John 11:55 (KJV)

And the Jews' passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the passover, to purify themselves.

“The Law of the New Kingdom” in our lesson book, Desire of Ages!***

Mark 10:37 (KJV)

They said unto him, Grant unto us that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and the other on thy left hand, in thy glory.

Mark 10:38 (KJV)

But Jesus said unto them, Ye know not what ye ask: can ye drink of the cup that I drink of? and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?

Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #60, pages 547- 548

The time of the Passover was drawing near, and again Jesus turned toward Jerusalem. In His heart was the peace of perfect oneness with the Father's will, and with eager steps He pressed on toward the place of sacrifice. But a sense of mystery, of doubt and fear, fell upon the disciples. The Saviour "went before them: and they were amazed; and as they followed, they were afraid." {DA 547.1}

Question: What was in the heart of Jesus while he turned toward Jerusalem as the Passover was drawing near? And, what fell upon the disciple over the same seen?

Answer: In His heart was the peace of perfect oneness with the Father's will, and with eager steps He pressed on toward the place of sacrifice. And, a sense of mystery, doubt and fear.

Again Christ called the twelve about Him, and with greater definiteness than ever before, He opened to them His betrayal and sufferings. "Behold," He said, "we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished. For He shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on: and they shall scourge Him, and put Him to death: and the third day He shall rise again. And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken." {DA 547.2}

Question: Did the disciples understand what Christ shared with them? And, where these things hid or known to them?

Answer: They understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.

Had they not just before proclaimed everywhere, "The kingdom of heaven is at hand"? Had not Christ Himself promised that many should sit down with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of God? Had He not promised to all who had left aught for His sake a hundredfold in this life, and a part in His kingdom? And had He not given to the twelve the special promise of positions of high honor in His kingdom,--to sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel? Even now He had said that all things written in the prophets concerning Him should be fulfilled. And had not the prophets foretold the glory of the Messiah's reign?

In the light of these thoughts, His words in regard to betrayal, persecution, and death seemed vague and shadowy. Whatever difficulties might intervene, they believed that the kingdom was soon to be established. {DA 547.3}

Question: How many promises did the disciples hear Jesus proclaim everywhere? And, what did they seem His words to be in the light of these thoughts; as well as believed about the kingdom?

Answer: As many that were written in the prophets concerning Him that should be fulfilled. And, in regard to betrayal, persecution, and death they seemed vague and shadowy to them. Whatever difficulties might intervene, they believed that the kingdom was soon to be established

that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature,
having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

2 Peter 1 verse 4

John, the son of Zebedee, had been one of the first two disciples who had followed Jesus. He and his brother James had been among the first group who had left all for His service. Gladly they had forsaken home and friends that they might be with Him; they had walked and talked with Him; they had been with Him in the privacy of the home, and in the public assemblies. He had quieted their fears, delivered them from danger, relieved their sufferings, comforted their grief, and with patience and tenderness had taught them, till their hearts seemed linked with His, and in the ardor of their love they longed to be nearest to Him in His kingdom. At every possible opportunity, John took his place next the Saviour, and James longed to be honored with as close connection with Him. {DA 548.1}

Question: Whom were the first two disciples who had followed Jesus and what did they do? And, what did Jesus do for them?

Answer: John, the son of Zebedee and his brother James had been among the first group who had left all for His service. He had quieted their fears, delivered them from danger, relieved their sufferings, comforted their grief, and with patience and tenderness had taught them, till their hearts seemed linked with His.

Their mother was a follower of Christ, and had ministered to Him freely of her substance. With a mother's love and ambition for her sons, she coveted for them the most honored place in the new kingdom. For this she encouraged them to make request. {DA 548.2}

Together the mother and her sons came to Jesus, asking that He would grant a petition on which their hearts were set. {DA 548.3}

"What would ye that I should do for you?" He questioned. {DA 548.4}

The mother answered, "Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on Thy right hand, and the other on the left, in Thy kingdom." {DA 548.5}

Question: What did John and James' mother do for Christ? And, what did Jesus ask of her petition and what was her answer?

Answer: Their mother was a follower of Christ, and had ministered to Him freely of her substance. And, "What would ye that I should do for you?" She answered "Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on Thy right hand, and the other on the left, in Thy kingdom."

Jesus bears tenderly with them, not rebuking their selfishness in seeking preference above their brethren. He reads their hearts, He knows the depth of their attachment to Him. Their love is not a mere human affection; though defiled by the earthliness of its human channel, it is an outflowing from the fountain of His own redeeming love. He will not rebuke, but deepen and purify. He said, "Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" They recall His mysterious words, pointing to trial and suffering, yet answer confidently, "We are able." They would count it highest honor to prove their loyalty by sharing all that is to befall their Lord. {DA 548.6}

Question: How did Jesus bears with them? And, what did the disciples answer confidently pointing to trial and suffering as they recall His mysterious words?

