Let's continue in our book *Desire of Ages*, Chapter #61, pages 555- 556

No repentance is genuine that does not work reformation. The righteousness of Christ is not a cloak to cover unconfessed and unforsaken sin; it is a principle of life that transforms the character and controls the conduct. Holiness is wholeness for God; it is the entire surrender of heart and life to the indwelling of the principles of heaven. {DA 555.6}

Question: How is repentance known to be genuine in nature? And, what is the righteousness of Christ not a cloak to cover and what it is for?

Answer: No repentance is genuine that does not work reformation. And, is not a cloak to cover unconfessed and unforsaken sin; it is a principle of life that transforms the character and controls the conduct.

In every transaction he is to make it manifest that God is his teacher. "Holiness unto the Lord" is to be written upon daybooks and ledgers, on deeds, receipts, and bills of exchange. Those who profess to be followers of Christ, and who deal in an unrighteous manner, are bearing false witness against the character of a holy, just, and merciful God. Every converted soul will, like Zacchaeus, signalize the entrance of Christ into his heart by an abandonment of the unrighteous practices that have marked his life. Like the chief publican, he will give proof of his sincerity by making restitution. The Lord says, "If the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity; . . . none of his sins that he hath committed shall be mentioned unto him: . . . He shall surely live." **Ezekiel 33:15, 16. {DA 556.1}**

Question: What is the Christian in his business life to represent to the world? And, where should, "Holiness unto the Lord" be written upon?

Answer: The manner in which our Lord would conduct business enterprises, in every transaction he is to make it manifest that God is his teacher. And, it's to be written upon daybooks and ledgers, on deeds, receipts, and bills of exchange.

Question: What do those who profess to be followers of Christ as well as deal in an unrighteous manner do? And, like Zacchaeus, what will every converted soul do?

Answer: They are bearing false witness against the character of a holy, just, and merciful God. And, they will signalize the entrance of Christ into his heart by an abandonment of the unrighteous practices that have marked his life giving proof of his sincerity by making restitution.

Ezekiel 33:15

If we have injured others through any unjust business transaction, if we have overreached in trade, or defrauded any man, even though it be within the pale of the law, we should confess our wrong, and make restitution as far as lies in our power. It is right for us to restore not only that which we have taken, but all that it would have accumulated if put to a right and wise use during the time it has been in our possession. {DA 556.2}

Question: What things does the paragraph say we should confess our wrong, and make restitution as far as lies in our power? And, should only that which we have taken be right for us to restore?

Answer: If we have injured others through any unjust business transaction, if we have overreached in trade, or defrauded any man, even though it be within the pale of the law. And, no! but all that it would have accumulated if put to a right and wise use during the time it has been in our possession.

To Zacchaeus the Saviour said, "This day is salvation come to this house." Not only was Zacchaeus himself blessed, but all his household with him. Christ went to his home to give him lessons of truth, and to instruct his household in the things of the kingdom. They had been shut out from the synagogues by the contempt of rabbis and worshipers; but now, the most favored household in all Jericho, they gathered in their own home about the divine Teacher, and heard for themselves the words of life. {DA 556.3}

Question: What did the Saviour say to Zacchaeus as well as to all who were also blessed by this statement made to him? And, what did Christ go to his home to do and why?

Answer: "This day is salvation come to this house." Not only was Zacchaeus himself blessed, but all his household with him. And, to give him lessons of truth, and to instruct his household in the things of the kingdom. They had been shut out from the synagogues by the contempt of rabbis and worshipers.

For "they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham." **Galatians 3:7. {DA 556.4}**

Question: When does salvation comes to the soul? And, did Zacchaeus receive Jesus just merely as a passing guest in his home? And, why did He recognize him as a son of Abraham despite been accused as a sinner by the scribes and Pharisees?

Answer: It is when Christ is received as a personal. And, no! But as One to abide in the soul temple. And, for "they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham." Despite they murmured against Christ for becoming his guest.

