Let's continue in our book *Desire of Ages*, Chapter #62, pages 560- 563

The fragrant gift which Mary had thought to lavish upon the dead body of the Saviour she poured upon His living form. At the burial its sweetness could only have pervaded the tomb; now it gladdened His heart with the assurance of her faith and love. Joseph of Arimathaea and Nicodemus offered not their gift of love to Jesus in His life. With bitter tears they brought their costly spices for His cold, unconscious form. The women who bore spices to the tomb found their errand in vain, for He had risen. But Mary, pouring out her love upon the Saviour while He was conscious of her devotion, was anointing Him for the burial. And as He went down into the darkness of His great trial, He carried with Him the memory of that deed, an earnest of the love that would be His from His redeemed ones forever. {DA 560.2}

Question: How did Mary's fragrant gift differ from that of Joseph of Arimathaea and Nicodemus' love upon the body of the Saviour from? Also, which earnest act of the love did He carry as He went down into the darkness of His great trial?

Answer: Mary had thought to lavish upon the dead body of the Saviour she poured upon His living form but with bitter tears they brought their costly spices for His cold, unconscious form. And, Mary's pouring out her love upon the Saviour while He was conscious of her devotion, was anointing Him for the burial.

Many there are who bring their precious gifts for the dead. As they stand about the cold, silent form, words of love are freely spoken. Tenderness, appreciation, devotion, all are lavished upon one who sees not nor hears. Had these words been spoken when the weary spirit needed them so much, when the ear could hear and the heart could feel, how precious would have been their fragrance! {DA 560.3}

Question: Who and what have been done to them who seeth not, nor heareth? Also, what would happen had these words been spoken when the weary spirit needed them so much?

Answer: Many there are who bring their precious gifts for the dead. As they stand about the cold, silent form, words of love are freely spoken. Tenderness, appreciation, devotion, all are lavished. And, how precious would have been their fragrance, when the ear could hear and the heart could feel.

Mary knew not the full significance of her deed of love. She could not answer her accusers. She could not explain why she had chosen that occasion for anointing Jesus. The Holy Spirit had planned for her, and she had obeyed His promptings. Inspiration stoops to give no reason. An unseen presence, it speaks to mind and soul, and moves the heart to action. It is its own justification. {DA 560.4}

Question: Did Mary know the full significance of her deed of love and why not? Also, how and why was this able to be done and what does the unseen presence do for us all?

Answer: No! She could not answer her accusers. She could not explain why she had chosen that occasion for anointing Jesus. And, the Holy Spirit had planned for her, and she had obeyed His promptings. An unseen presence, it speaks to mind and soul, and moves the heart to action. It is its own justification.

Christ told Mary the meaning of her act, and in this He gave her more than He had received. "In that she hath poured this ointment on My body," He said, "she did it for My burial." As the alabaster box was broken, and filled the whole house with its fragrance, so Christ was to die, His body was to be broken; but He was to rise from the tomb, and the fragrance of His life was to fill the earth. Christ "hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor." **Ephesians 5:2. {DA 560.5}**

Question: Did Christ tell Mary more than the meaning of her act? And, what precious truth was brought about as the alabaster box was broken filling the whole house with its fragrance?

Answer: Yes! And in this He gave her more than He had received. "In that she hath poured this ointment on My body," He said, "she did it for My burial." And, so Christ was to die, His body was to be broken; rise from the tomb, and the fragrance of His life was to fill the earth a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor.

“Verily I say unto you,” Christ declared, “Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.” Looking into the future, the Saviour spoke with certainty concerning His gospel. It was to be preached throughout the world. And as far as the gospel extended, Mary's gift would shed its fragrance, and hearts would be blessed through her unstudied act. Kingdoms would rise and fall; the names of monarchs and conquerors would be forgotten; but this woman's deed would be immortalized upon the pages of sacred history. Until time should be no more, that broken alabaster box would tell the story of the abundant love of God for a fallen race. {DA 563.1}

Question: What did Christ declare, after He said, “Verily I say unto you?” Also, as far as what would the act of Mary's gift shed it's fragrance in history?

Answer: “Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.” And, Kingdoms would rise and fall; the names of monarchs and conquerors would be forgotten; but this woman's deed would be immortalized upon the pages of sacred history.

Mary's act was in marked contrast with that which Judas was about to do. What a sharp lesson Christ might have given him who had dropped the seed of criticism and evil thinking into the minds of the disciples! How justly the accuser might have been accused! He who reads the motives of every heart, and understands every action, might have opened before those at the feast dark chapters in the experience of Judas. The hollow pretense on which the traitor based his words might have been laid bare; for, instead of sympathizing with the poor, he was robbing them of the money intended for their relief. Indignation might have been excited against him for his oppression of the widow, the orphan, and the hireling. But had Christ unmasked Judas, this would have been urged as a reason for the betrayal. And though charged with being a thief, Judas would have gained sympathy, even among the disciples. The Saviour reproached him not, and thus avoided giving him an excuse for his treachery. {DA 563.2}

Question: What sharp lesson might Christ have given him who had drop the seed of criticism and evil thinking into the minds of the disciples? Also, what would have happen if Christ had unmasked Judas?

