

Chapter 8 - The Temptation, Part 3

For sinful man He was withstanding temptation. He was to be an overcomer, that they might overcome, that they might be equal with the angels, and be worthy to be acknowledged as sons of God. {SJ 47.4}

To Satan's demand for worship, Christ answered: {SJ 47.5}

“Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.” **Matthew 4:3-10.** {SJ 47.6}

The love of the world, the lust for power, and the pride of life--everything that draws man away from the worship of God--was embraced in this great temptation of Christ. {SJ 47.7}

Satan offered Christ the world and its riches if He would pay homage to the principles of evil.

So Satan presents to us the advantages to be gained by wrongdoing. {SJ 47.8}

He whispers to us, “In order to succeed in this world, you must serve me.

Do not be too particular about truth and honesty.

Obey my counsel, and I will give you riches, honor, and happiness.” {SJ 47.9}

In obeying this counsel we are worshiping Satan instead of God.

It will bring us only misery and ruin. {SJ 47.10}

Writhing with baffled hate and rage,

Christ's victory was as complete as had been the failure of Adam. {SJ 48.4}

So we may resist temptation, and overcome Satan.




Nature Wind

The vapor forms drops of rain on the particles of dust or other foreign matter in the air (see Proverbs 8:26) forming clouds. The wind carries the clouds inland. *"The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirlleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits"* (Ecclesiastes 1:6). This verse tells us the pattern of the air movements. Air moves from the center of the earth (equator) to the poles and back again.

The Holy Spirit, like the wind moving the clouds, moved upon the heart of Jesus to warn Him of Satan's temptation, telling Him Satan did not quote all of the Bible verse. Jesus **denied Himself** and listened to the Holy Spirit. (See John 3:8.)

The wildest winds do great good by thoroughly removing poisonous gases (pollution) that hang over our big cities. These winds carry the pollution out over the ocean to be purified. The air and the ocean water are two great purifiers of the world. They remind us of the importance of the Holy Spirit and the *"Water of Life"* in purifying our lives from the poisonous atmosphere of sin.





Remind

1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.
2. Never be careless in doing your chores. Practice being careful. When using a knife to chop vegetables work carefully. Listen to the Holy Spirit's instructions. Remember how Jesus would not carelessly cast Himself down off the pinnacle to prove something to another.
3. Discuss as a family what the sin of presumption means. Explain to the child that it is not right to do such things as playing in the street because it would be "placing Himself in peril that would make it necessary for his heavenly Father to display His power to save him from danger."

Reinforce

1. Observe water!
2. In the autumn notice how the wind blows the leaves. As you rake up dead leaves remember how the wind (Holy Spirit) works. In summertime, notice how the wind blows the dandelion seeds, and other seeds about. In winter notice how the wind blows the snow.

4. Make a kite and fly it in the wind as you think about the work of the Holy Spirit.

The disciples had thought that their Master would not suffer Himself to be taken.


For the same power that had caused the mob to fall as dead men could keep them helpless, until Jesus and His companions should escape.
