**Luke 4:18 (KJV)**

**The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,**

He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me.

**Mark 9:20 (KJV)**

**Matthew 17:19-20 (KJV)**

Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

**Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #47, pages 427-428**

As if He had been a witness of all that had occurred, the Saviour came to the scene of conflict, and fixing His gaze upon the scribes inquired, "What question ye with them?" {DA 427.4}

But the voices so bold and defiant before were now silent. A hush had fallen upon the entire company. Now the afflicted father made his way through the crowd, and falling at the feet of Jesus, poured out the story of his trouble and disappointment. {DA 427.5}

**Question:** Why did the Saviour say to the scribes, "What question ye with them?" And, what brought about a hush that had fallen upon the entire company?

**Answer:** He had been a witness of all that had occurred when He came to the scene of conflict with fix gaze upon them. And, His presence with the Heavenly touch the afflicted father made his way through the crowd falling at the feet of Jesus brought the voices so bold and defiant now silent.

"Master," he said, "I have brought unto Thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit; and wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: . . . and I spake to Thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not." {DA 428.1}

Jesus looked about Him upon the awe-stricken multitude, the caviling scribes, the perplexed disciples. He read the unbelief in every heart; and in a voice filled with sorrow He exclaimed, "O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you?" Then He bade the distressed father, "Bring thy son hither." {DA 428.2}

**Question:** What did the father of the son who had a dumb spirit say to the Master? And, what was Jesus' response to the distressed father with the heart of unbelief, the awe-stricken multitude, the caviling scribes and the perplexed disciples?

**Answer:** He said, "I have brought unto Thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit; and wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: I spake to Thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not." And, "O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you?"

The boy was brought, and as the Saviour's eyes fell upon him, the evil spirit cast him to the ground in convulsions of agony. He lay wallowing and foaming, rending the air with unearthly shrieks. {DA 428.3}

Again the Prince of life and the prince of the powers of darkness had met on the field of battle,--Christ in fulfillment of His mission to "preach deliverance to the captives, . . . to set at liberty them that are bruised" (Luke 4:18), Satan seeking to hold his victim under his control. Angels of light and the hosts of evil angels, unseen, were pressing near to behold the conflict. For a moment, Jesus permitted the evil spirit to display his power, that the beholders might comprehend the deliverance about to be wrought. {DA 428.4}

**Question:** What happened when the boy was brought forward, as the Saviour's eyes fell upon him? And, what two powers had met on the field of battle again?

**Answer:** The evil spirit cast him to the ground in convulsions of agony. He lay wallowing and foaming, rending the air with unearthly shrieks. And, the Prince of life and the prince of the powers of darkness! Christ in fulfillment of His mission to “preach deliverance to the captives.

**Song:** *Let's learn our first beautiful song together dear ones from the **book of Isaiah!***

### ***Isaiah 61:1-3 (KJV)***

The spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, **and the day** of vengeance of our God; (2 xs) to comfort all that mourn;

To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them that mourn beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

The spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, **and the day** of vengeance of our God; (2 xs)  
Isaiah chapter 61 verses 1 through 3  
to proclaim liberty to the captives.

The multitude looked on with bated breath, the father in an agony of hope and fear. Jesus asked, “How long is it ago since this came unto him?” The father told the story of long years of suffering, and then, as if he could endure no more, exclaimed, “If Thou canst do anything, have compassion on us, and help us.” “If Thou canst!” Even now the father questioned the power of Christ. {DA 428.5}

**Question:** What did Jesus ask the father who in an agony of hope and fear, before the multitude that was looking on with bated breath? And, what was the father's response?

**Answer:** “How long is it ago since this came unto him?” And, the father told the story of long years of suffering, and then, as if he could endure no more, exclaimed, “If Thou canst do anything, have compassion on us, and help us.”

Jesus answers, “If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.” There is no lack of power on the part of Christ; the healing of the son depends upon the father's faith. With a burst of tears, realizing his own weakness, the father casts himself upon Christ's mercy, with the cry, “Lord, I believe; help Thou mine unbelief.” {DA 428.6}

**Question:** What was Jesus' answer and on what did the healing of the son depend upon, for there is no lack of power on the part of Christ? And, why did the father with a burst of tears cast himself upon Christ with a cry for mercy?

**Answer:** “If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.” And, the healing of the son depends upon the father's faith. And, he was crying for the Lord to help him with his unbelief?

**Song:** *Let's learn another song scripture song together dear ones from the **book of Hebrews!***

***Hebrews 11:6 (KJV)***

But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]:  
for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, (2 xs)  
and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.  
Hebrews chapter 11 and verse 6

Jesus turns to the suffering one, and says, “Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.” There is a cry, an agonized struggle. The demon, in passing, seems about to rend the life from his victim. Then the boy lies motionless, and apparently lifeless. The multitude whisper, “He is dead.” But Jesus takes him by the hand, and lifting him up, presents him, in perfect soundness of mind and body, to his father. Father and son praise the name of their Deliverer. The multitude are “amazed at the mighty power of God,” while the scribes, defeated and crestfallen, turn sullenly away. {DA 428.7}

**Question:** What did Jesus turn to the suffering one, and say? And, what was the result of that command?

**Answer:** “Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.” There is a cry, an agonized struggle. The demon, in passing, seems about to rend the life from his victim. Then the boy lies motionless, and apparently lifeless, lifting him up in perfect soundness of mind and body.

**Song:** *Let's learn our last song scripture song together dear ones from the **book of Hebrews!***

**Chapter 5-In the Study of the Scriptures**

**And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself. Luke 24:27. {SD 134.1}**

After Joseph and Mary had searched for Him [Christ] for three days, they found Him in the court of the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. And all that heard Him were **astonished** at His understanding and answers. He asked His questions with a grace that charmed these learned men. . . . His mother could not but mark His words, His spirit, His willing obedience to all her **requirements**. {SD 134.2}

It is not correct to say, as many writers have said, that Christ was like all children. He was not like all children. Many children are **misguided** and **mismanaged**. But Joseph, and especially Mary, kept before them the remembrance of their child's divine Fatherhood. Jesus was instructed in accordance with the sacred character of His mission. His **inclination** to right was a constant **gratification** to His parents. {SD 134.3}

His **intimate acquaintance** with the Scriptures shows how **diligently** His early years were given to the study of God's Word. {SD 134.4}

Christ opened the Scriptures to His disciples, beginning at Moses and the prophets, and instructed them in all things concerning Himself, and also explained to them the **prophecies**. {SD 134.5}

He pointed to the Scriptures as of **unquestionable** authority, and we should do the same. {SD 134.6}

Every child may gain knowledge as Jesus did. As we try to become acquainted with our heavenly Father through His Word, angels will draw near, our minds will be strengthened, our characters will be **elevated**, and refined. {SD 134.7}

Like Christ, we should be able to meet the enemy in time of temptation with, “It is written.” {SD 134.8}.