Chapter 7-God's Goodness and Mercy Inspire Courage

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever. Psalm 23:6. {SD 198.1}

Christ has given us no **assurance** that to attain to perfection of character is an easy matter. It is a **conflict**, a battle and a march, day by day. It is through much **tribulation** that we enter the kingdom of heaven. In order to share with Christ in His glory we must share in His suffering. . . . He has overcome for us. Shall we, then, be timid and **cowardly** because of the trials that we meet as we advance? . . . {SD 198.2}

When we have a deeper **appreciation** of the mercy and **loving-kindness** of God, we shall praise Him, instead of complaining. We shall talk of the loving watchcare of the Lord, of the tender compassion of the Good Shepherd. The language of the heart will not be selfish murmuring and repining. Praise, like a clear, flowing stream, will come from God's truly believing ones. They will say, “Goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.” . . . {SD 198.3}

Why not awake the voice of spiritual song in the days of our **pilgrimage**? . . . We need to study God's Word, to meditate and pray. Then we shall have spiritual eyesight to **discern** the inner courts of the **celestial** temple. We shall catch the notes of thanksgiving sung by the heavenly choir around the throne. When Zion shall arise and shine, her light will be most penetrating, and songs of praise and thanksgiving will be heard in the assembly of the saints. Little **disappointments** and difficulties will be lost sight of. {SD 198.4}

