



Chapter 10 - Teachings of Christ, Part 4

Continuing: “Ye are the light of the world.” **Matthew 5:14.**

Jesus was soon going away from the world to His heavenly home.

But the disciples were to teach the people of His love.

They were to be as lights among men. {SJ 62.6}

The lamp in the lighthouse, shining out in the darkness, guides the ship safely to the harbor; thus Christ's followers are to shine in this dark world, to guide men to Christ and the heavenly home. {SJ 62.7}

This is what all the followers of Christ are to do.

He calls them to work with Him in saving others. {SJ 63.1}

Such lessons were strange and new to Christ's hearers, and He repeated them many times.


At one time a lawyer came to Him with the question:

“Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?” Jesus said unto him,


“What is written in the law? how readest thou? {SJ 63.2}

So he asked Jesus:
"Who is my neighbor?"



Continuing:

“And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbor as thyself. **{SJ 63.3}**

“Thou hast answered right,” said Christ; “this do and thou shalt live.” The lawyer had not done this. He knew that he had not loved others as himself. Instead of repenting, he tried to find an excuse for his selfishness. So he asked Jesus: “Who is my neighbor?”

Luke 10:25-29. The priests and rabbis often disputed about this question.

They did not call the poor and ignorant their neighbors, and would show them no kindness.

Christ took no part in their disputes; He answered the question by a story about something that had happened a short time before. **{SJ 63.5}**

A certain man, He said, was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho.

The road was steep and rocky, and passed through a wild, lonely region.


Here the man was seized by robbers, and stripped of all that he had.

He was beaten and bruised, and left for dead. **{SJ 63.6}**






Nature The Body's Cooling System

As the body's cells work they make heat. This heat needs to be cared for at once or you would burn up. The body transfers the heat to the skin layers (epidermal and dermal). This is like a radiator on a car. There are many tiny blood capillaries in this area. The sweat glands release water; it evaporates and cools the skin, the blood, and the body. As water cools and **cleanses** the body, so Jesus' words were to accomplish a **cleansing** process in Nicodemus' life. *"That he might sanctify and **cleanse** it with the washing of water by the word"* (Ephesians 5:26).

Basic Parts of the Skin


1. Hair Shaft

Remarkable Parent Food


“The youth especially stumble over this phrase, ‘*a new heart.*’ They do not know what it means. They look for a special change to take place in their feelings. This they term conversion. Over this error thousands have stumbled to ruin, not understanding the expression, ‘*Ye must be born again.*’

“Satan leads people to think that because they have felt a rapture of feeling, they are converted. But their experience does not change. Their actions are the same as before. Their lives show no good fruit. They pray often and long, and are constantly referring to the feelings they had at such and such a time. But they do not live the new life. They are deceived. Their experience goes no deeper than feeling. They build upon the sand, and when adverse winds come, their house is swept away....

“When Jesus speaks of the new heart, He means the mind, the life, the whole being. To have a change of heart is to withdraw the affections from the world, and fasten them upon Christ. To have a new heart is to have a new mind, new purposes, new motives. What is the sign of a new heart?—a changed life. There is a daily, hourly dying to selfishness and pride.” (4 Bible Commentary 1164-1165)

Remind

Read this information.

- Water in the body helps carry waste products out of it.
- Water can take much heat before rising in temperature.
- The world's deadliest killer may be dirty water: Many diseases come from it and disease carrying insects live and breed in the water.
- Fruits and vegetables we eat are made up of mainly water: Watermelons and tomatoes are some of the wettest foods we eat.
- It takes about 400 gallons (1,500 liters) of water to grow just over two pounds (one kilogram) of dry wheat.
- When the water in your body is scarce because you are not drinking enough some of its wastes will be eliminated through your breath, causing it to be offensive.





It was in sleeping when Jesus bade him watch and pray that Peter had prepared the way for his great sin.


All the disciples, by sleeping in that critical hour, sustained a great loss.


As soon as it was day, the Sanhedrin again assembled, and again Jesus was brought into the council room.






