

"Father who art in Heaven."


Beyond the earth, beyond the clouds,



By giving the gospel to the world it is in our power to hasten our Lord's return.



Continuing: escaped the judgments that fell upon the disobedient and unbelieving.



The word came to Noah, “Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before Me.” Noah obeyed and was saved.

THE FALL OF JERUSALEM

When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

In Matthew 24:15-22, Jesus explained what would happen before the destruction of Jerusalem and how the believers could escape. Those events would happen again during the history of the Church.

When Christians saw "Jerusalem surrounded by armies," they knew the time had come to leave Jerusalem. Luke 21:20 is the parallel text to Matthew 24:15-16, the "abomination of desolation" is explained there in the context of the destruction of



Jerusalem. **Please See: {The Great Controversy 88 30.4}**

When Vespasian rose the siege, Christians fled the city and took refuge in Pella. Therefore, no Christian died when Titus razed Jerusalem and the Temple to the ground in 70 AD.



Continuing:
So Christ's disciples were given warning of the destruction of Jerusalem. Those who watched for the sign of the coming ruin, and fled from the city, escaped the destruction. So now we are given warning of Christ's second coming and of the destruction to fall upon the world. Those who heed the warning will be saved. {DA 634.1}

Because we know not the exact time of His coming, we are commanded to watch. “Blessed are those servants, whom the Lord when He cometh shall find watching.”



