**Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #28, page 280**

It was this that proved the ruin of the Jews, and it will prove the ruin of many souls in our own day. Thousands are making the same mistake as did the Pharisees whom Christ reproved at Matthew's feast. Rather than give up some cherished idea, or discard some idol of opinion, many refuse the truth which comes down from the Father of light. They trust in self, and depend upon their own wisdom, and do not realize their spiritual poverty. They insist on being saved in some way by which they may perform some important work. When they see that there is no way of weaving self into the work, they reject the salvation provided. {DA 280.1}

**Question:** What did proved the ruin of the Jews as will prove the ruin of many souls in our own day? And, what led the Pharisees to reject the salvation provided?

**Answer:** Rather than give up some cherished idea, or discard some idol of opinion, many refuse the truth which comes down from the Father of light. And, when they see that there is no way of weaving self into the work.

A legal religion can never lead souls to Christ; for it is a loveless, Christless religion. Fasting or prayer that is actuated by a self-justifying spirit is an abomination in the sight of God. The solemn assembly for worship, the round of religious ceremonies, the external humiliation, the imposing sacrifice, proclaim that the doer of these things regards himself as righteous, and as entitled to heaven; but it is all a deception. Our own works can never purchase salvation. {DA 280.2}

**Question:** What can never lead souls to Christ and why? And, what can never purchase?

**Answer:** A legal religion. For it's a loveless and a Christless religion. And, our own works for salvation for the imposing sacrifice, proclaim that the doer of these things regards himself as righteous, and as entitled to heaven; but it is all a deception.

As it was in the days of Christ, so it is now; the Pharisees do not know their spiritual destitution. To them comes the message, "Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: I counsel thee to buy of Me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear." **Revelation 3:17, 18.**

Faith and love are the gold tried in the fire. But with many the gold has become dim, and the rich treasure has been lost. The righteousness of Christ is to them as a robe unworn, a fountain untouched. To them it is said, "I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent." **Revelation 2:4, 5** {DA 280.3}

**Question:** How is it now with many religious leaders, as it was in the days of Christ? And, what does the message that comes to them say?

**Answer:** The Pharisees do not know their spiritual destitution. And, "Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked".

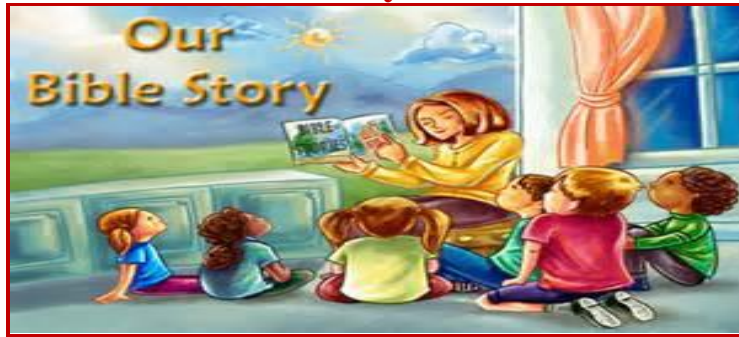

**Chapter 2-We Will Love Our Neighbors as Ourselves**  
**Narrated by our dear Brother Graves!**  
**Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Matthew 22:39. {SD 52.1}**

The divine law requires us to love God supremely, and our neighbor as ourselves. Without the exercise of this love, the highest profession of faith is mere **hypocrisy**. {SD 52.2}

The worshiper of God will find that he cannot cherish one fiber of the root of **selfishness**. He cannot do his duty to his God and practice **oppression** toward his fellow men. The second principle of the law is like unto the first, "Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself." "This do and thou shalt live." These are the words of Jesus Christ from which there can be no departure on the part of any man, woman, or youth who would be a true Christian. It is obedience to the principles of the commandments of God, that molds the character after the divine **similitude**. . . . {SD 52.3}

To leave a suffering neighbor **unrelieved** is a **breach** of the law of God. . . . He who loves God will not only love his fellow men, but will regard with tender compassion the creatures which God has made. When the Spirit of God is in man it leads him to relieve rather than to create suffering. . . . We are to care for every case of suffering, and to look upon ourselves as God's agents to relieve the needy to the very **uttermost** of our ability. We are to be **laborers** together with God. There are some who manifest great affection for their relatives, for their friends and favorites, who yet fail to be kind and **considerate** to those who need tender sympathy, who need kindness and love. With earnest heart, let us inquire, Who is my neighbor? Our neighbors are not merely our neighbors and special friends, are not simply those who belong to our church or who think as we do. Our neighbors are the whole human family. We are to do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. We are to give to the world an **exhibition** of what it means to carry out the law of God. We are to love God supremely and our neighbors as ourselves. {SD 52.4}

