For Jesus' sake all day.





And let them rule over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the **cattle**, and over all the earth.” And He did.




But, you know, this first man and woman in the world were never babies at all.




The work of redemption






The message of the Greeks, foreshadowing as it did the gathering in of the Gentiles, brought to the mind of Jesus His entire mission.






# *The Desire of Ages, p.624*

glorify His Father’s name.**






**As the voice was heard,




**Continuing:

and pronounced their doom.**



**Now God again set His seal




