**Lesson #143: “He Ordained Twelve” Part 2**

**John 14:23 (KJV)**

**And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.**

*This week boys and girls, we will continue with part 2 in our lesson entitled,  
“He Ordained twelve” of our study book Desire of Ages!*

**John 1:45 (KJV)**

Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

**John 6:5 (KJV)**

When Jesus then lifted up [his] eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

**John 6:6 (KJV)**

And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do.

**John 14:5 (KJV)**

Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

**John 14:6 (KJV)**

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

**John 14:7 (KJV)**

If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

**John 14:8 (KJV)**

Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

**Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #30, pages 291 – 292**

Jesus had called His disciples that He might send them forth as His witnesses, to declare to the world what they had seen and heard of Him. Their office was the most important to which human beings had ever been called, and was second only to that of Christ Himself. They were to be workers together with God for the saving of the world. As in the Old Testament the twelve patriarchs stand as representatives of Israel, so the twelve apostles were to stand as representatives of the gospel church. {DA 291.3}

**Question:** What did Jesus call His disciples for? And, how important was their office as well as how they stood before the world for Jesus?

**Answer:** That He might send them forth as His witnesses, to declare to the world what they had seen and heard of Him. And, their office was the most important to which human beings had ever been called, and was second only to that of Christ Himself; so the twelve apostles were to stand as representatives of the gospel church.

**Song:** *Let's learn a beautiful song together dear ones, about how we can also serve Jesus by becoming His co-laborers!*

***Here are my Hands***

Here are my hands help them serve.  
Let my mouth speak Your Words.  
And my ears to hear Your Voice,  
Got my feet to follow Your Path,

The Saviour knew the character of the men whom He had chosen; all their weaknesses and errors were open before Him; He knew the perils through which they must pass, the responsibility that would rest upon them; and His heart yearned over these chosen ones. Alone upon a mountain near the Sea of Galilee He spent the entire night in prayer for them, while they were sleeping at the foot of the mountain. With the first light of dawn He summoned them to meet Him; for He had something of importance to communicate to them. {DA 291.4}

**Question:** How well did the Saviour know the characters of the men whom He had chosen? And, what did the Saviour do to help them and how?

**Answer:** He knew all their weaknesses and errors, the perils through which they must pass, the responsibility that would rest upon them, were open before Him. And, alone upon a mountain near the Sea of Galilee He spent the entire night in prayer for them, while they were sleeping at the foot of the mountain. He summoned them to meet Him; for He had something of importance to communicate to them.

These disciples had been for some time associated with Jesus in active labor. John and James, Andrew and Peter, with Philip, Nathanael, and Matthew, had been more closely connected with Him than the others, and had witnessed more of His miracles. Peter, James, and John stood in still nearer relationship to Him. They were almost constantly with Him, witnessing His miracles, and hearing His words. John pressed into still closer intimacy with Jesus, so that he is distinguished as the one whom Jesus loved. The Saviour loved them all, but John's was the most receptive spirit. He was younger than the others, and with more of the child's confiding trust he opened his heart to Jesus. Thus he came more into sympathy with Christ, and through him the Saviour's deepest spiritual teaching was communicated to His people. {DA 292.1}

**Question:** How did the Saviour feel about His disciples who were associated with Him in active labor? But, to who does He communicates the deepest spiritual teaching to His people?

**Answer:** The Saviour loved them all. And, thus he that comes more into sympathy with Christ, like (John)...they with more of the child's confiding trust that will open his heart to Jesus.

At the head of one of the groups into which the apostles are divided stands the name of Philip. He was the first disciple to whom Jesus addressed the distinct command, "Follow Me." Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. He had listened to the teaching of John the Baptist, and had heard his announcement of Christ as the Lamb of God. Philip was a sincere seeker for truth, but he was slow of heart to believe. Although he had joined himself to Christ, yet his announcement of Him to Nathanael shows that he was not fully convinced of the divinity of Jesus. Though Christ had been proclaimed by the voice from heaven as the Son of God, to Philip He was "Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." **John 1:45.**

**Question:** Which disciple from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter, was first to whom Jesus addressed with distinct command, “Follow Me”? And, Philip was a sincere seeker for truth, why was he slow of heart to believe?

