Exodus 20:11 (KJV)

For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble. **25.** To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. **26.** Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these [things],

that bringeth out their host by number: he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his might, for that [he is] strong in power; not one faileth. **27.** Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel,

My way is hid from the LORD, and my judgment is passed over from my God? **28.** Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, [that] the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? [there is] no searching of his understanding. **29.** He giveth

power to the faint; and to [them that have] no might he increaseth strength.

Isaiah 41:10 (KJV)

Fear thou not; for I [am] with thee: be not dismayed; for I [am] thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Isaiah 45:22 (KJV)

Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I [am] God, and [there is] none else.

Ezekiel 20:20 (KJV)

And hallow my sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I [am] the LORD your God.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #29, pages 281 - 282

The Sabbath was hallowed at the creation. As ordained for man, it had its origin when "the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy." **Job 38:7**. Peace brooded over the world; for earth was in harmony with heaven. "God saw everything that He had made, and, behold, it was very good;" and He rested in the joy of His completed work. **Genesis 1:31**. {DA 281.1}

Because He had rested upon the Sabbath, "God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it,"-- set it apart to a holy use. He gave it to Adam as a day of rest. It was a memorial of the work of creation, and thus a sign of God's power and His love. The Scripture says, "He hath made His wonderful works to be remembered." "The things that are made," declare "the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world," "even His eternal power and Godhead." **Genesis 2:3; Psalm 111:4; Romans 1:20** {DA 281.2}

All things were created by the Son of God. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God. . . . All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made." **John 1:1-3**. And since the Sabbath is a memorial of the work of creation, it is a token of the love and power of Christ. {DA 281.3}

Question: When was the Sabbath hallowed? And, why did God bless the seventh day, and sanctified it?

Answer: At the creation. And, because He had rested upon the Sabbath setting it apart to a holy use.

Question: By whom were all things created? And, what is the Sabbath a memorial of as concerning the work of creation?

Answer: The Son of God all things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made. And, it is a token of the love and power of Christ.

Song: *Let's learn a beautiful scripture song together dear ones, from the book of John!*

John 1:1-5, 9-11(KJV)

1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
The same was in the beginning with God.

All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.
In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

1:9-11 [That] was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.
He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.
He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

The Sabbath calls our thoughts to nature, and brings us into communion with the Creator. In the song of the bird, the sighing of the trees, and the music of the sea, we still may hear His voice who talked with Adam in Eden in the cool of the day. And as we behold His power in nature we find comfort, for the word that created all things is that which speaks life to the soul. He "who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ." **2 Corinthians 4:6. {DA 281.4}**

It was this thought that awoke the song,--

I will triumph in the works of Thy hands.
O Lord, how great are Thy works!
And Thy thoughts are very deep." **Psalm 92:4, 5. {DA 282.1}**

Question: What does the Sabbath call our thoughts to? And, as we behold His power in nature what can we find?

Answer: Nature brings us into communion with the Creator. In the song of the bird, the sighing of the trees, and the music of the sea, we still may hear His voice who talked with Adam in Eden in the cool of the day. And, comfort, for the word that created all things is that which speaks life to the soul.

And the Holy Spirit through the prophet Isaiah declares: "To whom then will ye liken God? or what likeness will ye compare unto Him? . . . Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth? It is He that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in. . . . To whom then will ye liken Me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these things, that bringeth out their host by number: He calleth them all by names by the greatness of His might, for that He is strong in power; not one faileth. Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel, My way is hid from the Lord, and my judgment is passed over from my God? Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? . . . and to them that have no might He increaseth strength." When the Lord bade Israel hallow His Sabbaths, He said, "They shall be a sign between Me and you, that ye may know that I am Jehovah your God." **Isaiah 40:18-29; 41:10; 45:22; Ezekiel 20:20 {DA 282.2}**

Question: What does our Creator give to the faint and those without might? And, what are His promises to us all?

Answer: He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might He increaseth strength. And, "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness."

Question: What did the Lord say to Israel when He bade them to hallow His Sabbaths? And, what is the message written in nature which the Sabbath was appointed by the Lord to teach us?

Answer: He said, “They shall be a sign between Me and you, that ye may know that I am Jehovah your God.” And, to keep in memory, “Look unto Me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.”

