Lesson #157: “Centurion” Part 3

Matthew 28:18 (KJV)

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

*This week boys and girls, we will end with part 3 in our lesson entitle,
“Centurion” in our study book Desire of Ages!*

Revelation 1:18 (KJV)

I [am] he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Hebrews 2:14 (KJV)

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

1 Thessalonians 4:17 (KJV)

Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #32, pages 318 – 320

In clear, authoritative voice the words are spoken, “Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.” That voice pierces the ears of the dead. The young man opens his eyes. Jesus takes him by the hand, and lifts him up. His gaze falls upon her who has been weeping beside him, and mother and son unite in a long, clinging, joyous embrace. The multitude look on in silence, as if spellbound. “There came a fear on all.” Hushed and reverent they stood for a little time, as if in the very presence of God. Then they “glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited His people.” The funeral train returned to Nain as a triumphal procession. “And this rumor of Him went forth throughout all Judea, and throughout all the region round about.” {DA 318.5}

Question: What words were spoken in clear authoritative voice by Jesus to the dead young man? And, how did the on-looking multitude react and experience?

Answer: Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.” That voice pierces the ears of the dead. And, In silence, as if spellbound. “There came a fear on all.” Hushed and reverent they stood for a little time, as if in the very presence of God.

Song: *Let's learn a beautiful scripture and song together dear ones, from the book of 1 Corinthians!*

1 Corinthians 15:55-57 (KJV)

O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave, where *is* thy victory?
The sting of death *is* sin;
and the strength of sin *is* the law.
But thanks *be* to God,
which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

He who stood beside the sorrowing mother at the gate of Nain, watches with every mourning one beside the bier. He is touched with sympathy for our grief. His heart, that loved and pitied, is a heart of unchangeable tenderness. His word, that called the dead to life, is no less efficacious now than when spoken to the young man of Nain. He says, “All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth.” **Matthew 28:18.** That power is not diminished by the lapse of years, nor exhausted by the ceaseless activity of His overflowing grace. To all who believe on Him He is still a living Saviour. {DA 319.1}

Question: Is Jesus' word less efficacious now than when spoken to the young man of Nain? And, what did Jesus say regarding the power given Him, being diminished by the lapse of years, nor exhausted by the ceaseless activity of His overflowing grace?

Answer: Not! It's no less efficacious now than when spoken to the young man of Nain. He is touched with sympathy for our grief. His heart, that loved and pitied, is a heart of unchangeable tenderness. And, “All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth.”

Song: *Let's learn another scripture song together dear ones, from the book of Matthew!*

Matthew 28:18-20 (KJV)

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying,

All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.
Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father,
and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:
and, lo, I am with you always, [even] unto the end of the world. Amen.

Question: Unto who is all power is given in heaven and in earth? And, what is Jesus still to all who believe?

Answer: Unto Jesus. And, to all who believe on Him He is still a living Saviour.

Jesus changed the mother's grief to joy when He gave back her son; yet the youth was but called forth to this earthly life, to endure its sorrows, its toils, and its perils, and to pass again under the power of death. But Jesus comforts our sorrow for the dead with a message of infinite hope: "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, . . . and have the keys of hell and of death." "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; and deliver them who through of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." **Revelation 1:18; Hebrews 2:14, 15. {DA 320.1}**

Question: What message of infinite hope does Jesus comfort our sorrow for the dead as the weeping mother? And, why did Jesus partake of flesh same flesh and blood as us?

Answer: "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, . . . and have the keys of hell and of death." And, that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; and deliver them who through of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."

Satan cannot hold the dead in his grasp when the Son of God bids them live. He cannot hold in spiritual death one soul who in faith receives Christ's word of power. God is saying to all who are dead in sin, "Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead." **Ephesians 5:14.** That word is eternal life. As the word of God which bade the first man live, still gives us life; as Christ's word, "Young man, I say unto thee, Arise, "gave life to the youth of Nain, so that word, "Arise from the dead," is life to the soul that receives it. God "hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son." **Colossians 1:13.** It is all offered us in His word. If we receive the word, we have the deliverance. **{DA 320.2}**

Question: Can Satan hold the dead in his grasp when the Son of God bids them live? And, as the word of God bade the first man to live, what word is it which still gives us life today?

