



## Chapter 8 - The Temptation, Part 3

For sinful man He was withstanding temptation. He was to be an overcomer, that they might overcome, that they might be equal with the angels, and be worthy to be acknowledged as sons of God. {SJ 47.4}

To Satan's demand for worship, Christ answered: {SJ 47.5}

“Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.” **Matthew 4:3-10.** {SJ 47.6}

The love of the world, the lust for power, and the pride of life--everything that draws man away from the worship of God--was embraced in this great temptation of Christ. {SJ 47.7}

Satan offered Christ the world and its riches if He would pay homage to the principles of evil.

So Satan presents to us the advantages to be gained by wrongdoing. {SJ 47.8}

He whispers to us, “In order to succeed in this world, you must serve me.

Do not be too particular about truth and honesty.

Obey my counsel, and I will give you riches, honor, and happiness.” {SJ 47.9}

In obeying this counsel we are worshiping Satan instead of God.

It will bring us only misery and ruin. {SJ 47.10}

## Continuing:

Christ has shown us what we should do when tempted. {SJ 48.1}

When He said to Satan,

“Get thee hence,” the tempter could not resist the command. He was compelled to go. {SJ 48.2}

Writhing with baffled hate and rage,  
the rebel chief left the presence of the world's Redeemer. {SJ 48.3}

The contest was ended for the time.

Christ's victory was as complete as had been the failure of Adam. {SJ 48.4}

So we may resist temptation, and overcome Satan.

The Lord says to us, “Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.  
Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you.” James 4:7, 8.

### Chapter 13 - The Victory

“And the same would be true of asking for that which God had not promised. It would manifest distrust, and be really proving, or tempting, Him. We should not present our petitions to God to prove whether He will fulfill His word, but because He will fulfill it; not to prove that He loves us, but because He loves us.

"Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." **Hebrews 11:6. {DA 125.4}**

“Yet we should not lose courage when assailed by temptation.

Often when placed in a trying situation we doubt that the Spirit of God has been leading us. But it was the Spirit's leading that brought Jesus into the wilderness to be tempted by Satan.

When God brings us into trial, He has a purpose to accomplish for our good.

Jesus did not presume on God's promises by going unbidden into temptation, neither did He give up to despondency when temptation came upon Him. Nor should we.

"God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." He says, "Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the Most High: and call upon Me in the day of trouble:

I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify Me." **1 Corinthians 10:13; Psalm 50:14, 15.**

Jesus was victor in the second temptation, and now Satan manifests himself in his true character.

But he does not appear as a hideous monster, with cloven feet and bat's wings.

He is a mighty angel, though fallen. He avows himself the leader of rebellion {DA 129.1}

and the god of this world.” {DA 125.4 ; 129.1}

# Continuing our Reference Reading for Tiny Tot's Lesson

## REVIEW!

When the tempter offered to Christ the kingdom and glory of the world, he was proposing that Christ should yield up the real kingship of the world, and hold dominion subject to Satan.

This was the same dominion upon which the hopes of the Jews were set.

They desired the kingdom of this world. If Christ had consented to offer them such a kingdom, they would gladly have received Him. But the curse of sin, with all its woe, rested upon it.

Christ declared to the tempter, "Get thee behind Me, Satan: for it is written,

Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve." {DA 130.1}

Satan had questioned whether Jesus was the Son of God. In his summary dismissal he had proof that he could not gainsay. Divinity flashed through suffering humanity. Satan had no power to resist the command. Writhing with humiliation and rage, he was forced to withdraw from the presence of the world's Redeemer. Christ's victory was as complete as had been the failure of Adam. {DA 130.3}

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“So we may resist temptation, and force Satan to depart from us.

Jesus gained the victory through submission and faith in God, and by the apostle He says to us,

"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you." James 4:7, 8. {DA 130.4}



## Research

### Jesus Answers the Tempter

*“Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God” (Matthew 4:7).*

Jesus again **denies self** and obeys God. Not even by a thought did Jesus sin. “Christ knew that God could indeed bear Him up if He had required Him to throw Himself from the Temple. But to do this unbidden, and to experiment upon His Father’s protecting care and love, because dared by Satan to do so, would not show His strength of faith.” (*1 Selected Messages* 282-283)

*“It is written again...”*



“Satan knew that Christ’s life must be one of sorrow, hardship, and conflict.” He tried to present an easier life to Christ. Jesus once more **denied Himself** and trusted His Father in heaven.

When Satan presents temptations to us he hides the “traces of evil.” He makes the tempting path look bright and inviting, but remember, he is *“the father of lies.”*

## Remarkable Parent Food

“Satan tempted the first Adam in Eden, and Adam reasoned with the enemy, thus giving him the advantage. Satan exercised his power of hypnotism over Adam and Eve, and this power he strove to exercise over Christ. But after the word of Scripture was quoted, Satan knew that he had no chance of triumphing.” (*5 Bible Commentary* 1081)



# What is wind?

The wind is created because different parts of the surface of the earth are dissimilarly heated by the sun.

The winds are directed from the points having high barometric (high pressure) to the points with low barometric (low pressure). During this movement they are diverted to the right on the Northern hemisphere because of the rotation of the Earth (forces Coriolis)



North Hemisphere

High pressure



Direction of Wind

Low pressure

**Water condenses**

As it rises, the air cools and expands. Water vapour in the air begins to condense.

**Warm air rises**


As the Sun heats the ground, warm pockets of air begin to rise.

**Clouds form**

Tiny water droplets form, which are light enough to float in clouds.

**Cool air sinks**

The air beneath the clouds receives less heat from the Sun, so it cools and descends.

**Wind is generated**

Air flows from the cool area, where pressure is high, to the warm area, where pressure is low.




The disciples had thought that their Master would not suffer Himself to be taken.

## *Chapter 139 - Tokens of God's Love Everywhere*


