# Lesson #186: "A Night on the Lake"

#### John 6:14 (KJV)

Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

This Sabbath boys and girls, we will begin a new chapter of our lesson entitle, "A Night on the Lake" in our study book Desire of Ages!

### **Deuteronomy 8:16 (KJV)**

Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

#### **Deuteronomy 8:2 (KJV)**

And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, [and] to prove thee, to know what [was] in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

#### **Deuteronomy 8:3 (KJV)**

And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

### John 6:13 (KJV)

Therefore they gathered [them] together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

### Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #40, pages 377-378

Seated upon the grassy plain, in the twilight of the spring evening, the people ate of the food that Christ had provided. The words they had heard that day had come to them as the voice of God. The works of healing they had witnessed were such as only divine power could perform. But the miracle of the loaves appealed to everyone in that vast multitude. All were sharers in its benefit. In the days of Moses, God had fed Israel with manna in the desert; and who was this that had fed them that day but He whom Moses had foretold? No human power could create from five barley loaves and two small fishes food sufficient to feed thousands of hungry people. And they said one to another, "This is of a truth that Prophet that should come into the world." {DA 377.1}

**Question:** Of all the miracles Jesus had performed, which one was the most appealing to everyone in that vast multitude? And, who was this that had fed them that day whom Moses had foretold?

Answer: The miracles of the loaves appealed to everyone in that vast multitude for all were sharers in its benefit. And, Jesus! No human power could create from five barley loaves and two small fishes food sufficient to feed thousands of hungry people.

Some day our raptured eyes shall see He's just the same Jesus Oh, blessèd day for you and me! The very same Jesus. **Refrain** 

The very same Jesus, The wonder working Jesus; Oh praise His Name, He's just the same The very same Jesus. All day the conviction has strengthened. That crowning act is assurance that the long-looked-for Deliverer is among them. The hopes of the people rise higher and higher. This is He who will make Judea an earthly paradise, a land flowing with milk and honey. He can satisfy every desire. He can break the power of the hated Romans. He can deliver Judah and Jerusalem. He can heal the soldiers who are wounded in battle. He can supply whole armies with food. He can conquer the nations, and give to Israel the long-sought dominion. **{DA 377.2}** 

**Question:** How did the crowning act of feeding thousands strengthen the people's conviction and what did it make them believe?

**Answer:** The hopes of the people rise higher and higher. This is He who will make Judea an earthly paradise, a land flowing with milk and honey.

In their enthusiasm the people are ready at once to crown Him king. They see that He makes no effort to attract attention or secure honor to Himself. In this He is essentially different from the priests and rulers, and they fear that He will never urge His claim to David's throne. Consulting together, they agree to take Him by force, and proclaim Him the king of Israel. The disciples unite with the multitude in declaring the throne of David the rightful inheritance of their Master. It is the modesty of Christ, they say, that causes Him to refuse such honor. Let the people exalt their Deliverer. Let the arrogant priests and rulers be forced to honor Him who comes clothed with the authority of God. {DA 378.1}

**Question:** What lead the disciples to believe that Jesus would not secure honor to Himself?

**Answer:** They see that He makes no effort to attract attention or secure honor to Himself. It is the modesty of Christ, they say, that causes Him to refuse such honor.

### Philippians 2:5-11 (KJV)

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant,

#### and was made in the likeness of men: (2 xs)

And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. (2 xs)

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;

And [that] every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ [is] Lord,

to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians chapter 2 verses 5 through 11 and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

They eagerly arrange to carry out their purpose; but Jesus sees what is on foot, and understands, as they cannot, what would be the result of such a movement. Even now the priests and rulers are hunting His life. They accuse Him of drawing the people away from them. Violence and insurrection would follow an effort to place Him on the throne, and the work of the spiritual kingdom would be hindered. Without delay the movement must be checked. Calling His disciples, Jesus bids them take the boat and return at once to Capernaum, leaving Him to dismiss the people. {DA 378.2}

**Question:** Why were the priests and rulers hunting Jesus life? And, what was the reason Jesus called and bid the disciple to return to Capernaum?

**Answer:** They accuse Him of drawing the people away from them. And, Jesus bids them take the boat and return at once to Capernaum, leaving Him to dismiss the people. Violence and insurrection would follow an effort to place Him on the throne, and the work of the spiritual kingdom would be hindered.

Never before had a command from Christ seemed so impossible of fulfillment. The disciples had long hoped for a popular movement to place Jesus on the throne; they could not endure the thought that all this enthusiasm should come to nothing. The multitudes that were assembling to keep the Passover were anxious to see the new prophet. To His followers this seemed the golden opportunity to establish their beloved Master on the throne of Israel. In the glow of this new ambition it was hard for them to go away by themselves, and leave Jesus alone upon that desolate shore. They protested against the arrangement; but Jesus now spoke with an authority He had never before assumed toward them. They knew that further opposition on their part would be useless, and in silence they turned toward the sea. {DA 378.3}

**Question:** What seem as a golden opportunity to establish their beloved Master on the throne of Israel?

Answer: The disciples had long hoped for a popular movement to place Jesus on the throne; the multitudes that were assembling to keep the Passover were anxious to see the new prophet.

**Question:** Why did Jesus now speak with an authority He had never before assumed toward the disciples?

**Answer:** They protested against the arrangement. They knew that further opposition on their part would be useless, and in silence they turned toward the sea.

These **attributes** are gained by doing kindly actions with a kindly heart. . . . Christians love those around them as precious souls for whom Christ has died. There is no such thing as a loveless Christian; for "God is love." . . . "This is my commandment, That ye love one another as I have loved you." This is the fruit that is to be given back to God. **{SD 102.3}** 


The Lord will help every one of us where we need help the most in the grand work of overcoming and conquering self. Let the law of kindness be upon your lips and the oil of grace in your heart. This will produce wonderful results. You will be tender, **sympathetic**, courteous. You need all these graces. The Holy Spirit must be received and brought into your character; then it will be as holy fire, giving forth incense which will rise up to God, not from lips that **condemn**, but as a healer of the souls of men. Your **countenance** will express the image of the divine. . . . God requires every soul in His service to kindle their censers from the **coals** of sacred fire. The common, severe, **harsh** words that come from your lips so readily must be **withheld**, and the Spirit of God speak through the human agent. By beholding the character of Christ you will become changed into His likeness. The grace of Christ alone can changed your heart and then you will reflect the image of the Lord Jesus. God calls upon us to be like Him, --pure, holy, and **undefiled**. We are to bear the divine image. **{SD 102.4}**

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