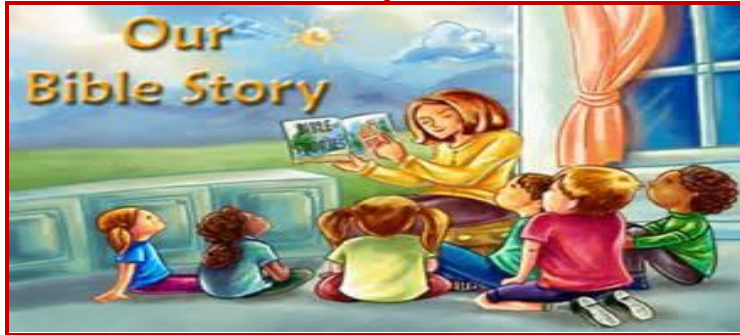

**And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
Exodus 20:6. {SD 53.1}**

The ten holy **precepts** spoken by Christ upon **Sinai's** mount were the revelation of the character of God, and made known to the world the fact that He had **jurisdiction** over the whole human **heritage**. That law of ten precepts of the greatest love that can be presented to man is the voice of God from heaven speaking to the soul in promise. "This do, and you will not come under the dominion and control of Satan." There is not a negative in that law, although it may appear thus. It is DO, and Live. . . . The Lord has given His holy commandments to be a wall of protection around His created beings. {SD 53.2}

Everything that God could do, He has done to manifest His great love and mercy to you. He "so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." Then rest in the assurance of the love of God. . . . Not because we first loved Him did God love us; but "while we were yet sinners," Christ died for us, making full and abundant **provision** for our **redemption**. Although by our disobedience we have merited God's **displeasure** and **condemnation**, yet He has not **forsaken** us, leaving us to **grapple** with the power of the enemy in our own **finite** strength. Heavenly angels fight our battles for us, and cooperating with them, we may be **victorious** over the powers of evil. . . . As we draw nigh to Him by faith, He draws nigh to us, adopting us into His family, and making us His sons and daughters. {SD 53.3}

To those who are faithful in His service, mercy is promised, not merely to the third and fourth generation . . . but to thousands of generations. {SD 53.4}

The tender mercies of God are **unmeasured**, and those who **appreciate** the love of Christ will be renewed in true holiness, and brought into Christ, their living Head. They will be followers of God as dear children. {SD 53.5}

