Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #60, pages 548- 550

“Ye shall drink indeed of My cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with,” He said; before Him a cross instead of a throne, two malefactors His companions at His right hand and His left. John and James were to share with their Master in suffering; the one, first of the brethren to perish with the sword; the other, longest of all to endure toil, and reproach, and persecution. {DA 548.7}

Question: How did Christ drink His cup and was baptized with the baptism in this paragraph? And, what did Jesus mean when He said, “Ye shall drink indeed of My cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?”

Answer: Before Him a cross instead of a throne, two malefactors His companions at His right hand and His left. And, He meant that, John and James were to share with their Master in suffering; the one, first of the brethren to perish with the sword; the other, longest of all to endure toil, and reproach, and persecution.

“But to sit on My right hand, and on My left,” He continued, “is not Mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of My Father.” In the kingdom of God, position is not gained through favoritism. It is not earned, nor is it received through an arbitrary bestowal. It is the result of character. The crown and the throne are the tokens of a condition attained; they are the tokens of self-conquest through our Lord Jesus Christ. {DA 549.1}

Question: To whom and by who is to be given to sit on Jesus right hand, and on His left? And, by what condition is the kingdom of God to be gain and the result of?

Answer: It shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of My Father. And, It is the result of character. The crown and the throne are the tokens of a condition attained; they are the tokens of self-conquest through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Long afterward, when the disciple had been brought into sympathy with Christ through the fellowship of His sufferings, the Lord revealed to John what is the condition of nearness in His kingdom. "To him that overcometh," Christ said, "will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne." "Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of My God, . . . and I will write upon him My new name." **Revelation 3:21, 12.** So Paul the apostle wrote, "I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, shall give me at that day." **2 Timothy 4:6-8.** {DA 549.2}

Question: What is the condition of nearness in His kingdom did the Lord reveal to John? And, what shall He write upon them?

Answer: "To him that overcometh," Christ said, "will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne." Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go no more out. And, the name of My God, . . . and I will write upon him My new name.

2 Timothy Chapter 4 verses 6 through 8

The one who stands nearest to Christ will be he who on earth has drunk most deeply of the spirit of His self-sacrificing love,--love that "vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, . . . seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil" (**1 Corinthians 13:4, 5**),--love that moves the disciple, as it moved our Lord, to give all, to live and labor and sacrifice, even unto death, for the saving of humanity. This spirit was made manifest in the life of Paul. He said, "For to me to live is Christ;" for his life revealed Christ to men; "and to die is gain,"--gain to Christ; death itself would make manifest the power of His grace, and gather souls to Him. "Christ shall be magnified in my body," he said, "whether it be by life or by death." **Philippians 1:21, 20.** {DA 549.3}

Question: Who will be the ones who will stand nearest to Christ? And, what as well as who had move the disciple to give for the saving of humanity?

Answer: He who on earth has drunk most deeply of the spirit of His self-sacrificing love,--love that "vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil. And, love that moves the disciple, as it moved our Lord, to give all, to live and labor and sacrifice, even unto death, for the saving of humanity.

When the ten heard of the request of James and John, they were much displeased. The highest place in the kingdom was just what every one of them was seeking for himself, and they were angry that the two disciples had gained a seeming advantage over them. {DA 549.4}

Again the strife as to which should be greatest seemed about to be renewed, when Jesus, calling them to Him, said to the indignant disciples, “Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and their great ones exercise authority upon them. But so shall it not be among you.” {DA 550.1}

Question: What reaction and why did the ten heard about the request of James and John? And, calling them to Him, what did Jesus said to the indignant disciples for the strife as to which should be greatest seemed about to be renewed?

Answer: They were much displeased and they were angry that the two disciples had gained a seeming advantage over them. And, “Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and their great ones exercise authority upon them. But so shall it not be among you.”

In the kingdoms of the world, position meant self-aggrandizement. The people were supposed to exist for the benefit of the ruling classes. Influence, wealth, education, were so many means of gaining control of the masses for the use of the leaders. The higher classes were to think, decide, enjoy, and rule; the lower were to obey and serve. Religion, like all things else, was a matter of authority. The people were expected to believe and practice as their superiors directed. The right of man as man, to think and act for himself, was wholly unrecognized. {DA 550.2}

Question: What position as well as influence, wealth, education mean in the kingdoms of the world? And, what were the people expected to believe and practice and was wholly unrecognized?

Answer: Position meant self-aggrandizement; as influence, wealth, education, were many means of gaining control of the masses for the use of the leaders. And, as their superiors directed to think, decide, enjoy, and rule; the lower were to obey and serve like all things else, was a matter of authority. And the right of man as man, to think and act for himself

Chapter 7-To Live in Harmony With His Law

Be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest. Joshua 1:7. {SD 194.1}

God calls for men,--for those who in His sight will be true. Reforms must be brought about in the churches. There is now great need of reinstating in the hearts of men and women an old-time reverence for the ten commandments. Through obedience to these **commandments**, humanity is to be sanctified, that the results of **skepticism** shall not be strengthened, but that the foundation of our faith shall be made manifest, and all the precepts of God's holy law enforced. The **realization** of individual responsibility is to be **awakened**. Men are to remember that in order to be regarded as men by the Lord, their course of action must be just, pure, and true. {SD 194.2}

Men and women may shun the reproach they are called upon to bear for Christ's sake, they may do the works of the children of transgressors, but as surely as they do this, they will receive the reward of the **evildoer**. They may climb to places of distinction, they may stand high in the literary world, and with proud **superiority** they may resist the truth of heavenly origin; but in the end they will lose all. {SD 194.3}


Our happiness and salvation depend upon eating the bread of life; that is, obeying the words and doing the works of Christ, advancing righteousness and restraining **unrighteousness**. Nothing can give such **self-reliance**, such courage, such an increase of talents and ability, as a true **estimate** of the requirements of God's law. . . . Love for Jesus Christ leads us to obey God's commandments, which are a lamp to our feet and a light to our path, securing for us the **illuminating**, purifying, **blissful** presence of both the Father and the Son. He who is **obedient** can commune with God even as did Enoch. {SD 194.4}




