
King David prayed, “Create in me a clean heart, O God.”

Nature The Body's Water Treatment Plant

It is important to drink plenty of water each day. Sometimes people forget to drink their water just like many people forget to spend time with the "*Water of Life*." Nicodemus was spiritually thirsty, and desired that time with Jesus so he sought Him out. It is written: "*If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink*" (John 7:37).

Can you imagine what it would be like to have to drink 50 gallons of water a day? That is how much water goes through an adult's kidneys each day as the body is **cleansed** and made pure. If this water were not made pure and put back into the system you would need to replace it. There is also water lost each day from perspiration, digestion and breathing. Almost all the water is recycled (99%) in the system and only a small amount (1%) leaves the body.

In order to replace the water that leaves the body it is important that you drink a proper amount. Not more than half a glass should be drunk at one time. If the water is replaced you will have more endurance to do the things you need to do. A Christian needs to take proper time with God, then he will have more endurance to resist temptation than a non-Christian does.

Drinking water at regular times in proper amounts is the best blood **cleanser** known. Seeking God at regular times and drinking fully of the "*Water of Life*" is the best sin **cleanser** known.

It is important that the water used for drinking be soft water. Hard water irritates the kidneys and other organs. Its use over a period of time leads to certain diseases.

There was a time when people who cared for horses made sure their animals had only soft water to drink. The taste of the well-cared-for horse was so perfect in this matter as to cause him when thirsty to refuse to drink at hard water springs and go for miles until he could find soft water. The coat of a horse which drinks soft water is glossy and sleek. Those that have only hard water have a dry, half-deadened condition of their hair and skin that makes them twice as hard to groom. So hard water with too many minerals mixed in causes disease in animals as well as people.

The money changers had a spiritual disease called hard-heartedness. They were not drinking from the pure "fountain of life." They had added hard requirements to the worship of God. This created an unhealthy condition in the temple, like hard water causes an unhealthy condition in the body temple. *"Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee"* (Proverbs 30:6).

Remarkable Parent Food

"The old nature, born of blood and the will of the flesh, cannot inherit the kingdom of God. The old ways, the hereditary tendencies, the former habits, must be given up; for grace is not inherited. The new birth consists in having new motives, new tastes, new tendencies. Those who are begotten unto a new life by the Holy Spirit, have become partakers of the divine nature, and in all their habits and practices they will give evidence of their relationship to Christ. When men who claim to be Christians retain all their natural defects of character and disposition, in what does their position differ from that of the worldling? They do not appreciate the truth as a sanctifier, a refiner. They have not been born again." (6 Bible Commentary 1101)

Remind

1. As you work together as a family, let your chores remind you of your lesson.
2. As you help mother wash the clothes, scrub out the shower or tub, change baby's diaper, remember your lesson.
3. When seeing horses they can remind you to drink and use soft water.

Reinforce


1. Observe water! Find out if your water is hard or soft. If it is hard, look for inexpensive ways to get pure, soft water. A solar water distiller could be a family building project.
2. Find pictures that remind you of keeping the body **clean** with water, like washing machines, showers, glasses of water, and so forth, to put on your bulletin board.
3. Try to find something that holds ten to twenty gallons of water. Imagine that increased by 5 or 2 1/2 times. That is how much liquid that goes through your kidneys in one day.

The disciple John, upon entering the judgment hall, did not try to conceal the fact that he was a follower of Jesus. He did not mingle with the rough company who were reviling his Master.

He was not questioned, for he did not assume a false character, and thus lay himself liable to suspicion. He sought a retired corner secure from the notice of the mob, but as near Jesus as it was possible for him to be. Here he could see and hear all that took place at the trial of his Lord. {DA 711.1}

An hour had passed, when one of the servants of the high priest, being a near kinsman of the man whose ear Peter had cut off, asked him, “Did not I see thee in the garden with Him?” “Surely thou art one of them: {Next Slide Please}

At this Peter flew into a rage.

The disciples of Jesus were noted for the purity of their language, and in order fully to deceive his questioners, and justify his assumed character, Peter now denied his Master with cursing and swearing.