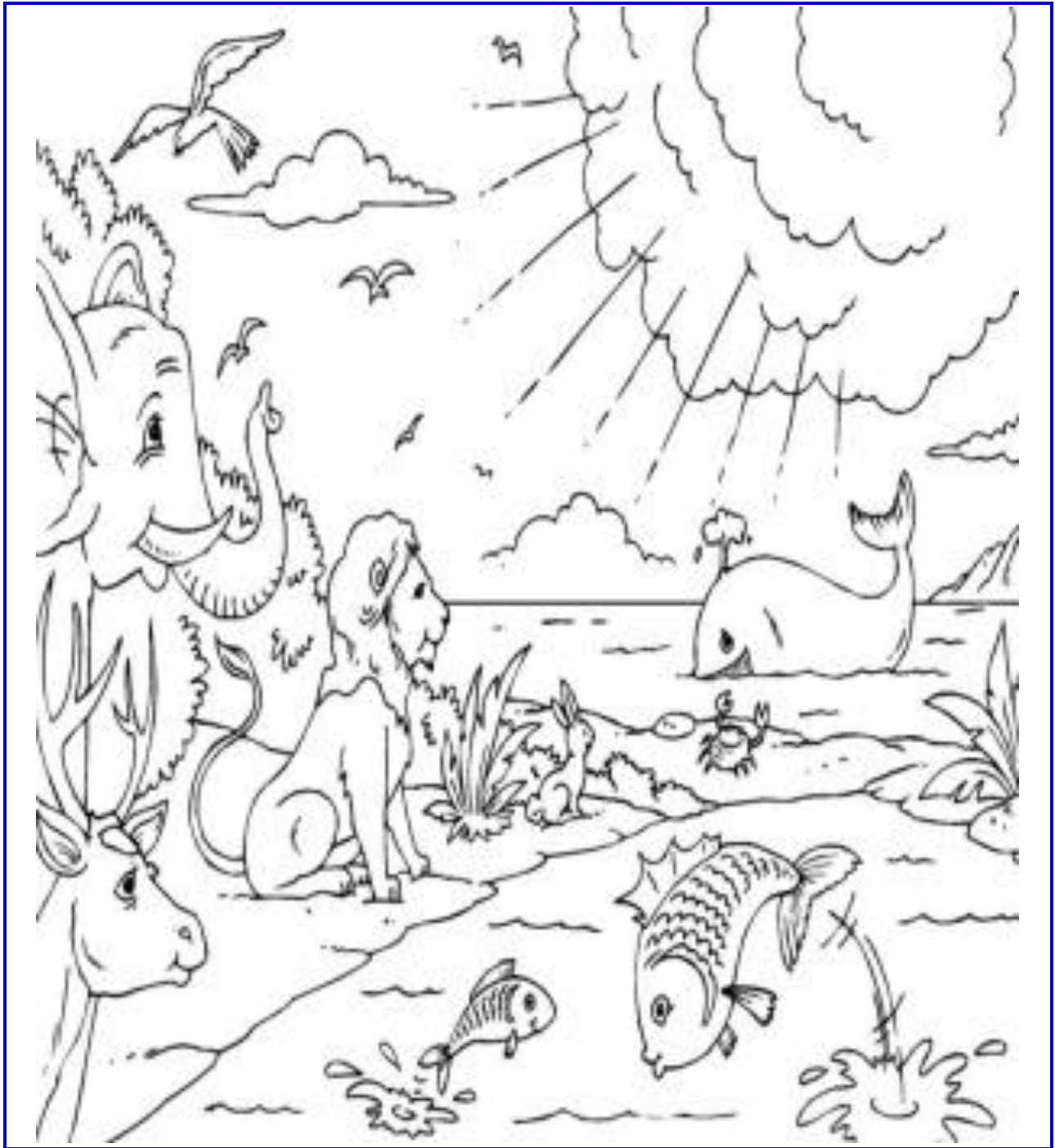

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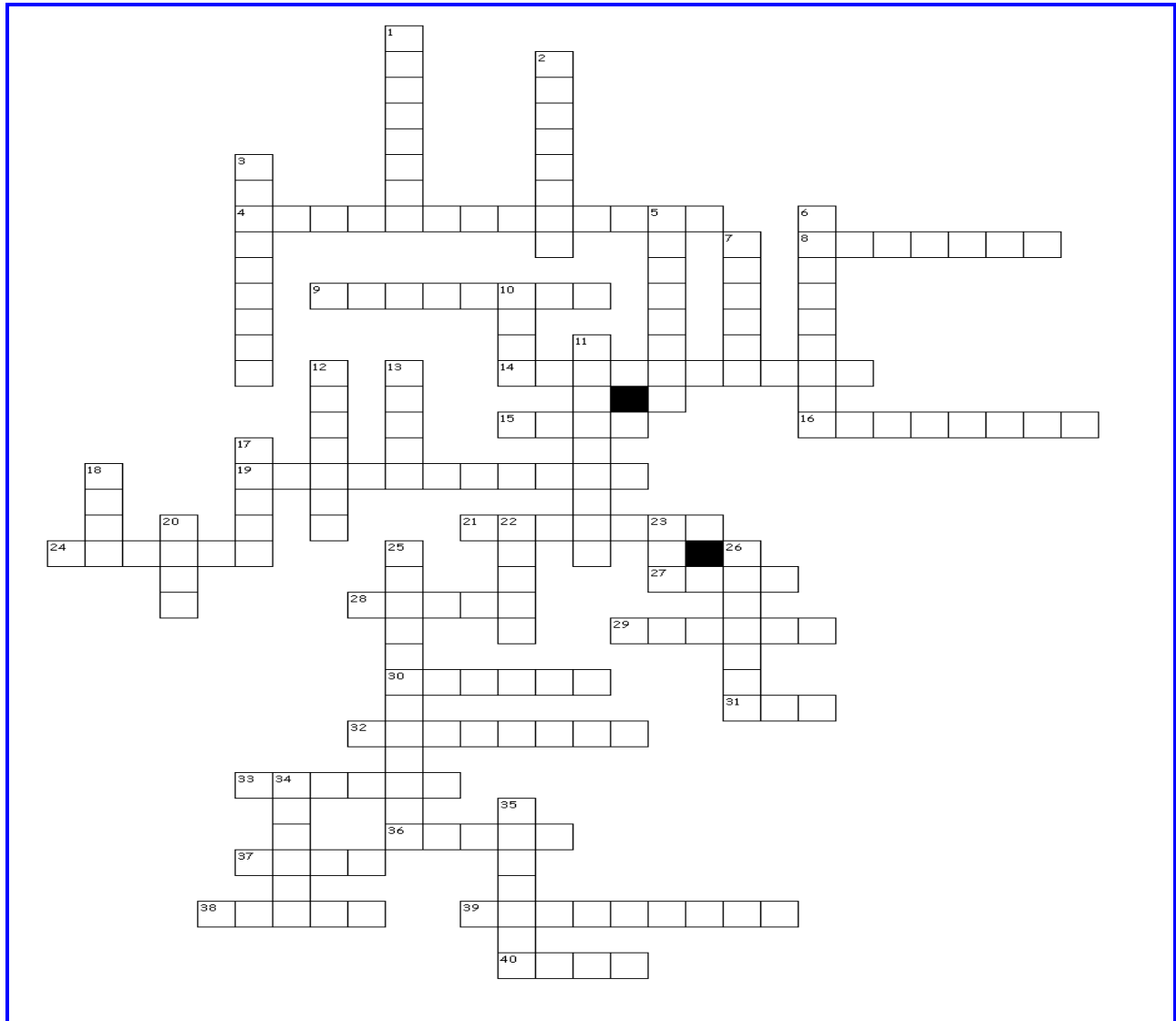
