The Water of LIFE Part 4
REVIEW

Wisdom
from Above



If someone were to ask you what is the color of the ocean, chances are that you would answer that it was blue. For most of the world's oceans, your answer would be correct. Pure water is perfectly clear, of course -- but if there is a lot of water, and the water is very deep so that there are no reflections off the sea floor, the water appears as a very dark navy blue. The reason the ocean is blue is due to the absorption and scattering of light.



The blue wavelengths of light are scattered, similar to the scattering of blue light in the sky but absorption is a much larger factor than scattering for the clear ocean water. In water, absorption is strong in the red and weak in the blue, thus red light is absorbed quickly in the ocean leaving blue. Almost all sunlight that enters the ocean is absorbed, except very close to the coast.





The red, yellow, and green wavelengths of sunlight are absorbed by water molecules in the ocean. When sunlight hits the ocean, some of the light is reflected back directly but most of it penetrates the ocean surface and interacts with the water molecules that it encounters. The red, orange, yellow, and green wavelengths of light are absorbed so that the remaining light we see is composed of the shorter wavelength blues and violets.



If there are any particles suspended in the water, they will increase the scattering of light. In coastal areas, runoff from rivers, resuspension of sand and silt from the bottom by tides, waves and storms and a number of other substances can change the color of the near-shore waters. Some types of particles (in particular, the cells of phytoplankton, also referred to as algae) can also contain substances that absorb certain wavelengths of light, which alters its characteristics.



Remind

1. On nature walks near streams notice how the color of the water is affected by what is on the bottom of the stream bed. This is the way it is with the ocean in its shallower areas. White sand may give a grayish or apple-green color to the water, while the presence of rocks is often announced by the deep color which the sea takes in their vicinity.

2. When using sea salt to season food, think about how God wants Christians scattered abundantly throughout the sea of humanity. (See Matthew 5:13.)

3. When using water to wash dishes, think about how weak it is and yet how useful it is.

4. When mixing frozen juice concentrate into the **pure** water, think of how God imparts His virtues to the **pure** and simple person.





In describing to His disciples the office work of the Holy Spirit, Jesus sought to inspire them with the joy and hope that inspired His own heart.


It is the Spirit that makes effectual what has been wrought out by the world's Redeemer.




“When He [the Spirit of truth] is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment.”
