





## Chapter 5 - Child Life of Jesus, Part 2

Day by day He watched them, and tried to learn lessons from them, and to understand the reason of things. {30.7}

Holy angels were with Him, and helped Him to learn from these things about God.

Thus, as He grew in height and strength, He grew also in knowledge and wisdom. {SJ 30.8}

Every child may gain knowledge as Jesus did. We should spend our time in learning only that which is true. Falsehood and fables will do us no good. {SJ 30.9}

Only the truth is of any value, and this we may learn from God's Word and from His works.

As we study these things the angels will help us to understand. {SJ 31.1}

We shall see the wisdom and goodness of our heavenly Father.

Our minds will be strengthened, our hearts will be made pure, and we shall be more like Christ. {SJ 31.2}

Every year Joseph and Mary went up to Jerusalem, to the feast of the Passover.


When Jesus was twelve years old, they took Him with them. {SJ 31.3}

This was a pleasant journey. The people traveled on foot, or rode on oxen or asses, and it took several days to go. The distance from Nazareth to Jerusalem is about seventy miles.

From all parts of the land, and even from other countries, the people went to this feast, and those from the same place usually traveled together, in a large company. {SJ 30.7 - 31.4}

## Continuing:

The feast was held near the close of March or the beginning of April.

This was springtime in Palestine, and the whole land was bright with flowers,  
and glad with the song of birds. {SJ 31.5}

As they traveled, parents told their children of the wonderful things that God had done for Israel in ages past. And often they sang together some of the beautiful psalms of David. {SJ 31.6}

In the days of Christ the people had grown cold and formal in their service to God.  
They thought more of their own pleasure than of His goodness to them. {SJ 31.7}

But it was not so with Jesus. He loved to think about God.

As He came to the temple, He watched the priests in their work.

He bowed with the worshipers as they knelt to pray, and His voice joined in the songs of praise. {SJ 31.8}






## Nature

### Icebergs and Glaciers

Glaciers are large bodies of ice that move slowly over the land. They are found in the cold polar areas and in very high mountain valleys. They teach us that a weak nature may be turned into a strong character just as weak water is transformed into a powerful glacier.

Icebergs are made when chunks of ice break away from a glacier as it moves into the sea. They are pieces of frozen fresh water. This reminds me of people searching for truth moving away from the world towards the sea of people, called Christians; saying as the wise men, *"Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him"* (Matthew 2:2). Only those with Christian **integrity** can tell them *"...This is the way, walk ye in it..."* (Isaiah 30:21).

Icebergs are very dangerous to ships that are passing through the water. So are cold hearted Christians dangerous to their family, friends and neighbors. *"...Men cannot love God supremely and their neighbor as themselves, and be as cold as icebergs. Not only do they rob God of the love due Him, but they rob their neighbor as well. Love is a plant of heavenly growth, and it must be fostered and nourished. Affectionate hearts, truthful, loving words, will make happy families and exert an elevating influence upon all who come within the sphere of their influence."* (4 Testimonies 548)


Icebergs, white in color, are very beautiful to look at, and they form many unusual shapes. Only a part of them show as they float along. Most of an iceberg is

under the water (1/7 to 1/10 above water). This can remind us of Herod who did not show his true feelings about the young King. He made a beautiful outward appearance. Remember: "He concealed his mistrust...A tempest of wrath and fear was raging [under the surface] in his heart, but he preserved a calm exterior..." (*The Desire of Ages* 61-62)

Icebergs float calmly in a stormy sea while drift ice is battered and blown about. Icebergs are not affected by the wind and waves because they are so deeply "rooted" in the water. They move along with the deeper currents. The icebergs can remind us of the wise men who were among the sea of people but were different than most because they had deeply rooted **integrity**. They were moved by the unseen current of the Holy Spirit.



His inclination to right was a constant gratification to His parents. The questions He asked them led them to study most earnestly the great elements of **truth**. His soul-stirring words about nature and the God of nature opened and enlightened their minds.

“On the rocks and knolls about His home the eye of the Son of God often rested. He was familiar with the things of nature. He saw the sun in the heavens, the moon and the stars fulfilling their mission. With the voice of singing He welcomed the morning light. He listened to the lark caroling forth music to its God, and joined His voice with the voice of praise and thanksgiving....” (5 Bible Commentary 1116-1117)