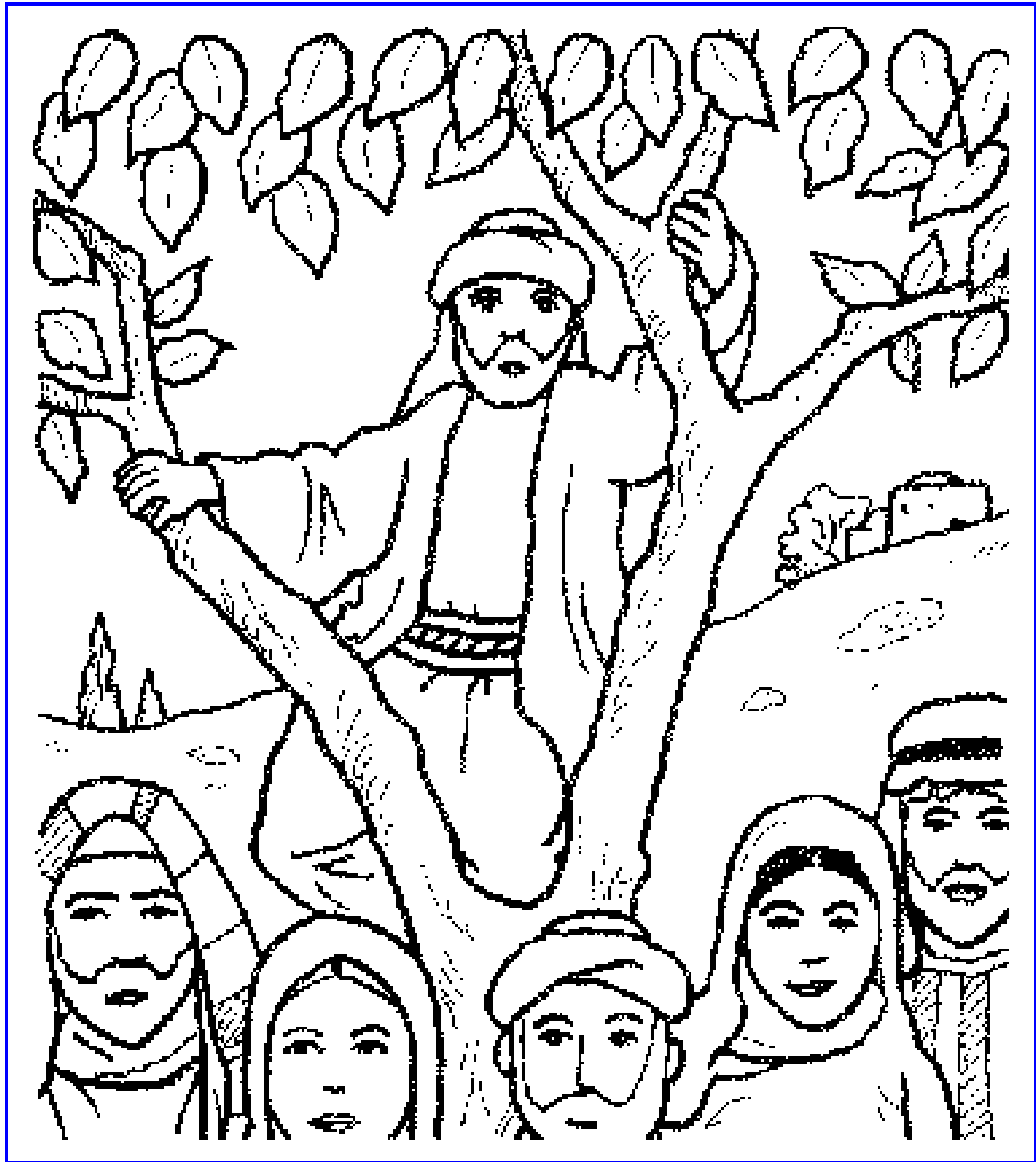

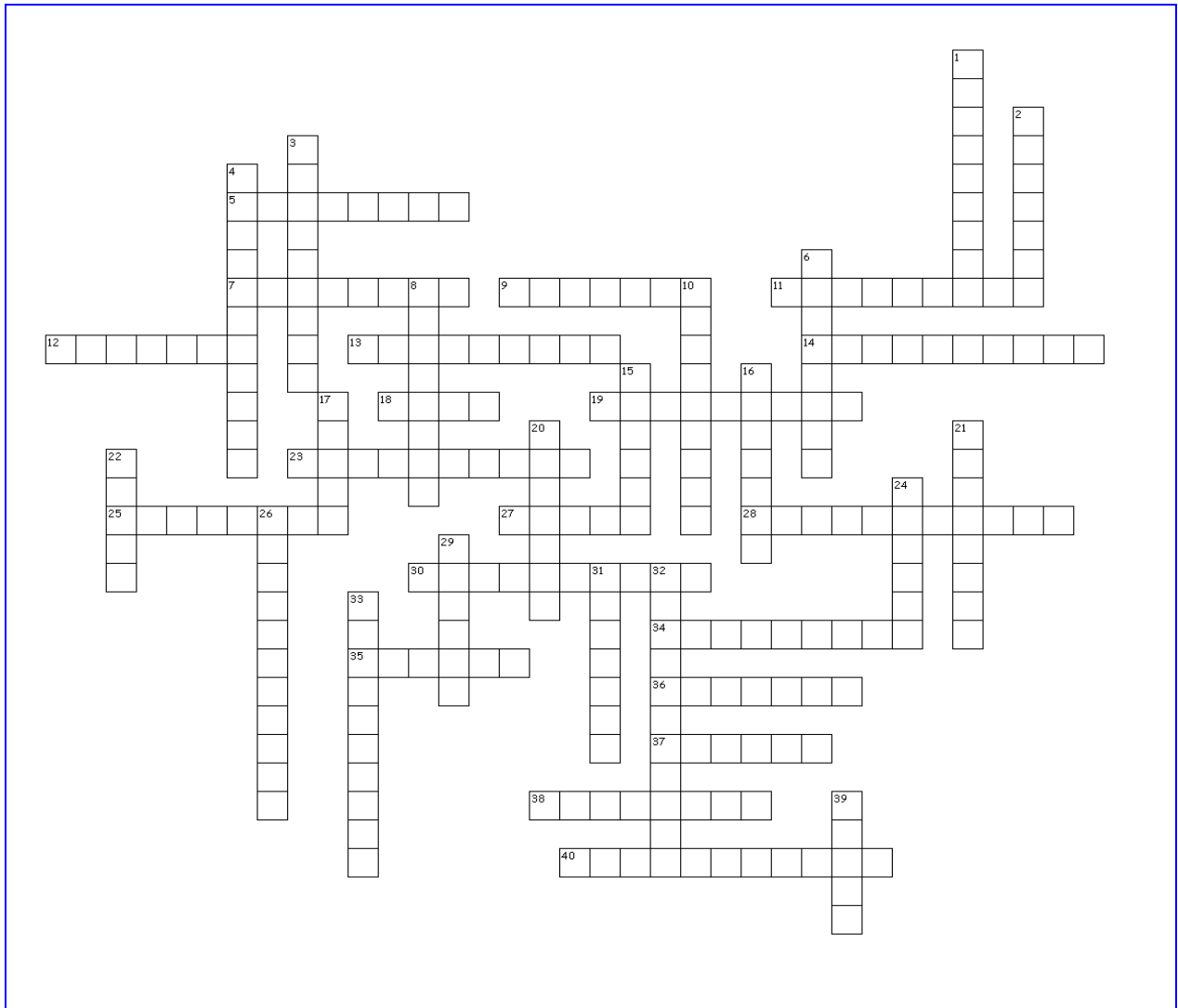

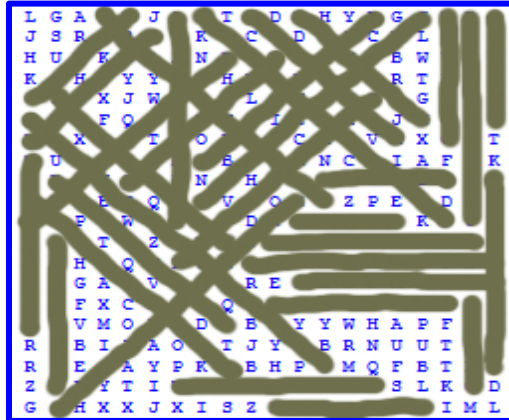