Answer: He who reads the motives of every heart might have opened before those at the feast dark chapters in the experience of Judas, a traitor based his words might have been laid bare. And, this would have been urged as a reason for the betrayal and would have gained sympathy, even among the disciples.

Now is the time for God's people to show themselves true to principle. When the religion of Christ is most held in **contempt**, when His law is most despised, then should our zeal be the warmest and our courage and firmness the most **unflinching**. To stand in the defense of truth and righteousness when the majority **forsake** us, to fight the battles of the Lord when champions are few--this will be our test. At this time we must gather warmth from the coldness of others, courage from their **cowardice**, and loyalty from their treason. . . . {SD 201.3}

The Captain of our salvation will strengthen His people for the conflict in which they must engage. . . . {SD 201.4}

Now is the time when we should closely connect with God, that we may be hid when the **fierceness** of His wrath is poured upon the sons of men. {SD 201.5}

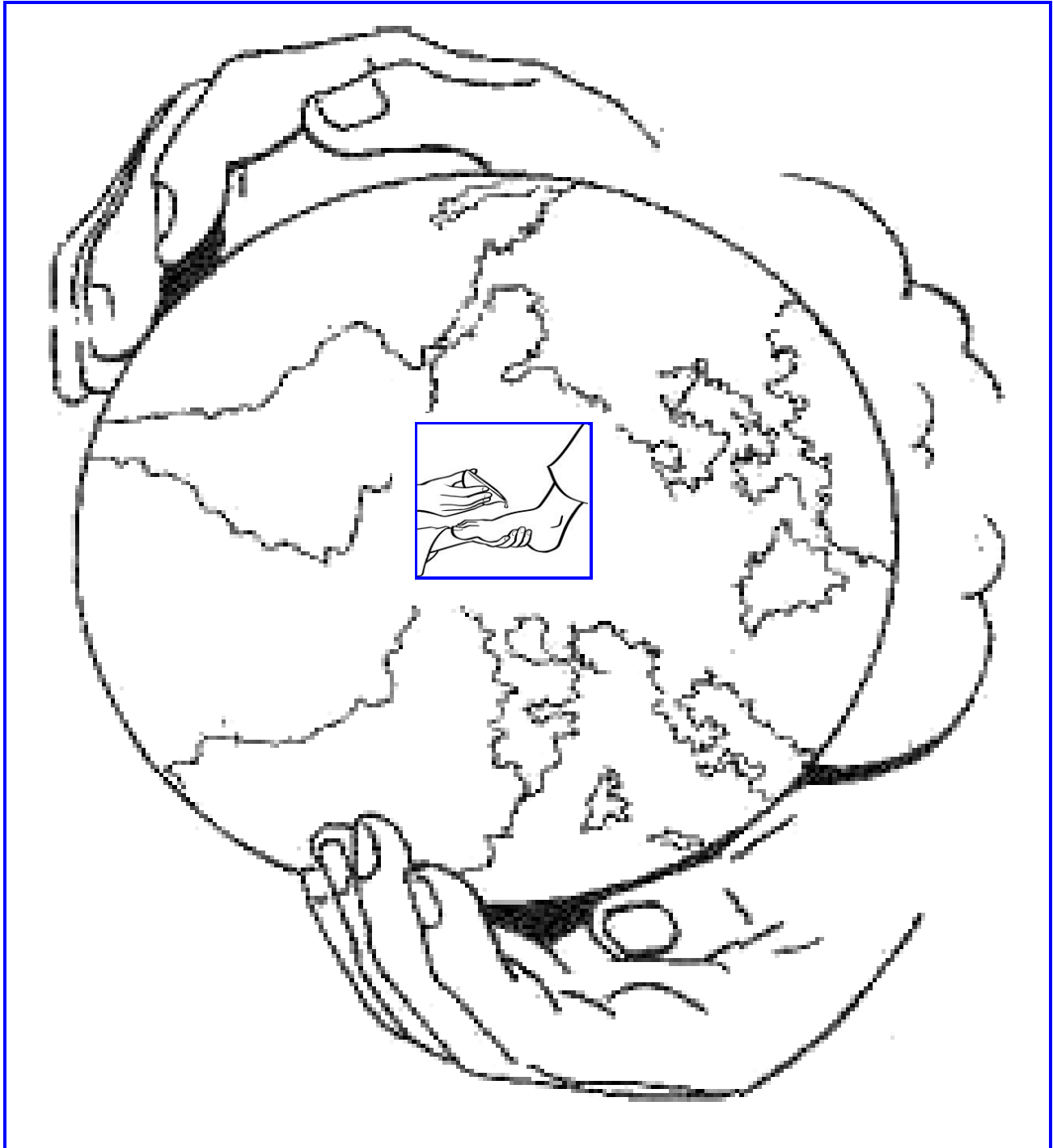
All who will gather warmth from the coldness of others, courage from their defections, and loyalty from their **treason**, will triumph with the third angel's message. {SD 201.6}

