Let's continue in our book *Desire of Ages*, Chapter #63, pages 572-575

New accessions were made continually to the procession, and, with few exceptions, all who joined it caught the inspiration of the hour, and helped to swell the hosannas that echoed and re-echoed from hill to hill and from valley to valley. The shouts went up continually, "Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest." {DA 572.1}

Question: What happen with few exceptions after new accessions were made continually to the procession? Also, what was repeatedly shouted as it went up?

Answer: All who joined it caught the inspiration of the hour, and helped to swell the hosannas that echoed and re-echoed from hill to hill and from valley to valley. "Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest."

Never before had the world seen such a triumphal procession. It was not like that of the earth's famous conquerors. No train of mourning captives, as trophies of kingly valor, made a feature of that scene. But about the Saviour were the glorious trophies of His labors of love for sinful man. There were the captives whom He had rescued from Satan's power, praising God for their deliverance. The blind whom He had restored to sight were leading the way. The dumb whose tongues He had loosed shouted the loudest hosannas. The cripples whom He had healed bounded with joy, and were the most active in breaking the palm branches and waving them before the Saviour. Widows and orphans were exalting the name of Jesus for His works of mercy to them. The lepers whom He had cleansed spread their untainted garments in His path, and hailed Him as the King of glory. Those whom His voice had awakened from the sleep of death were in that throng. Lazarus, whose body had seen corruption in the grave, but who now rejoiced in the strength of glorious manhood, led the beast on which the Saviour rode. {DA 572.2}

Question: What was made a feature of that scene before the Saviour at His triumphal procession? Also, who were these trophies praising God for their deliverance?

Answer: About the Saviour were the glorious trophies of His labors of love for sinful man. There were the captives whom He had rescued from Satan's power: the blind, the dumb, the cripples, the lepers, Widows and orphans.

Question: Who were spreading their garments in His path and what were they shouting? Also, who were rejoicing in the strength of glorious manhood, which led the beast on which the Saviour rode?

Answer: The lepers whom He had cleansed spread their untainted garments in His path, and hailed Him as the King of glory. Those whom His voice had awakened from the sleep of death were in that throng, Lazarus, whose body had seen corruption in the grave.

Many Pharisees witnessed the scene, and, burning with envy and malice, sought to turn the current of popular feeling. With all their authority they tried to silence the people; but their appeals and threats only increased the enthusiasm. They feared that this multitude, in the strength of their numbers, would make Jesus king. As a last resort they pressed through the crowd to where the Saviour was, and accosted Him with reproving and threatening words: "Master, rebuke Thy disciples." They declared that such noisy demonstrations were unlawful, and would not be permitted by the authorities. But they were silenced by the reply of Jesus, "I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out." That scene of triumph was of God's own appointing. It had been foretold by the prophet, and man was powerless to turn aside God's purpose. Had men failed to carry out His plan, He would have given a voice to the inanimate stones, and they would have hailed His Son with acclamations of praise. As the silenced Pharisees drew back, the words of Zechariah were taken up by hundreds of voices: "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: He is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass." {DA 572.3}

Question: What were the reactions of many of the Pharisees as they sought to turn the current of popular feeling as they witnessed the scene? Also, what did they fear?

Answer: They were burning with envy and malice, with all their authority they tried to silence the people; but their appeals and threats only increased the enthusiasm. They feared that this multitude, in the strength of their numbers, would make Jesus king.

Question: What would have happened, had men failed to carry out His (God's) plan? Also, what words of spoken of Zechariah were taken up by hundreds of voices, as the silenced Pharisees drew back?

Answer: He would have given a voice to the inanimate stones, and they would have hailed His Son with acclamations of praise. "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: He is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass."

Before them lay Jerusalem in its glory, now bathed in the light of the declining sun. The temple attracted all eyes. In stately grandeur it towered above all else, seeming to point toward heaven as if directing the people to the only true and living God. The temple had long been the pride and glory of the Jewish nation. The Romans also prided themselves in its magnificence. A king appointed by the Romans had united with the Jews to rebuild and embellish it, and the emperor of Rome had enriched it with his gifts. Its strength, richness, and magnificence had made it one of the wonders of the world. {DA 575.1}

Question: Why did Jesus and the entire multitude halt, when the procession reached the brow of the hill, as they were about to descend into the city? And, why were they so captivated by the site?

Answer: Jesus with the multitude beheld before them, laid Jerusalem in its glory, now bathed in the light of the declining sun, The temple attracted all eyes. In stately grandeur it towered above all else, seeming to point toward heaven as if directing the people to the only true and living God.

Chapter 7-Two Brave Young Men Rout Philistines

And Jonathan said to the young man that bare his armour, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the Lord will work for us: for there is no restraint to the Lord to save by many or by few. 1 Samuel 14:6. {SD 208.1}

In Jonathan, the son of Saul, the Lord saw a man of pure **integrity**,-- one to whom He could draw nigh, and upon whose heart He could move. . . . {SD 208.2}

These two men gave **evidence** that they were moving under the influence and command of a more than human general. To outward appearance, their **venture** was rash, and **contrary** to all military rules. But the action of Jonathan was not done in human **rashness**. He depended not on what he and his **armor-bearer** themselves could do; he was the **instrument** that God used in behalf of His people Israel. They made their plans, and rested their cause in the hands of God. If the armies of the Philistines challenged them, they would advance. If they said, Come, they would go forward. . . . Jonathan and his armor-bearer had asked a sign of the Lord; and the challenge had come, the sign was given. These two men placed their hope in God, and went forward. It was no easy passage for the brave adventurers. They had hard climbing to reach the top. . . . {SD 208.3}