**Answer:** Philip! He had listened to the teaching of John the Baptist, and had heard his announcement of Christ as the Lamb of God. And, he shows that he was not fully convinced of the divinity of Jesus.

Again, when the five thousand were fed, Philip's lack of faith was shown. It was to test him that Jesus questioned, “Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?” Philip's answer was on the side of unbelief: “Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.” **John 6:5, 7.** Jesus was grieved. Although Philip had seen His works and felt His power, yet he had not faith. When the Greeks inquired of Philip concerning Jesus, he did not seize upon the opportunity of introducing them to the Saviour, but he went to tell Andrew. Again, in those last hours before the crucifixion, the words of Philip were such as to discourage faith. When Thomas said to Jesus, “Lord, we know not whither Thou goest; and how can we know the way?” the Saviour answered, “I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. . . . If ye had known Me, ye should have known My Father also.” From Philip came the response of unbelief: “Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.” **John 14:5-8.** So slow of heart, so weak in faith, was that disciple who for three years had been with Jesus. {DA 292.2}

**Question:** During what miracle of Jesus was Philip’s lack of faith shown again? And, how did Jesus test him?

**Answer:** When the five thousand were fed. And, by Jesus questioned, “Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat”? Philip's answer was on the side of unbelief: “Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.”

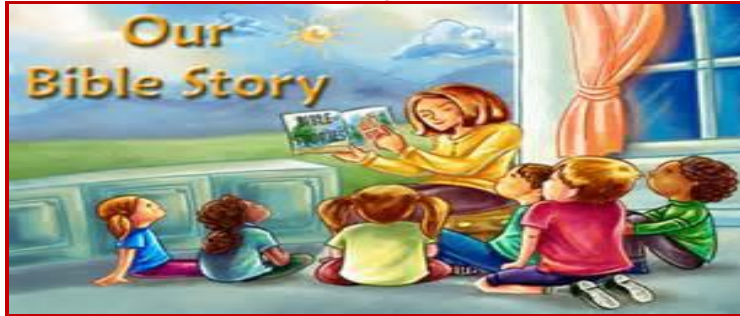

**Chapter 2- We Shall Keep the Sabbath Day Holy**  
**Narrated by our dear Brother Graves!**

**Remember the sabbath day to keep it holy. Exodus 20:8. {SD 59.1}**

God said, "The seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God." He placed His **sanctity** upon this day and blessed it and hallowed it as a day of rest. . . .It is the only commandment in the whole **Decalogue** that tells who God is. It places God in **distinction** with every other god. It says the God that made the heaven and the earth, the God that made the trees and the flowers and that created man; this is the God that you are to keep before your children, and you have only to point to the flowers and tell them that He made these and that He rested on the seventh day from all His labors. . . . The seventh day is a God-given **memorial**. {SD 59.2}

Pointing to God as the maker of the heavens and the earth, it **distinguishes** the true God from all false gods. All who keep the seventh day, signify by this act that they are worshippers of Jehovah. Thus the Sabbath is the sign of man's **allegiance** to God as long as there are any upon the earth to serve Him. . . . {SD 59.3}

God has given men six days wherein to labor, and He requires that their own work be done in the six working days. Acts of necessity and mercy are permitted on the Sabbath, the sick and suffering are at all times to be cared for; but unnecessary labor is to be **strictly** avoided. . . . And the commandment includes all within our gates. The **inmates** of the house are to lay aside their worldly business during the sacred hours. All should unite to honor God by willing service upon His holy days. {SD 59.4}

