**Lesson #223 “Who Is the Greatest?” Part 4**

**Psalms 18:35 (KJV)**

**Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.**

**Isaiah 66:1 (KJV)**

Thus saith the LORD, The heaven [is] my throne, and the earth [is] my footstool: where [is] the house that ye build unto me? and where [is] the place of my rest?

**Isaiah 66:2 (KJV)**

For all those [things] hath mine hand made, and all those [things] have been, saith the LORD: but to this [man] will I look, [even] to [him that is] poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.

**Mark 9:38 (KJV)**

And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

**Mark 9:39 (KJV)**

But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.

**Mark 9:43 (KJV)**

And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

**Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #48, pages 437-438**

Again Jesus explained to the disciples that His kingdom is not characterized by earthly dignity and display. At the feet of Jesus all these distinctions are forgotten. The rich and the poor, the learned and the ignorant, meet together, with no thought of caste or worldly preeminence. All meet as blood-bought souls, alike dependent upon One who has redeemed them to God. {DA 437.2}

The sincere, contrite soul is precious in the sight of God. He places His own signet upon men, not by their rank, not by their wealth, not by their intellectual greatness, but by their oneness with Christ. The Lord of glory is satisfied with those who are meek and lowly in heart. "Thou hast also given me," said David, "the shield of Thy salvation: . . . and Thy gentleness"--as an element in the human character—"hath made me great." **Psalm 18:35.** {DA 437.3}

**Question:** Where do all meet as blood-bought souls where distinction are forgotten, where rich and poor, the learned and the ignorant, meet together, with no thought of caste or worldly preeminence? And, who are precious in the sight of God; and by what does He places His own signet upon men?

**Answer:** At the feet of Jesus all meet as blood-bought souls, alike dependent upon One who has redeemed them to God. And, the sincere, contrite soul; He places His own signet upon men, not by their rank, not by their wealth, not by their intellectual greatness, but by their oneness with Christ.

"Whosoever shall receive one of such children in My name," said Jesus, "receiveth Me: and whosoever shall receive Me, receiveth not Me, but Him that sent Me." "Thus saith the Lord, The heaven is My throne, and the earth is My footstool: . . . but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at My word." **Isaiah 66:1, 2.** {DA 437.4}

The Saviour's words awakened in the disciples a feeling of self-distrust. No one had been specially pointed out in the reply; but John was led to question whether in one case his action had been right. With the spirit of a child he laid the matter before Jesus. "Master," he said, "we saw one casting out devils in Thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbade him, because he followeth not us." {DA 437.5}

**Question:** Who did Jesus say that, "Whosoever shall receive one of such children in My name," whom have they received? And, what did the Saviour's words awakened in the disciples?

**Answer:** Jesus said, "receiveth Me: and whosoever shall receive Me, receiveth not Me, but Him that sent Me." And, The Saviour's words awakened in the disciples a feeling of self-distrust.

James and John had thought that in checking this man they had had in view their Lord's honor; they began to see that they were jealous for their own. They acknowledged their error, and accepted the reproof of Jesus, "Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in My name, that can lightly speak evil of Me." None who showed themselves in any way friendly to Christ were to be repulsed. There were many who had been deeply moved by the character and the work of Christ, and whose hearts were opening to Him in faith; and the disciples, who could not read motives, must be careful not to discourage these souls. When Jesus was no longer personally among them, and the work was left in their hands, they must not indulge a narrow, exclusive spirit, but manifest the same far-reaching sympathy which they had seen in their Master. {DA 437.6}

**Question:** What were the disciples, who could not read motives, be careful of doing and not to indulge in; when Jesus was no longer personally among them, and the work was left in their hands?

**Answer:** They must be careful not to discourage the souls who had been deeply moved by the character and the work of Christ, and whose hearts were opening to Him in faith. And, they must not indulge a narrow, exclusive spirit, but manifest the same far-reaching sympathy which they had seen in their Master.

The fact that one does not in all things conform to our personal ideas or opinions will not justify us in forbidding him to labor for God. Christ is the Great Teacher; we are not to judge or to command, but in humility each is to sit at the feet of Jesus, and learn of Him. Every soul whom God has made willing is a channel through which Christ will reveal His pardoning love. How careful we should be lest we discourage one of God's light bearers, and thus intercept the rays that He would have shine to the world! {DA 438.1}

**Question:** Would we be justified in forbidding souls to labor for God, who do not conform to our own personal ideas or opinions? And, what will every soul be as whom God has made a willing channel?

**Answer:** No! Christ is the Great Teacher; we are not to judge or to command, but in humility each is to sit at the feet of Jesus, and learn of Him. And, every soul God has made willing is a channel through which Christ will reveal His pardoning love.

Harshness or coldness shown by a disciple toward one whom Christ was drawing--such an act as that of John in forbidding one to work miracles in Christ's name--might result in turning the feet into the path of the enemy, and causing the loss of a soul. Rather than for one to do this, said Jesus, "it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea." And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: **Mark 9:43-45, {DA 438.2}**

**Question:** What will be the result should a disciple show harshness or coldness toward one whom Christ was drawing? And, rather than for one to do this, what did Jesus say about such person?

**Answer:** Such an act as that might result in turning the feet into the path of the enemy, and causing the loss of a soul; as that of John in forbidding one to work miracles in Christ's name. And, Jesus said, "it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea."

Why this earnest language, than which none can be stronger? Because "the Son of man is come to save that which was lost." Shall His disciples show less regard for the souls of their fellow men than the Majesty of heaven has shown? Every soul has cost an infinite price, and how terrible is the sin of turning one soul away from Christ, so that for him the Saviour's love and humiliation and agony shall have been in vain. **{DA 438.3}**

**Question:** Why did the Saviour speak this earnest language, than which none can be stronger? And, how important is it for us all to value this great regard for these precious souls?

**Answer:** Because "(Christ) the Son of man is come to save that which was lost." His disciples should show greater regard for the souls of their fellow men than the Majesty of heaven has shown. And, every soul has cost an infinite price, and how terrible is the sin of turning one soul away from Christ.

**Chapter 5-In Demonstrating God's Parental Attributes**

**Like as a father pitieth his children, so the Lord pitieth them that fear him.**

**Psalms 103:13. {SD 139.1}**

In all the gracious deeds that Jesus did, He sought to **impress** upon men the parental, **benevolent attributes** of God. In all His lessons He was seeking to teach men the wonderful truth that “God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” Jesus would have us understand the love of the Father, and He seeks to draw us to Him by presenting His parental grace. He would have the whole field of our vision filled with the perfection of God's character. In His prayer for His disciples He says, “I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world.” **{SD 139.2}**

Jesus came into the world to **illustrate** the character of God in His own life, and He swept back the **misrepresentations** that Satan had originated, and revealed the glory of God. It was only by living among men that He could reveal the mercy, **compassion**, and love of His heavenly Father; for it was only by actions of benevolence that He could set forth the grace of God. The unbelief of men was deep seated, and yet they could not resist the testimony of His **God-like** example, and His deeds of love and truth. **{SD 139.3}**

The **bounties** of God's **providence** speak to every soul, confirming Christ's testimony to the supreme goodness of His Father. The Lord would have His people realize that the blessings bestowed upon any object of creation are **proportionate** to the place that object occupies in the scale of creation. If even the wants of dumb animals are supplied, can we **appreciate** the blessings which God will bestow upon the beings formed in His image? **{SD 139.4}**


God is love, and He cares for us. “Like as a father **pitieth** his children, so the Lord pitieth them that fear him.” **{SD 139.5}**


