Lesson #150: “The Sermon on the Mount”, Part 4

Matthew 5:10 (KJV)

Blessed [are] they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

*This week boys and girls, we will continue with Part 4 in our lesson entitled,
 “The Sermon on the Mount” of our study book Desire of Ages!*

Matthew 5:11 (KJV) Blessed are ye, when [men] shall revile you, and persecute [you], and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.

Matthew 5:12 (KJV) Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great [is] your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

Matthew 5:13 (KJV) Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

Matthew 5:14 (KJV) Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

Matthew 5:15 (KJV) Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

Matthew 6:19 (KJV) Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

1 Peter 1:6 (KJV) Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:

1 Peter 1:7 (KJV) That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #31, pages 305 – 306

The multitudes were amazed at this teaching, which was so at variance with the precepts and example of the Pharisees. The people had come to think that happiness consisted in the possession of the things of this world, and that fame and the honor of men were much to be coveted. It was very pleasing to be called "Rabbi," and to be extolled as wise and religious, having their virtues paraded before the public. This was regarded as the crown of happiness. But in the presence of that vast throng, Jesus declared that earthly gain and honor were all the reward such persons would ever receive. He spoke with certainty, and a convincing power attended His words. The people were silenced, and a feeling of fear crept over them. They looked at one another doubtfully. Who of them would be saved if this Man's teachings were true? Many were convicted that this remarkable Teacher was actuated by the Spirit of God, and that the sentiments He uttered were divine. {DA 305.1}

Question: What was the response of Jesus regarding the people's thoughts of what happiness consisted of on earth? And, what led the people's silence with a feeling of fear crept over them as they looked at one another doubtfully?

Answer: Jesus declared that earthly gain and honor were all the reward such persons would ever receive. And, they were convicted that this remarkable Teacher was actuated by the Spirit of God, and that the sentiments He uttered were divine.

Matthew 6:20 (KJV)

But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven,
where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt,
and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

After explaining what constitutes true happiness, and how it may be obtained, Jesus more definitely pointed out the duty of His disciples, as teachers chosen of God to lead others into the path of righteousness and eternal life. He knew that they would often suffer from disappointment and discouragement, that they would meet with decided opposition, that they would be insulted, and their testimony rejected. Well He knew that in the fulfillment of their mission, the humble men who listened so attentively to His words were to bear calumny, torture, imprisonment, and death, and He continued: {DA 305.2}

"Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for My sake. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you." {DA 305.3}

Question: From what did Jesus know His disciples would often suffer from, as well as knowing they would meet with decided opposition in their mission? And, what words of comfort did the Lord leave for his people who are persecuted for righteousness' sake?

Answer: They would often suffer from disappointment and discouragement, they would be insulted, and their testimony rejected as well as His words were to bear calumny, torture, imprisonment, and death. And, Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you."

The world loves sin, and hates righteousness, and this was the cause of its hostility to Jesus. All who refuse His infinite love will find Christianity a disturbing element. The light of Christ sweeps away the darkness that covers their sins, and the need of reform is made manifest. While those who yield to the influence of the Holy Spirit begin war with themselves, those who cling to sin war against the truth and its representatives. {DA 306.1}

Question: What does the light of Christ do? And, what will the Holy Spirit begin to do for those whom yield themselves to His influence?

Answer: Sweeps away the darkness that covers their sins and the need of reform is made manifest. And, to the influence of the Holy Spirit begin war with them, those who cling to sin war against the truth and its representatives.

Thus strife is created, and Christ's followers are accused as troublers of the people. But it is fellowship with God that brings them the world's enmity. They are bearing the reproach of Christ. They are treading the path that has been trodden by the noblest of the earth. Not with sorrow, but with rejoicing, should they meet persecution. Each fiery trial is God's agent for their refining. Each is fitting them for their work as colaborers with Him. Each conflict has its place in the great battle for righteousness, and each will add to the joy of their final triumph. Having this in view, the test of their faith and patience will be cheerfully accepted rather than dreaded and avoided. Anxious to fulfill their obligation to the world, fixing their desire upon the approval of God, His servants are to fulfill every duty, irrespective of the fear or the favor of men. {DA 306.2}

Question: What is each fiery trial to God?" And, how are the servants of the Lord to fulfill every duty?

