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


Continuing:

Mary knew not the full significance of her deed of love. She could not answer her accusers.


She could not explain why she had chosen that occasion for anointing Jesus. The Holy Spirit had planned for her, and she had obeyed His promptings.

His body was to be broken;




but He was to rise from the tomb, and the fragrance of His life was to fill the earth. Christ “hath loved us,

and hath given Himself for us an


offering and a sacrifice to God




Mary's act was in marked contrast with that which Judas was about to do.



What a sharp lesson Christ might have given him who had dropped the seed of criticism and evil thinking into the minds of the disciples! How justly the accuser might have been accused!