Answer: Jesus bears tenderly with them, not rebuking their selfishness in seeking preference above their brethren. He reads their hearts; He knows the depth of their attachment to Him. And, "We are able." They would count it highest honor to prove their loyalty by sharing all that is to befall their Lord.

Chapter 7-To Enjoy Perfect Love

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment.
He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 1 John 4:18. {SD 193.1}

This is an important statement; for there are many who desire to love and serve God, and yet when **afflictions** comes upon them, they do not **discern** the love of God in it, but the hand of the enemy. They mourn and **murmur** and complain; but this is not the fruit of love to God in the soul. If we have perfect love, we shall know that God is not seeking to injure us, but that in the midst of trials, and griefs, and pains, He is seeking to make us perfect, and to test the quality of our faith. When we **cease** to worry about the future, and begin to believe that God loves us, and means to do us good, we shall trust Him as a child trusts a loving parent. Then our troubles and **torments** will disappear, and our will be swallowed up in the will of God. {SD 193.2}

Through an abiding Christ you will become **Christlike** in character. The Lord desires you to stand by His side, as a kind, patient, humble son of God. The Lord designs that the laborers in His service shall represent His love. . . . {SD 193.3}

Our relations with one another should be pleasant. When we do right, the testimony of our own spirit and the testimony of the Spirit of God bear witness that the human mind is under the control of the divine mind. . . . His Word furnishes evidence from which we may draw the **conclusion** that we are indeed His sons and daughters. . . . True love for God carries with it true, **reverential** trust. And he who loves God will love his brother also. {SD 193.4}