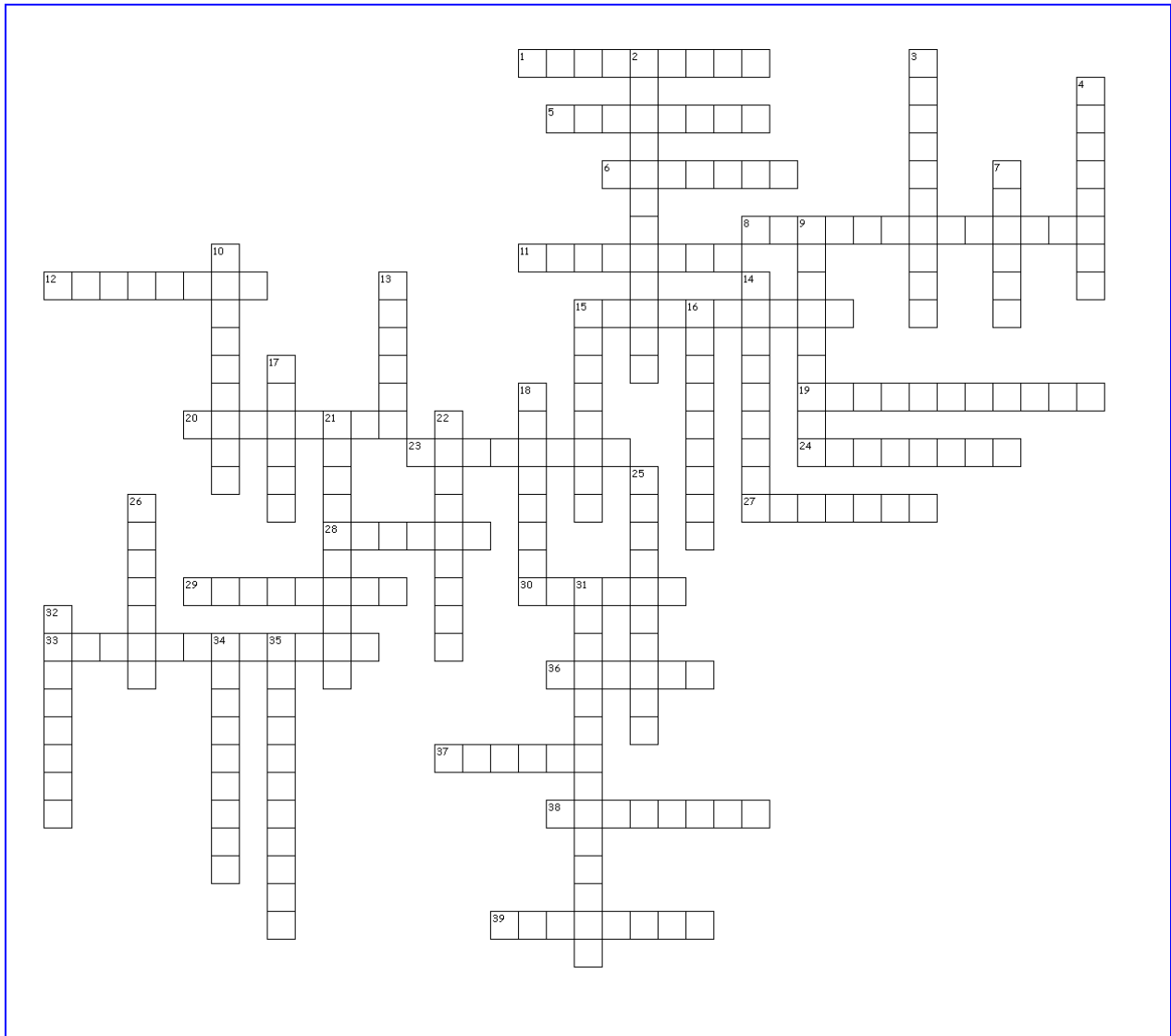

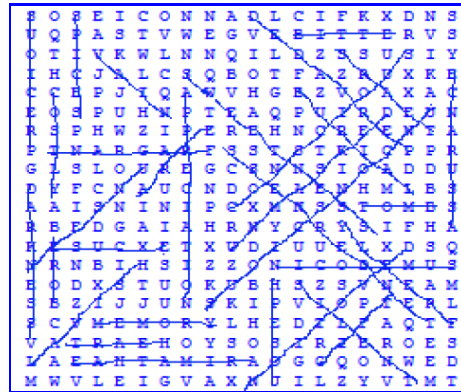