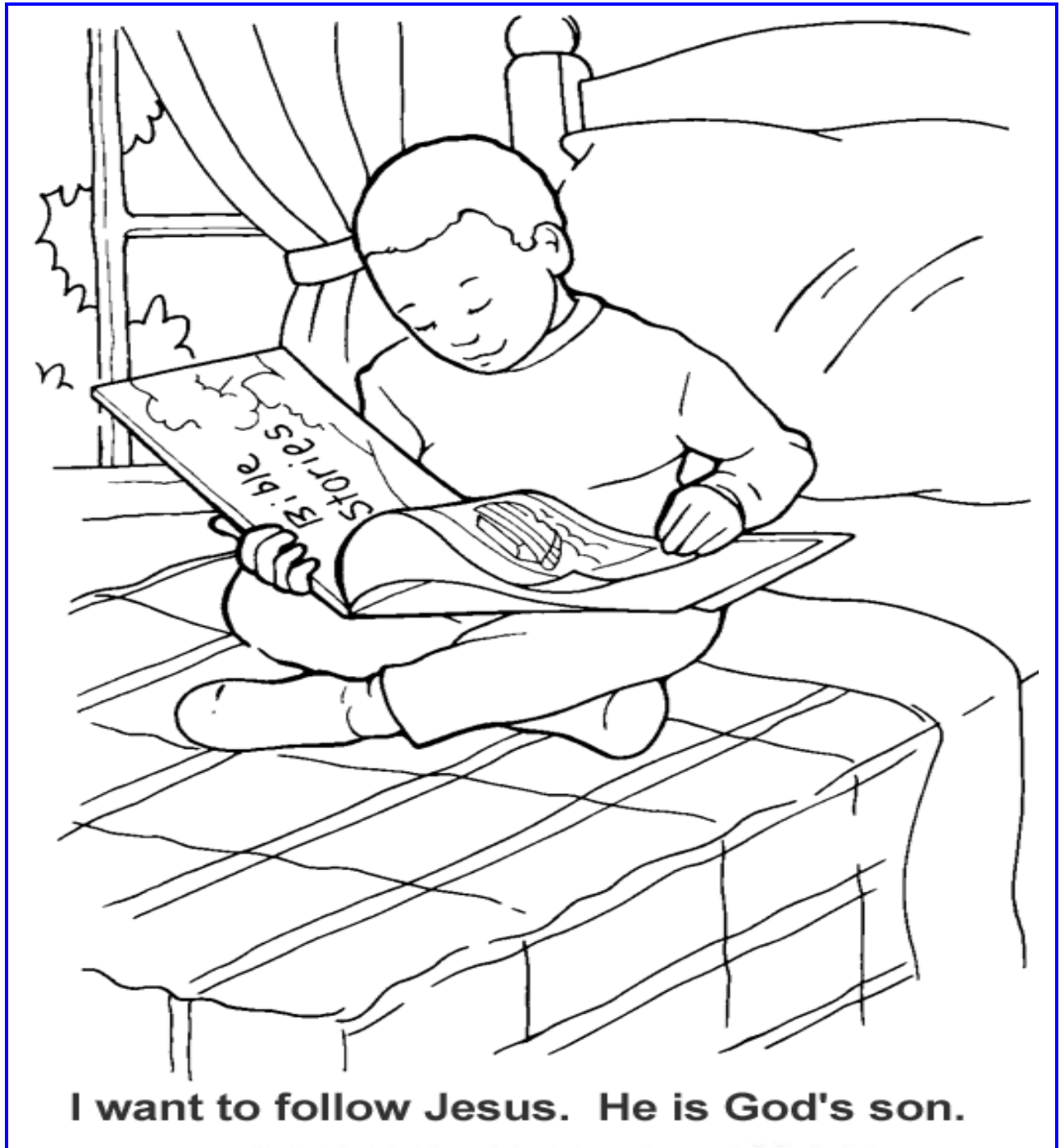
So long as the heavens and the earth endure, the Sabbath will continue as a sign of the Creator's power. And when Eden shall **bloom** on earth again, God's holy rest day will be honored by all beneath the sun. "From one sabbath to another" the **inhabitants** of the glorified new earth shall go up "to worship before me, saith the Lord." {SD 59.5}