Answer: Each fiery trial is God's agent for their refining. Each is fitting them for their work as colaborers with Him. Each conflict has its place in the great battle for righteousness, and each will add to the joy of their final triumph. And, irrespective of the fear or the favor of men their faith and patience will be cheerfully accepted rather than dreaded and avoided.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (KJV)

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man:
but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able;

"Ye are the salt of the earth," Jesus said. Do not withdraw yourselves from the world in order to escape persecution. You are to abide among men, that the savor of the divine love may be as salt to preserve the world from corruption. {DA 306.3}

Hearts that respond to the influence of the Holy Spirit are the channels through which God's blessing flows. Were those who serve God removed from the earth, and His Spirit withdrawn from among men, this world would be left to desolation and destruction, the fruit of Satan's dominion. Though the wicked know it not, they owe even the blessings of this life to the presence, in the world, of God's people whom they despise and oppress. But if Christians are such in name only, they are like the salt that has lost its savor. They have no influence for good in the world. Through their misrepresentation of God they are worse than unbelievers. {DA 306.4}

Question: What will the Hearts that respond to the influence of the Holy Spirit be? And, were would the earth be were those who serve God removed from the earth, and His Spirit withdrawn from among men?

Answer: The channels through which God's blessing flows. And, this world would be left to desolation and destruction, the fruit of Satan's dominion.

"Ye are the light of the world." The Jews thought to confine the benefits of salvation to their own nation; but Christ showed them that salvation is like the sunshine. It belongs to the whole world. The religion of the Bible is not to be confined between the covers of a book, nor within the walls of a church. It is not to be brought out occasionally for our own benefit, and then to be carefully laid aside again. It is to sanctify the daily life, to manifest itself in every business transaction and in all our social relations. {DA 306.5}

Question: What did the Lord say that his servants are? And, what should the religion of the Bible be and what should is not be?

Answer: "Ye are the light of the world." And, is not to be confined between the covers of a book, nor within the walls of a church; It is not to be brought out occasionally for our own benefit, and then to be carefully laid aside again.

And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as he hath commanded us. Deuteronomy 6:25. {SD 66.1}

The happiness of man is found in obedience to the laws of God. In obedience to God's law he is surrounded as with a hedge and kept from the evil. {SD 66.2}

The tempter's voice will be heard on every side, telling you that you are not now required to keep the law of God. This is a **device** of Satan. God has a law, and men must keep it. If they disregard these rules, they will not have that perfection of character . . . required to become members of the royal family . . . for God wrote these ten holy rules on tables of stone and kept them in the ark of God's testimony. The cover of this ark . . . was called the **mercy-seat**, to signify that although death was the **penalty** for transgressing the law, mercy came through Jesus Christ to pardon the repentant, believing sinner. {SD 66.3}

The only hope of any man lies through Jesus Christ, who brought the robe of His righteousness to put upon the sinner who would lay off his **filthy** garments. . . . The pure and holy garments are not prepared to be put on by any one after he has entered the gate of the city. All who enter will have on the robe of Christ's righteousness. . . . There will be no covering up of sins and faults to hide the **deformity** of character; no robes will be half washed; but all will be pure and **spotless**. {SD 66.4}

When we bring our lives to complete obedience to the law of God, regarding God as our supreme Guide, the clinging to Christ as our hope of righteousness, God will work in our behalf. This is a **righteousness** of faith. . . . The commandments of God diligently studied and practiced, open to us **communication** with heaven, and **distinguish** for us the true from the false. This obedience works out for us the divine will, bringing into our lives the righteousness and **perfection** that was seen in the life of Christ. {SD 66.5}