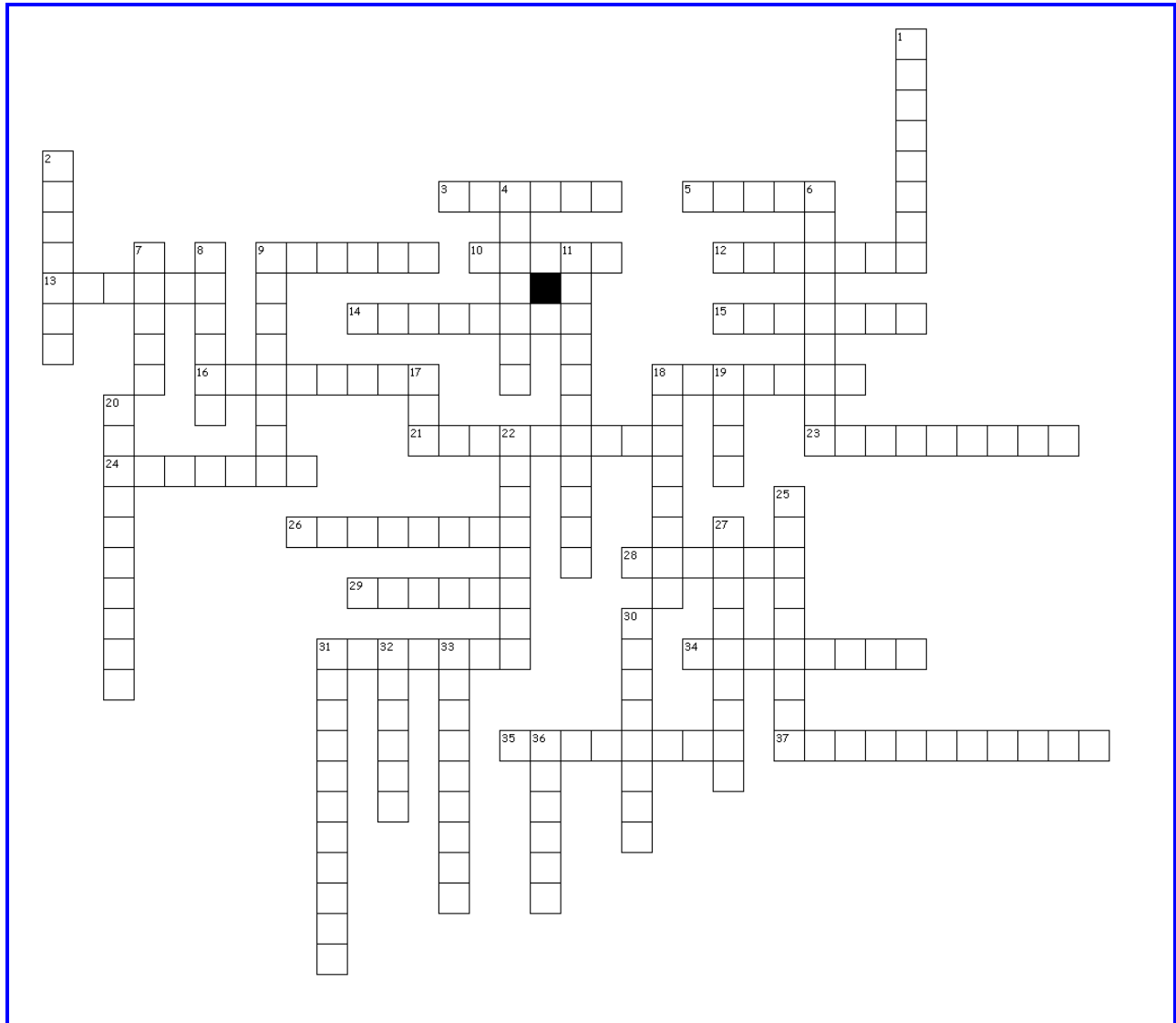