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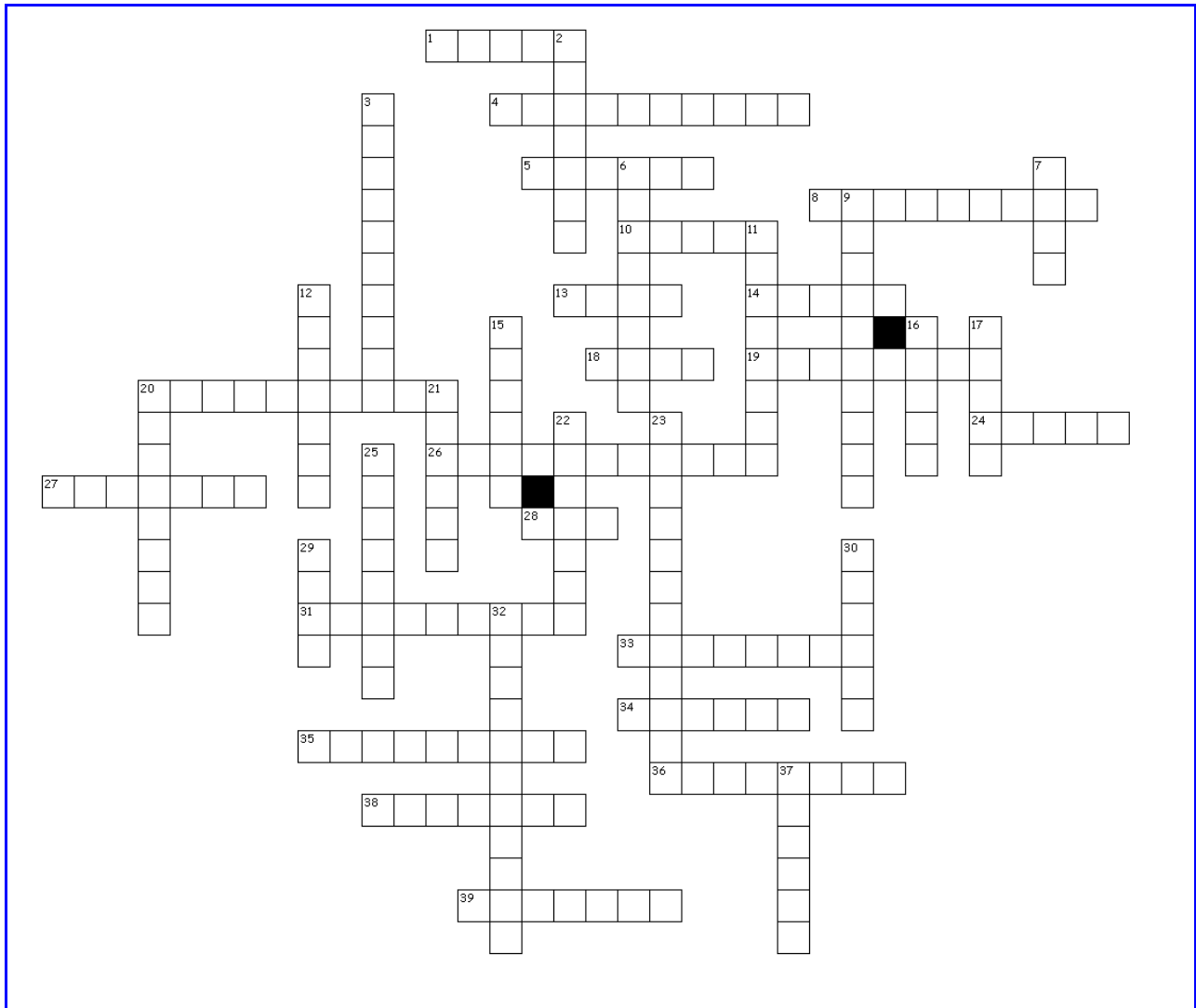