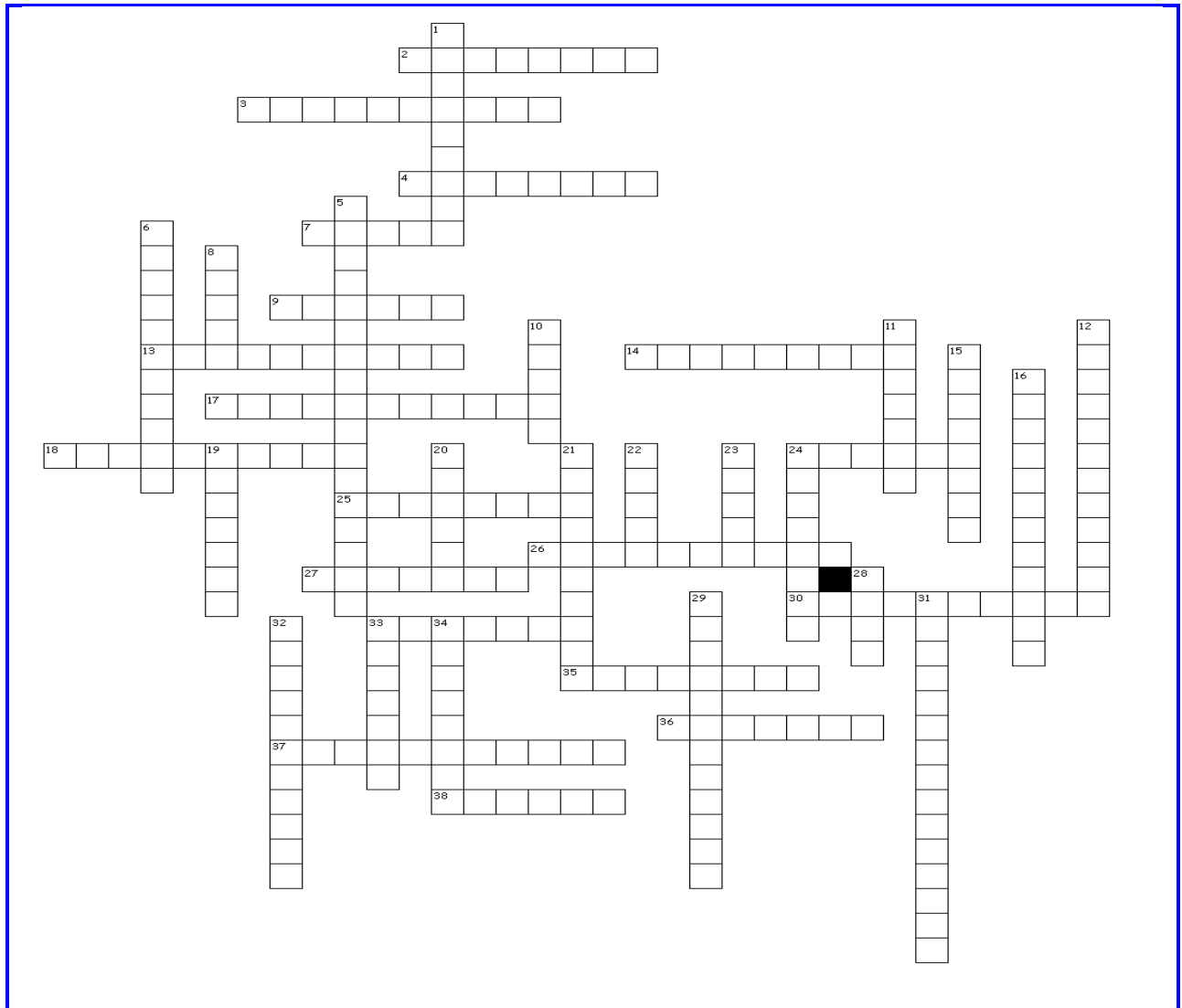
