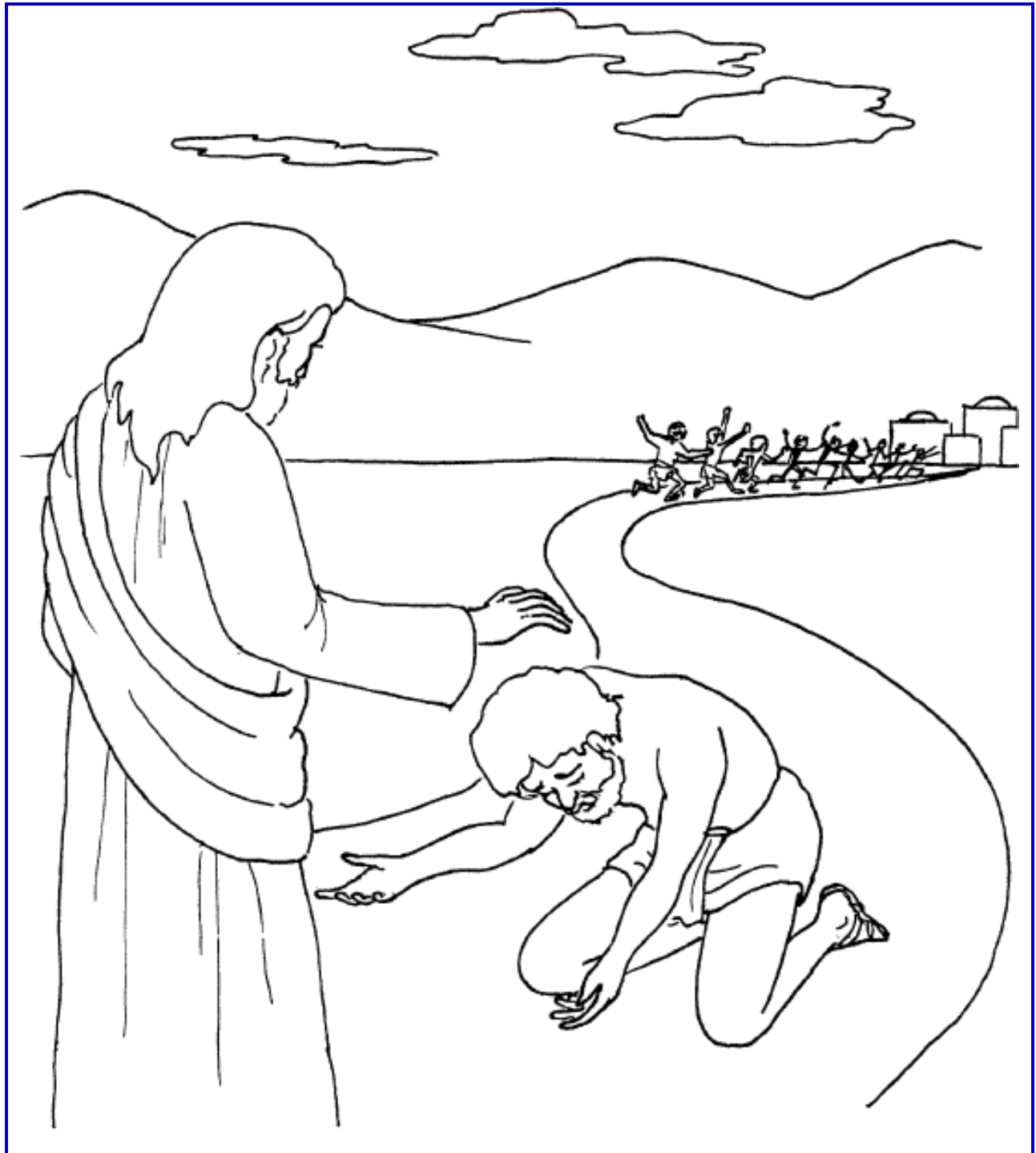