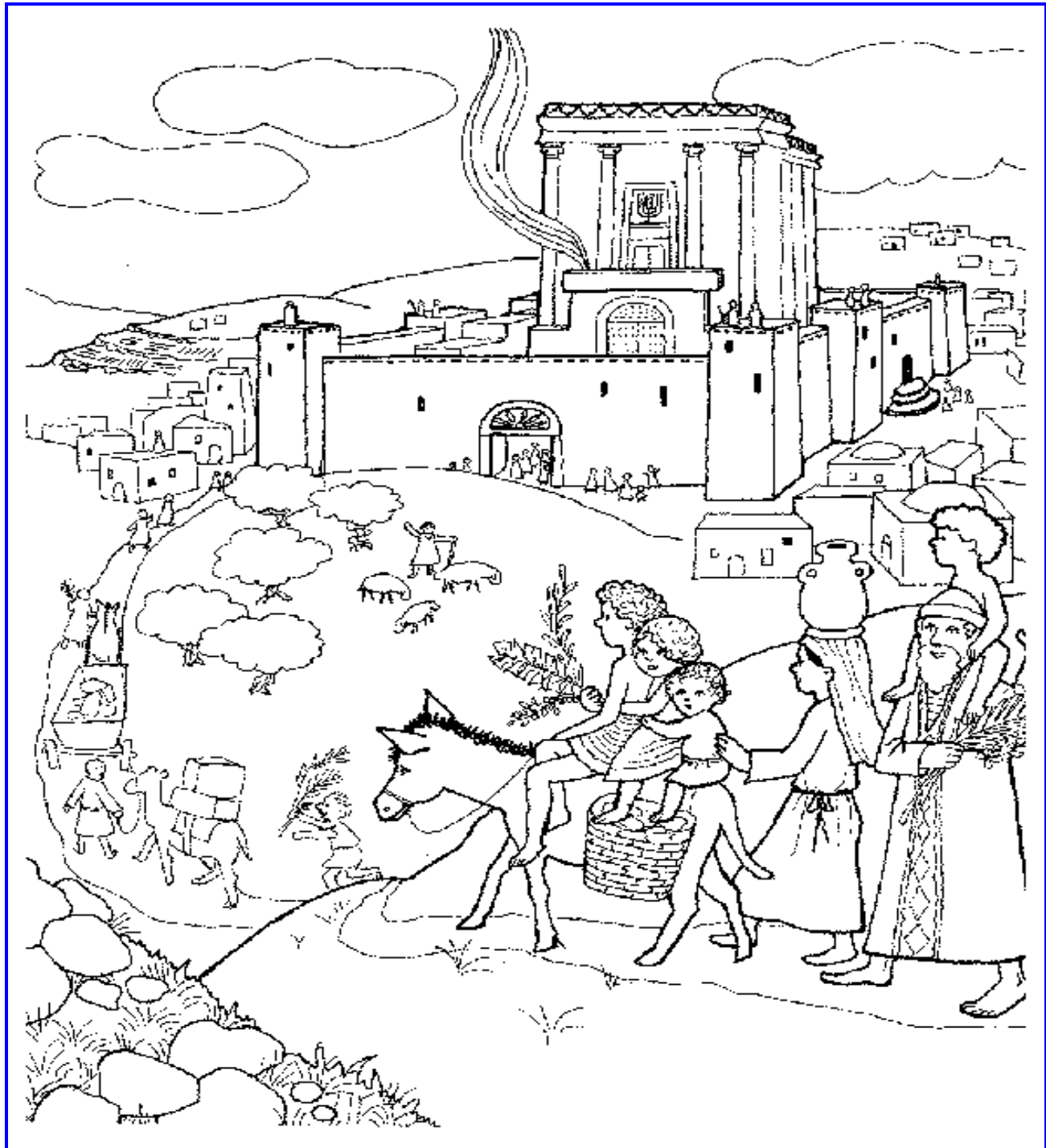

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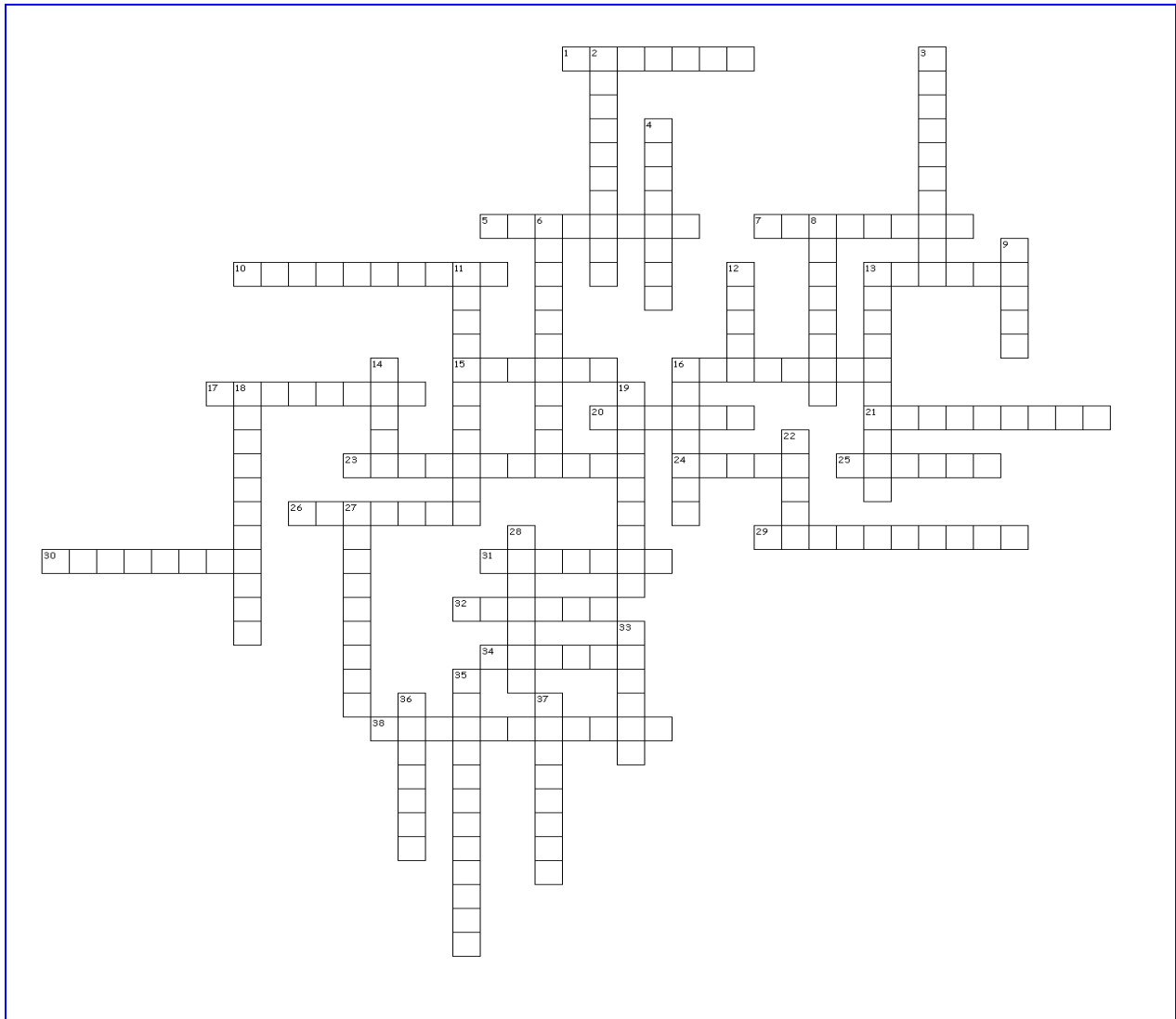