Answer: No! He cannot hold in spiritual death one soul who in faith receives Christ's word of power. And, Christ's word "I say unto thee, Arise," gave life to the youth of Nain, so that word, "Arise from the dead," is life to the soul that receives it.

And "if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you." "For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the Archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord." **Romans 8:11; 1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17.** This is the word of comfort wherewith He bids us comfort one another. {DA 320.3}

Question: If the Spirit of Him (God the Father) that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, what will happen? And, what will follow after the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the Archangel, and with the trump of God?

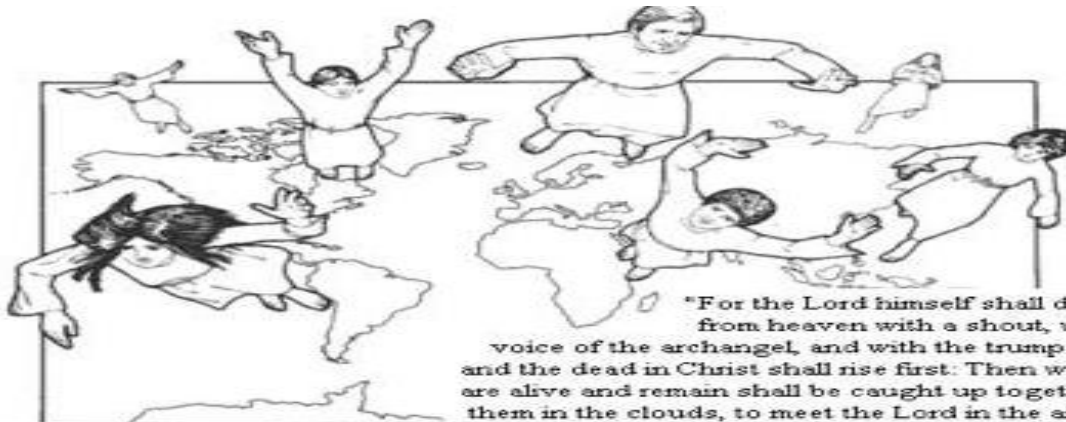
Answer: He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you. And, the dead in Christ shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Chapter 3-We Learn to Beware of Vain Deceit and Flattery
Narrated by our dear Brother Graves!

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8. {SD 73.1}

Flattery is an art by which Satan lieth in wait to deceive and to **puff** up the human agent with high thoughts of himself. . . . Flattery has been the food upon which many of our youth have been nourished; and those who have praised and flattered have supposed that they were doing right; but they have been doing wrong. Praise, flattery, and **indulgence** have done more toward leading precious souls into false paths, than any other art that Satan has devised. Flattery is a part of the world's policy, but it is no part of Christ's **policy**. Through flattery poor human beings, full of **frailty** and **infirmities**, come to think that they are **efficient** and worthy, and become puffed up in their fleshly mind. They become **intoxicated** with the idea that they possess ability beyond what they do have, and their religious experience becomes unbalanced. Unless in the providence of God they shall be turned from these **deceptions**, and become converted, and learn the a-b-c of religion in the school of Christ, they will lose their souls. Many a youth has been flattered that he has ability as a natural gift; when the ability he thinks he has, can be attained only through diligent training and culture, learning the meekness and **lowliness** of Christ. . . . God permits him to be attacked by the enemy, in order that he may understand his own weakness. He is permitted to make some decided **blunder**, and is plunged into painful humiliation. But when he is writhing under a sense of his own weakness, he is not to be judged **harshly**.... This is the time when he needs a friend who ... will deal patiently and faithfully with the erring. . . . He is not to be lifted up by the aid of flattery. . . . Rather he is to be pointed to the first rounds of the ladder, and his stumbling feet are to be placed on the lowest round of the ladder of progress. . . . Through the aid of wise counselors, his defeat will be turned into victory. {SD 73.2}

