## Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #45, pages 413-415

Peter had expressed the truth which is the foundation of the church's faith, and Jesus now honored him as the representative of the whole body of believers. He said, "I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." {DA 413.5}

"The keys of the kingdom of heaven" are the words of Christ. All the words of Holy Scripture are His, and are here included. These words have power to open and to shut heaven. They declare the conditions upon which men are received or rejected. Thus the work of those who preach God's word is a savor of life unto life or of death unto death. Theirs is a mission weighted with eternal results. **{DA 413.6}** 

**Question:** What did Peter express to be the foundation of the church' faith and what did Jesus give him in return for this truth? And, what are the keys of the kingdom of heaven and where are they found today?

Answer: The truth, Jesus honored him as the representative of the whole body of believers He said, "I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven. And, "The keys of the kingdom of heaven" are the words of Christ. All the words of Holy Scripture are His, and are here included.

## Scripture Singer Songs-The Living Word John 1:1-5 (KJV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God. (2 xs)** The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him;

John chapter 1:1 through 5

The Saviour did not commit the work of the gospel to Peter individually. At a later time, repeating the words that were spoken to Peter, He applied them directly to the church. And the same in substance was spoken also to the twelve as representatives of the body of believers. If Jesus had delegated any special authority to one of the disciples above the others, we should not find them so often contending as to who should be the greatest. They would have submitted to the wish of their Master, and honored the one whom He had chosen. {DA 414.1}

Instead of appointing one to be their head, Christ said to the disciples, "Be not ye called Rabbi;" "neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ." **Matthew 23:8, 10. {DA 414.2}** 

Question: Did the Saviour, because of His statement to Peter, commit the work of the gospel to him individually? And, what evidence would there have been if our Saviour had delegated special authority to one of the disciples above the others?

Answer: No! At a later time, repeating the words to the twelve as representatives of the body of believers also He applied them directly to the church. And, they would have submitted to the wish of their Master, and honored the one whom He had chosen.

"The head of every man is Christ." God, who put all things under the Saviour's feet, "gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him that filleth all in all." **1 Corinthians 11:3; Ephesians 1:22, 23**. The church is built upon Christ as its foundation; it is to obey Christ as its head. It is not to depend upon man, or be controlled by man. Many claim that a position of trust in the church gives them authority to dictate what other men shall believe and what they shall do. This claim God does not sanction. The Saviour declares, "All ye are brethren." All are exposed to temptation, and are liable to error. Upon no finite being can we depend for guidance. The Rock of faith is the living presence of Christ in the church. Upon this the weakest may depend, and those who think themselves the strongest will prove to be the weakest, unless they make Christ their efficiency. "Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm." The Lord "is the Rock, His work is perfect." "Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him." **Jeremiah 17:5; Deuteronomy 32:4; Psalm 2:12. {DA 414.3}** 

**Question:** Who is the head of every man and the head of church? And, on who is the foundation of the church built and to should depend upon?

**Answer:** "The head of every man is Christ." God, who put all things under the Saviour's feet, "gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him that filleth all in all." And, the church is built upon Christ as its foundation; it is to obey Christ as its head. It is not to depend upon man, or be controlled by man.

Question: Can we depend on the guidance of finite men and what does the scripture states? And, what did the Saviour declare why we shouldn't depend on man and who should we depend on?

Answer: No! Upon no finite being can we depend for guidance. "Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm." And, the Saviour declares, "All ye are brethren." All are exposed to temptation, and are liable to error. The Lord "is the Rock, His work is perfect." "Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him."

After Peter's confession, Jesus charged the disciples to tell no man that He was the Christ. This charge was given because of the determined opposition of the scribes and Pharisees. More than this, the people, and even the disciples, had so false a conception of the Messiah that a public announcement of Him would give them no true idea of His character or His work. But day by day He was revealing Himself to them as the Saviour, and thus He desired to give them a true conception of Him as the Messiah. **{DA 414.4}** 

**Question:** After Peter's confession, why did Jesus charge the disciples to tell no man that He was the Christ? And, what did the Saviour desire to give them?

Answer: This charge was given because of the determined opposition of the scribes and Pharisees. More than this, the people, and even the disciples, had so false a conception of the Messiah. And, a true conception of Him as the Messiah He was revealing Himself day by day.

The disciples still expected Christ to reign as a temporal prince. Although He had so long concealed His design, they believed that He would not always remain in poverty and obscurity; the time was near when He would establish His kingdom. That the hatred of the priests and rabbis would never be overcome, that Christ would be rejected by His own nation, condemned as a deceiver, and crucified as a malefactor,--such a thought the disciples had never entertained. But the hour of the power of darkness was drawing on, and Jesus must open to His disciples the conflict before them. He was sad as He anticipated the trial. {DA 415.1}

**Question:** What was still the disciple's expectation of their Master? And, what thought had the disciples never entertained and, why was Jesus sad?

Answer: The disciples still expected Christ to reign as a temporal prince; although He had so long concealed His design. And, that Christ would be rejected by His own nation, condemned as a deceiver, and crucified as a malefactor. And, He was sad as He anticipated the trial.

Our book selection this Sabbath is entitle, "Sons and Daughters of God" Chapter 4-From a Slave to Sin, to a Prince of God

And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed. Genesis 32:28. {SD 127.1}

Because of the **deception** practiced to secure his father's blessing, intended for Esau, Jacob had fled for his life, alarmed by his brother's deadly threats. After remaining for many years an exile, he had set out, at God's command, to return with his wives and children, his flocks and herds, to his native country. On reaching the borders of the land, he was filled with terror by the tidings of Esau's approach at the head of a band of warriors, **doubtless** bent upon **revenge**. . . . Having sent his family away, that they may not witness his distress, Jacob remains alone to intercede with God. **{SD 127.2}** 

Jacob, in the great crisis of his life, turned aside to pray. He was filled with one **overmastering** purpose,--to seek for **transformation** of character. But while he was pleading with God, an enemy, as he supposed, placed his hand upon him, and all night he wrestled for his life. But the purpose of his soul was not changed by peril of life itself. When his strength was nearly spent, the Angel put forth His divine power, and at His touch, Jacob knew Him with whom he had been contending. Wounded and helpless, he fell upon the Saviour's breast, pleading for a blessing. He would not be turned aside, nor cease his **intercession**, and Christ granted the **petition** of this helpless, **penitent** soul, according to His promise, "Let him take hold of my strength, that he may make peace with me. . . ." Jacob pleaded with determined spirit, "I will not let thee go, except thou bless me." This spirit of **persistence** was inspired by Him who wrestled with the patriarch. It was He who gave him the victory, and He changed his name from Jacob to Israel, saying, "As a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast **prevailed**." That for which Jacob had **vainly** wrestled in his own strength, was won through self-surrender and **steadfast** faith. **{SD 127.3}.**






