Lesson #280 “Zacchaeus” Part 2

Luke 19:8 (KJV)

And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore [him] fourfold.

Let's continue in our book *Desire of Ages*, Chapter #61, pages 554- 555

The multitude give way, and Zacchaeus, walking as in a dream, leads the way toward his own home. But the rabbis look on with scowling faces, and murmur in discontent and scorn, “that He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.” {DA 554.1}

Zacchaeus had been overwhelmed, amazed, and silenced at the love and condescension of Christ in stooping to him, so unworthy. Now love and loyalty to his new-found Master unseal his lips. He will make public his confession and his repentance. {DA 554.2}

Question: Why did the multitude give way, while Zacchaeus, walking as in a dream led the way toward his own home? And, why was he overwhelmed, amazed, and silenced?

Answer: The rabbis look on with scowling faces, and murmur in discontent and scorn, “that He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.” And, It was at the love and condescension of Christ in stooping to him, so unworthy.

“And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forasmuch as he also is a son of Abraham.” {DA 555.2}

When the rich young ruler had turned away from Jesus, the disciples had marveled at their Master's saying, “How hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!” They had exclaimed one to another, “Who then can be saved?” Now they had a demonstration of the truth of Christ's words, “The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.” **Mark 10:24, 26; Luke 18:27.** They saw how, through the grace of God, a rich man could enter into the kingdom. {DA 555.3}

Question: What had the disciples marveled at their regarding Master's saying, when the rich young ruler had turned away from Jesus? And, what demonstration of the truth of Christ's words did they have and, what through the grace of God did they also see?

Answer: “How hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!” And, “The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.” That, a rich man could enter into the kingdom.

Before Zacchaeus had looked upon the face of Christ, he had begun the work that made him manifest as a true penitent. Before being accused by man, he had confessed his sin. He had yielded to the conviction of the Holy Spirit, and had begun to carry out the teaching of the words written for ancient Israel as well as for ourselves. The Lord had said long before, “If thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: yea, though he be a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee. Take thou no usury of him, or increase: but fear thy God; that thy brother may live with thee. Thou shalt not give him thy money upon usury, nor lend him thy victuals for increase.” “Ye shall not therefore oppress one another; but thou shalt fear thy God.” **Leviticus 25:35-37, 17**. These words had been spoken by Christ Himself when He was enshrouded in the pillar of cloud, and the very first response of Zacchaeus to the love of Christ was in manifesting compassion toward the poor and suffering. **{DA 555.4}**

Question: What work did Zacchaeus begin that made him manifest as a true penitent before he had looked upon the face of Christ? And, what did the Lord say long before?

Answer: He had confessed his sin, yielding to the conviction of the Holy Spirit, and begun to carry out the teaching of the words written for ancient Israel as well as for ourselves. And, if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: yea, though he be a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.

Question: Where did those words come from that the Lord had said long before and was spoken by Christ Himself? And, what was Zacchaeus very first response to the love of Christ?

Answer: These words had been spoken by Christ Himself when He was enshrouded in the pillar of cloud. And, the very first response was in manifesting compassion toward the poor and suffering.

Among the publicans there was a confederacy, so that they could oppress the people, and sustain one another in their fraudulent practices. In their extortion they were but carrying out what had become an almost universal custom. Even the priests and rabbis who despised them were guilty of enriching themselves by dishonest practices under cover of their sacred calling. But no sooner did Zacchaeus yield to the influence of the Holy Spirit than he cast aside every practice contrary to integrity. {DA 555.5}

Question: What was a confederacy among the publicans there as well as what was that their extortion to carry out? And, what were even the priests and rabbis who despised them were guilty of?

Answer: That they could oppress the people, and sustain one another in their fraudulent practices. In their extortion they were but carrying out what had become an almost universal custom. And, they were guilty of enriching themselves by dishonest practices under cover of their sacred calling.

Chapter 7-Sense of God's Presence Banishes Fear

**Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed:
for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. Joshua 1:9.
{SD 197.1}**

Only the sense of God's presence can **banish** the fear that, for the timid child, would make life a burden. Let him fix in his memory the promise, "The angel of the Lord encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them." Let him read that wonderful story of Elisha in the mountain city, and, between him and the hosts of armed foemen, a mighty encircling band of heavenly angels. Let him read how to Peter, in prison and condemned to death, God's angel appeared; how, past the armed guards, the **massive** doors and great iron gateway with their **bolts** and bars, the angel led God's servant forth in safety. Let him read of that scene on the sea, when to the **tempest-tossed** soldiers and seamen, worn with labor and watching and long fasting, Paul the prisoner, on his way to trial and **execution**, spoke those grand words of courage and hope: "Be of good cheer; for there shall be no loss of any man's life among you. . . . For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve, saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before **Caesar**; and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee." In the faith of this promise Paul **assured** his companions, "There shall not a hair fall from the head of any of you." So it came to pass. Because there was in that ship one man through whom God could work, the whole **ship-load** of **heathen** soldiers and sailors was preserved. . . . {SD 197.2}


Let the **self-distrustful**, whose lack of **self-reliance** leads them to shrink from care and responsibility, be taught reliance upon God. Thus many a one who otherwise would be but a **cipher** in the world, perhaps only a helpless burden, will be able to say with the apostle Paul, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." {SD 197.3}




