

CHAPTER 3 - GOD’S CHILDREN Part 3

The love of God is manifested to the universe.





They loved the praise of men rather than the approval of God.


To save themselves from reproach and shame, they denied Christ, and rejected the offer of eternal life.





 Till saints arrive at heaven.


2) The Engine, Providence,


