

Continuing:

“When I am weak, then am I strong.”


2 Corinthians 12:10.

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





to see the Invisible.





to these humble men.
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




**Continuing:

Chapter 6-Happy Home Atmosphere Promotes Health

Happy is that people, whose God is the Lord. Psalm 144:15

{SD 168.1}

A home where love dwells and where it finds **expression** in looks, in words, in acts, is a place where angels delight to dwell. . . . {SD 168.2}

Let the sunshine of love, cheer, and happy content enter your own hearts, and let its sweet influence pervade the home. . . . The **atmosphere** thus created will be to the children what air and sunshine are to the vegetable world, promoting health and vigor of mind and body.

{SD 168.3}

Educate the soul to **cheerfulness**, to thankfulness, and to the expression of **gratitude** to God for the great love wherewith He hath loved us. . . . Christian cheerfulness is the very beauty of holiness. {SD 168.4}

While grief and **anxiety** cannot remedy a single evil, they can do great harm; but cheerfulness and hope, while they brighten the pathway of others, "are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh." {SD 168.5}

The mother should cultivate a cheerful, contented, happy **disposition**. Every effort in this direction will be abundantly repaid in both the physical well-being and the moral character of her children. A cheerful spirit will promote the happiness of her family, and in a very great degree improve her own health. {SD 168.6}

The healthfulness of youth requires exercise, cheerfulness, and a happy, **pleasant** atmosphere surrounding them, for the development of physical health and **symmetrical** character. {SD 168.7}

As children of the light, God would have us **cultivate** a cheerful, happy spirit, that we may show forth the praises of Him who hath called us out of darkness into His **marvelous** light. {SD 168.8}


