Many would be driven from their homes, and brought to poverty.



Many would be in distress through disease and privation.

“Everyone that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.”





His principles.




Through the influence of





Responsive to His tender love?


4). Oh, yes, our hearts, though hard, must feel.
