Let's continue in our book Desire of Ages, Chapter #65, pages 600. 1-3

“To them which stumble at the word, being disobedient,” Christ is a rock of offense. But “the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner.” Like the rejected stone, Christ in His earthly mission had borne neglect and abuse. He was “despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: . . . He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.” **Isaiah 53:3**. But the time was near when He would be glorified. By the resurrection from the dead He would be declared “the Son of God with power.” **Romans 1:4**. At His second coming He would be revealed as Lord of heaven and earth. Those who were now about to crucify Him would recognize His greatness. Before the universe the rejected stone would become the head of the corner. {DA 600.1}

Question: What is Christ to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient? Also, did Christ borne neglect and abuse, in His earthly mission?

Answer: Christ is a rock of offense. He was “despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: . . . He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 53:4 through 6

Question: How near was the time for Christ to be glorified and in what event? Also, when will He be reveal as Lord of heaven and earth, and be recognized in His greatness by the ones who were about to crucify Him?

Answer: Christ would be glorified by the resurrection from the dead, He would be declared “the Son of God with power.” And, At His second coming He would be revealed, before the universe the rejected stone would become the head of the corner.

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given:

He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest:
and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

And on “whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.” The people who rejected Christ were soon to see their city and their nation destroyed. Their glory would be broken, and scattered as the dust before the wind. And what was it that destroyed the Jews? It was the rock which, had they built upon it, would have been their security. It was the goodness of God despised, the righteousness spurned, the mercy slighted. Men set themselves in opposition to God, and all that would have been their salvation was turned to their destruction. All that God ordained unto life they found to be unto death. In the Jews' crucifixion of Christ was involved the destruction of Jerusalem. The blood shed upon Calvary was the weight that sank them to ruin for this world and for the world to come. So it will be in the great final day, when judgment shall fall upon the rejecters of God's grace. Christ, their rock of offense, will then appear to them as an avenging mountain. The glory of His countenance, which to the righteous is life, will be to the wicked a consuming fire. Because of love rejected, grace despised, the sinner will be destroyed. {DA 600.2}

Question: What would the people who rejected Christ soon to see happen around them and what would happen to their glory? Also, what would have been the outcome, had they built upon the rock (**Christ Jesus**)?

Answer: They would see their city and their nation destroyed, their glory would be broken, and scattered as the dust before the wind. And, It was the rock which, had they built upon it, would have been their security.

By many illustrations and repeated warnings, Jesus showed what would be the result to the Jews of rejecting the Son of God. In these words He was addressing all in every age who refuse to receive Him as their Redeemer. Every warning is for them. The desecrated temple, the disobedient son, the false husbandmen, the contemptuous builders, have their counterpart in the experience of every sinner. Unless he repent, the doom which they foreshadowed will be his. {DA 600.3}

Question: What did Jesus show to be the result to the Jews rejection of (Him) as the Son of God, as well as to those in every age who refuse to receive Him as their Redeemer?

Answer: Every warning is for them as for all in every age in those words He was addressing, the desecrated temple, the disobedient son, the false husbandmen, the contemptuous builders, have their counterpart in the experience of every sinner. Unless he repent, the doom which they foreshadowed will be his.



Chapter 8-All Who Look to the Cross will Live

**And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass,

The Lord Jesus had protected the children of Israel from the **venomous** serpents in the **wilderness**, but this part of their history they did not know. Angels from heaven had accompanied them, and in the pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night Christ had been their **protection** through all their journeying. But they became selfish and **discontented**, and in order that they might not forget His great care over them, the Lord gave them a bitter lesson. He permitted them to be bitten by the **fiery** serpents, yet in His great mercy He did not leave them to **perish**. Moses was bidden to lift the **brazen** serpent on the pole, and make the **proclamation** that whosoever should look upon it should live. And all who looked, did live. They recovered health at once. . . . What a strange symbol of Christ was that likeness of the serpents which stung them. This **symbol** was lifted on a pole, and they were to look to it, and be healed. So Jesus was made in the likeness of sinful flesh. He came as the **sin-bearer**. . . .

The same healing, life-giving message is now sounding. It points to the uplifted Saviour upon the **shameful** tree. Those who have been bitten by that old serpent, the devil, are bidden to look and live. . . . Look alone to Jesus as your righteousness and your sacrifice. As you are justified by faith, the deadly sting of the serpent will be healed. {SD 222.3}