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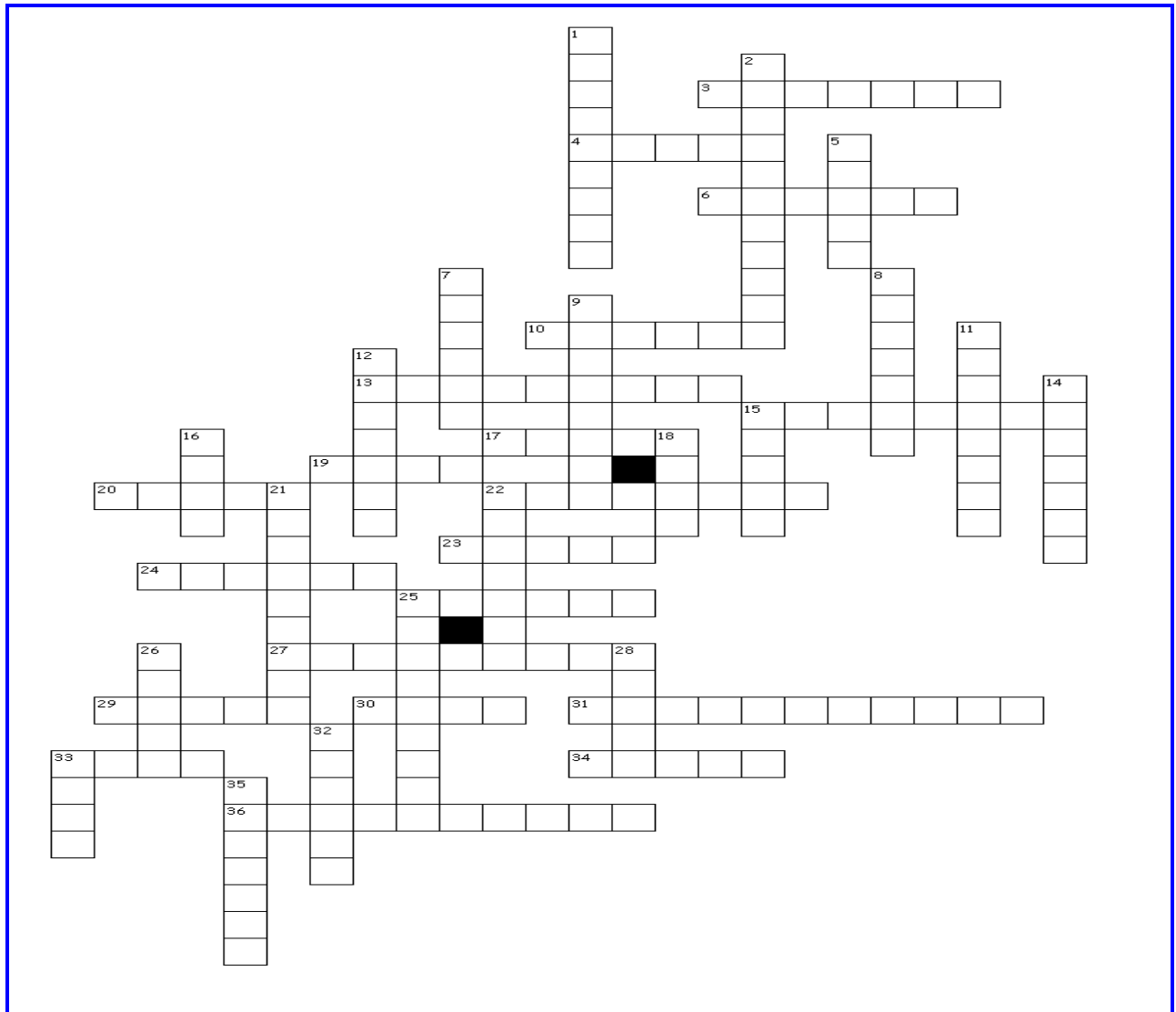