It would have been an easy matter for the Philistines to kill these two brave, daring men; but it did not enter into their minds that these two **solitary** men had come up with any **hostile intent**. The wondering men above looked on, too surprised to take in their possible object. They regarded these men as **deserters**, and permitted them to come without harm. . . . "And they fell before Jonathan; and his armor-bearer slew after him." . . . This daring work sent a **panic** through the camp. There lay the dead bodies of twenty men, and to the sight of the enemy there seemed hundreds of men prepared for war. The armies of heaven were revealed to the opposing host of the Philistines. {SD 208.4}

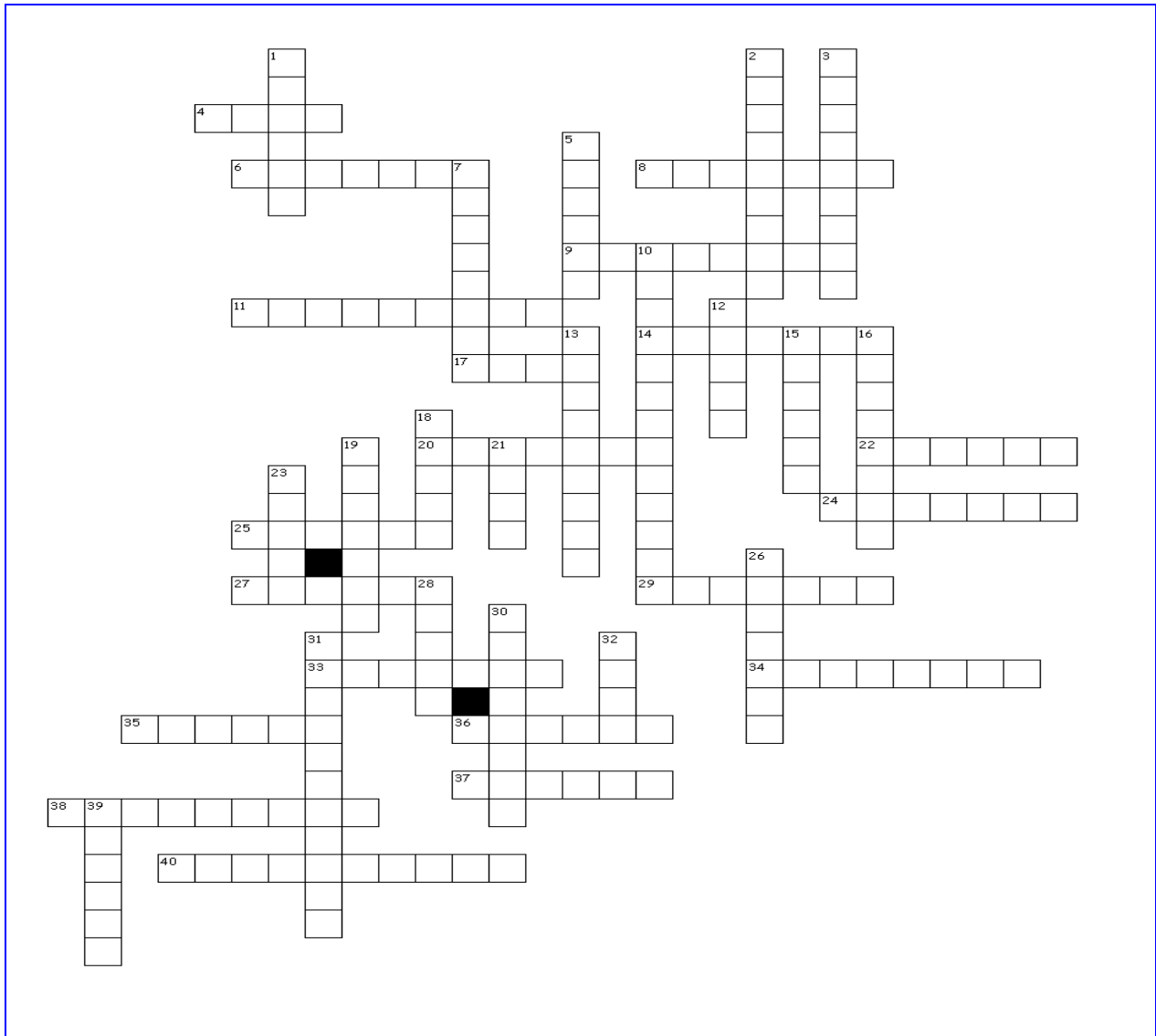

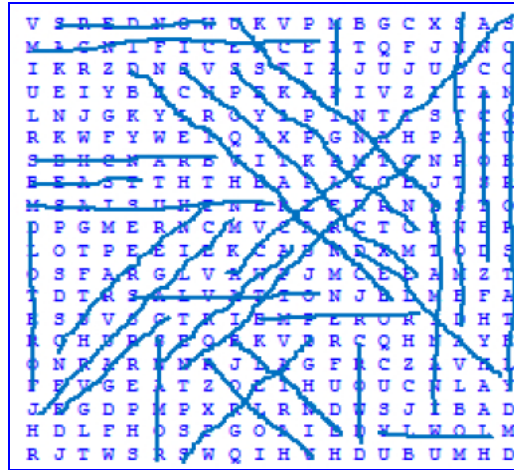