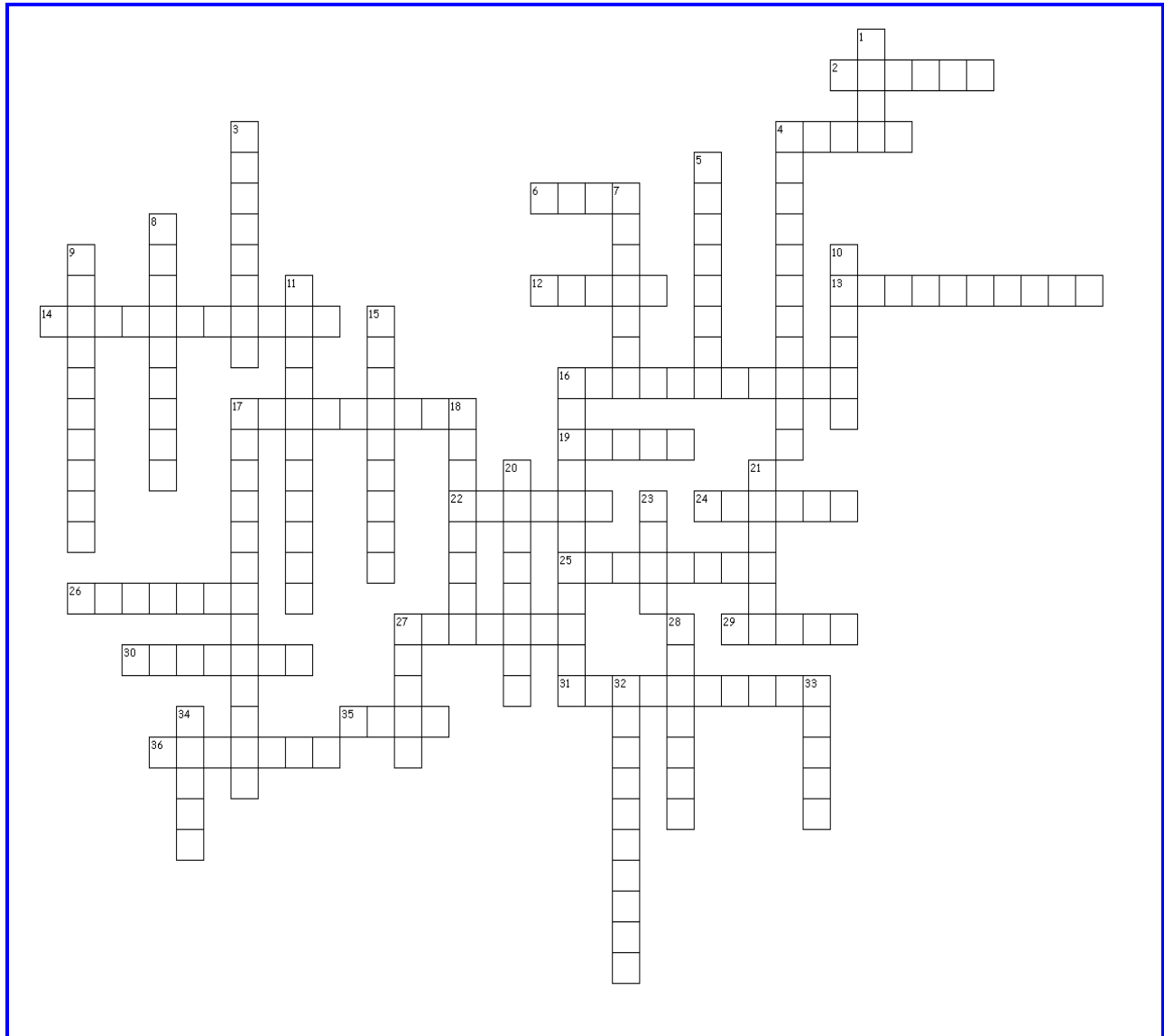
