Lesson #143: “He Ordained Twelve” Part 3

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #30, pages 293 – 294

In happy contrast to Philip's unbelief was the childlike trust of Nathanael. He was a man of intensely earnest nature, one whose faith took hold upon unseen realities. Yet Philip was a student in the school of Christ, and the divine Teacher bore patiently with his unbelief and dullness. When the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the disciples, Philip became a teacher after the divine order. He knew whereof he spoke, and he taught with an assurance that carried conviction to the hearers. {DA 293.1}

Question: What happen to Philip when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the disciples?

Answer: Philip became a teacher after the divine order. He knew whereof he spoke, and he taught with an assurance that carried conviction to the hearers.

While Jesus was preparing the disciples for their ordination, one who had not been summoned urged his presence among them. It was Judas Iscariot, a man who professed to be a follower of Christ. He now came forward, soliciting a place in this inner circle of disciples. With great earnestness and apparent sincerity he declared, "Master, I will follow Thee whithersoever Thou goest." Jesus neither repulsed nor welcomed him, but uttered only the mournful words: "The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay His head." **Matthew 8:19, 20.** Judas believed Jesus to be the Messiah; and by joining the apostles, he hoped to secure a high position in the new kingdom. This hope Jesus designed to cut off by the statement of His poverty. {DA 293.2}

Question: While Jesus was preparing the disciples for their ordination, who have not been summoned but, urged his presence among them? And, what statement of His poverty spoken by Jesus, was designed to cut of Judas' hope for a high position in the new kingdom?

Answer: It was Judas Iscariot, a man who professed to be a follower of Christ. He now came forward, soliciting a place in this inner circle of disciples. And, Jesus uttered only the mournful words: "The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay His head."

The disciples were anxious that Judas should become one of their number. He was of commanding appearance, a man of keen discernment and executive ability, and they commended him to Jesus as one who would greatly assist Him in His work. They were surprised that Jesus received him so coolly. {DA 294.1}

Question: Why where disciples surprised that Jesus received him (Judas) so coolly?

Answer: To the disciples Judas should become one of their number because he was of commanding appearance, a man of keen discernment and executive ability, and they commended him to Jesus as one who would greatly assist Him in His work.

The disciples had been much disappointed that Jesus had not tried to secure the co-operation of the leaders in Israel. They felt that it was a mistake not to strengthen His cause by securing the support of these influential men. If He had repulsed Judas, they would, in their own minds, have questioned the wisdom of their Master. The after history of Judas would show them the danger of allowing any worldly consideration to have weight in deciding the fitness of men for the work of God. The co-operation of such men as the disciples were anxious to secure would have betrayed the work into the hands of its worst enemies. {DA 294.2}

Question: What did Judas' after history show of the danger of allowing any worldly consideration to have weight in deciding the fitness of men for the work of God?

Answer: The co-operation of such men as the disciples were anxious to secure would have betrayed the work into the hands of its worst enemies.

Yet when Judas joined the disciples, he was not insensible to the beauty of the character of Christ. He felt the influence of that divine power which was drawing souls to the Saviour. He who came not to break the bruised reed nor quench the smoking flax would not repulse this soul while even one desire was reaching toward the light. The Saviour read the heart of Judas; He knew the depths of iniquity to which, unless delivered by the grace of God, Judas would sink. In connecting this man with Himself, He placed him where he might, day by day, be brought in contact with the outflowing of His own unselfish love. If he would open his heart to Christ, divine grace would banish the demon of selfishness, and even Judas might become a subject of the kingdom of God. {DA 294.3}

Question: What did he (Judas) feel from the Saviour influence? And, what statement regarding the Saviour shows that even Judas was not insensible to the beauty of the character of Christ?

Answer: His divine power which was drawing soul. And, he who came not to break the bruised reed nor quench the smoking flax would not repulse this soul while even one desire was reaching toward the light.

I have put my spirit upon him: Isaiah 42: 1 though 4

God takes men as they are, with the human elements in their character, and trains them for His service, if they will be disciplined and learn of Him. They are not chosen because they are perfect, but notwithstanding their imperfections, that through the knowledge and practice of the truth, through the grace of Christ, they may become transformed into His image. {DA 294.4}

Judas had the same opportunities as had the other disciples. He listened to the same precious lessons. But the practice of the truth, which Christ required, was at variance with the desires and purposes of Judas, and he would not yield his ideas in order to receive wisdom from Heaven. {DA 294.5}

Question: What is require of men to be chosen for His service? And, why did Judas having same opportunities as the other disciples had, come short of the practice of the truth, which Christ required?

Answer: If they will be disciplined and learn of Him that through the knowledge and practice of the truth, through the grace of Christ, they may become transformed into His image. And, Judas was at variance with the desires and purposes he had and would not yield his ideas in order to receive wisdom from Heaven.

Day by Day

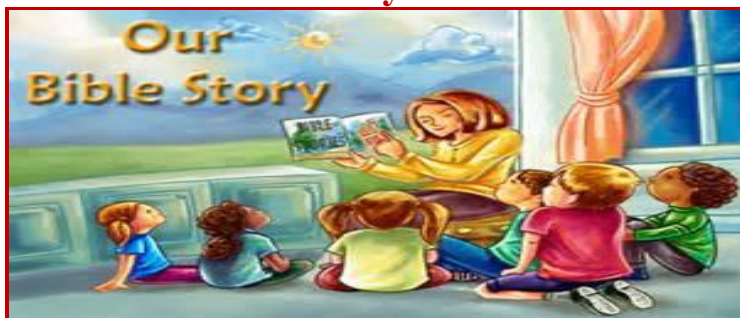

Chapter 2-Long Life Promised for Honoring Parents
Narrated by our dear Brother Graves!

Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. Exodus 20:12. {SD 60.1}

Those who would truly follow Christ must let Him abide in the heart, and **enthron**e Him there as **supreme**. They must represent His spirit and character in their home life, and show courtesy and kindness to those with whom they come in contact. There are many children who profess to know the truth, who do not render to their parents the honor and affection that are due to them, who manifest but little love to father and mother, and fail to honor them in deferring to their wishes, or in seeking to relieve them of **anxiety**. Many who profess to be Christians do not know what it means to "honour thy father and thy mother," and **consequently** will know just as little what it means, "that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee." . . . The Heart-searcher knows what is your **attitude** toward your parents; for He is weighing moral character in the golden scales of the heavenly sanctuary. O, confess your neglect of your parents, confess your indifference toward them, and your **contempt** of God's holy commandment. {SD 60.2}

Parents are entitled to a degree of love and respect which is due to no other person. God Himself, who has placed upon them a responsibility for the souls committed to their charge, has ordained that during the earlier years of life, parents shall stand in the place of God to their children. And he who rejects the rightful authority of his parents, is rejecting the authority of God. The fifth commandment requires the children not only to **yield** respect, **submission**, and obedience to their parents, but also to give them love and tenderness, to lighten their cares, to guard their **reputation**, and to **succor** and comfort them in old age. {SD 60.3}

The fifth commandment is binding upon children as long as their own lives and the lives of their parents are spared. {SD 60.4}

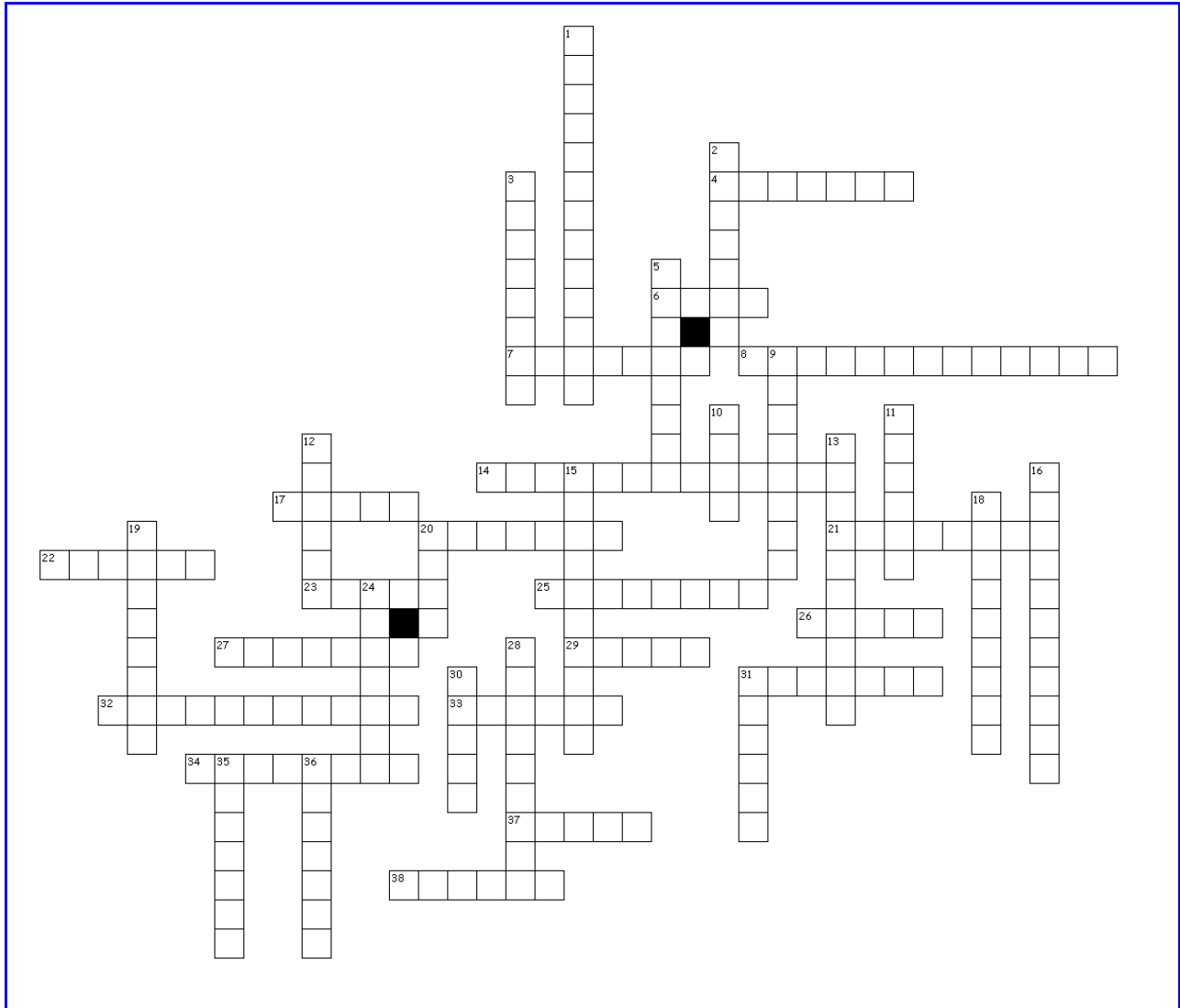
