John 8:10 (KJV)

When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?

The Pharisees therefore said unto him, Thou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true.

Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #50, pages 461-462

He had not set aside the law given through Moses, nor infringed upon the authority of Rome. The accusers had been defeated. Now, their robe of pretended holiness torn from them, they stood, guilty and condemned, in the presence of Infinite Purity. They trembled lest the hidden iniquity of their lives should be laid open to the multitude; and one by one, with bowed heads and downcast eyes, they stole away, leaving their victim with the pitying Saviour. {DA 461.4}

Question: How were the accusers of our Saviour defeated? And, why did they tremble and what was their reactions right after their defeat?

Answer: They stood, guilty and condemned, in the presence of Infinite Purity. He had not set aside the law given through Moses, nor infringed upon the authority of Rome. And, lest the hidden iniquity of their lives should be laid open to the multitude; and one by one, with bowed heads and downcast eyes, they stole away.

Jesus arose, and looking at the woman said, "Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more." {DA 461.5}

Question: What did Jesus say to the woman as He arose? And, what was the woman's response as well as her Saviour's?

Answer: Looking at the woman He said, "Woman, where are those thine accusers? Hath no man condemned thee? And, she said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, "Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more."

Luke Chapter 6 verse 38

The woman had stood before Jesus, cowering with fear. His words, “He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone,” had come to her as a death sentence. She dared not lift her eyes to the Saviour's face, but silently awaited her doom. In astonishment she saw her accusers depart speechless and confounded; then those words of hope fell upon her ear, “Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.” Her heart was melted, and she cast herself at the feet of Jesus, sobbing out her grateful love, and with bitter tears confessing her sins. {DA 462.1}

Question: What was the reaction of the woman as she stood before Jesus? And what was His word as she silently awaited her doom? And, in astonishment, what did she saw her accusers do?

Answer: She was cowering with fear. His words was, “He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone,” And, they depart speechless and confounded.

Question: What were the words of hope that fell upon her ears from the Saviour's lips? And, what was her response to such love pour out towards her from Jesus?

Answer: “Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.” She dared not lift her eyes to the Saviour's face. And, she cast herself at the feet of Jesus, sobbing out her grateful love, and with bitter tears confessing her sins.

This was to her the beginning of a new life, a life of purity and peace, devoted to the service of God. In the uplifting of this fallen soul, Jesus performed a greater miracle than in healing the most grievous physical disease; He cured the spiritual malady which is unto death everlasting. This penitent woman became one of His most steadfast followers. With self-sacrificing love and devotion she repaid His forgiving mercy. {DA 462.2}

Question: What was the evidence of the woman's beginning of a new life of purity and peace, devoted to the service of God? And, what was a greater miracle done than the healing of the most grievous physical disease that Jesus performed?

Answer: This penitent woman became one of His most steadfast followers. With self-sacrificing love and devotion she repaid His forgiving mercy. And, He cured the spiritual malady which is unto death everlasting.

Scripture Song Singer-God's Love

Ezekiel 33:15 (KJV)

[If] the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed,
walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity;
he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezekiel 33:15

In His act of pardoning this woman and encouraging her to live a better life, the character of Jesus shines forth in the beauty of perfect righteousness. While He does not palliate sin, nor lessen the sense of guilt, He seeks not to condemn, but to save. The world had for this erring woman only contempt and scorn; but Jesus speaks words of comfort and hope. The Sinless One pities the weakness of the sinner, and reaches to her a helping hand. While the hypocritical Pharisees denounce, Jesus bids her, "Go, and sin no more." {DA 462.3}

Question: What shined forth from Jesus in His act of pardoning this woman and encouraging her to live a better life? And, what did the world and our Saviour have for this erring woman?

Answer: The character of Jesus shines forth in the beauty of perfect righteousness. While He does not palliate sin, nor lessen the sense of guilt, He seeks not to condemn, but to save. And, the world had only contempt and scorn; but Jesus speaks words of comfort and hope.

It is not Christ's follower that, with averted eyes, turns from the erring, leaving them unhindered to pursue their downward course. Those who are forward in accusing others, and zealous in bringing them to justice, are often in their own lives more guilty than they. Men hate the sinner, while they love the sin. Christ hates the sin, but loves the sinner. This will be the spirit of all who follow Him. Christian love is slow to censure, quick to discern penitence, ready to forgive, to encourage, to set the wanderer in the path of holiness, and to stay his feet therein. {DA 462.4}

Question: What is said of those who are forward in accusing others, and zealous in bringing them to justice? And, how is Christian love described in obedience to Christ' saying, "He hates the sin, but loves the sinner?" And, are His followers to have the same spirit?

Answer: They are often in their own lives more guilty than they. Men hate the sinner, while they love the sin. Christian love is slow to censure, quick to discern penitence, ready to forgive, to encourage, to set the wanderer in the path of holiness. And, yes! This will be the spirit of all who follow Him.

You are to show forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. **{SD 150.2}**

Those who have experienced the love of Christ cannot be **idlers** in the Master's vineyard. They will see opportunities for helping others in their steps to Christ. Partaking of Christ's love, they will labor for the souls of others. Let every soul copy the Pattern, and become **missionaries** in the highest sense, winning souls to Jesus. **{SD 150.3}**

In view of what Christ has done for us, and what He suffered for sinners, we should, out of pure, disinterested love for souls, imitate His example by sacrificing our own pleasure and **convenience** for their good. The joy set before Christ, which sustained Him in all His sufferings, was the salvation of poor sinners. This should be our joy, and the spur of our **ambition** in the cause of our Master. In so doing we please God, and manifest our love and **devotion** to Him as His servants. He first loved us, and withheld not from us His beloved Son, but gave Him from His **bosom** to die that we might live. Love, true love, for our fellow-men, **evinces** love to God. **{SD 150.4}**

Those who are in **vital** contact with Christ will manifest it in their actions. . . . They will win souls to Christ, and bring sheaves to the heavenly garner. **{SD 150.5}**


