A Bear's Lifestyle

Bears almost always live alone and never gather in groups. Jesus almost always had a crowd around Him. People longed to hear Him teach and to be **healed**. During mating season the male and female bears stay together for about one month. They hug each other and play-wrestle. Then the male leaves and the female finds a place where her cubs can be born.



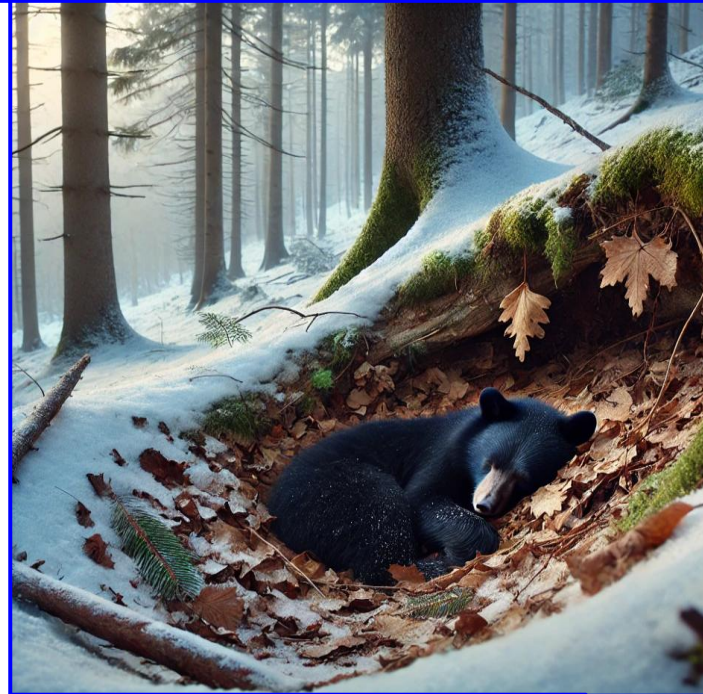
Let's learn about Polar's Bears Den!



“Coming out of the Den in Spring

- The mother polar bear along with its cubs come out of its den in the end of **March or early April**.
- By this time the cubs have grown enough to survive in the outside world. They are ready to move with their mother towards sea ice where the mother will hunt seals for the family.
- During this stage the mother teaches the cubs about survival in the Arctic.”

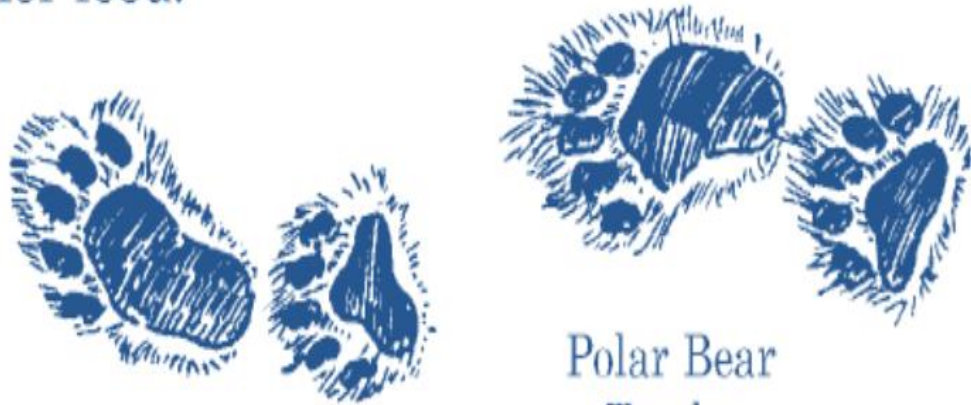
Some bears sleep most of the winter. It is like hibernation but is not true hibernation. The bears may awaken and move about, and their body temperature does not drop greatly. A bear prepares for its winter sleep by eating large amounts of food during late summer which stores fat inside its body. When food is no longer easily available the bear goes to its den. The den can be a cave, a hollow tree, a brush pile or a burrow under the roots of a tree. Unlike bears, humans are not meant to hibernate. It is not good for their health if they put a lot of fat on their bodies. *“Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand”* (Philippians 4:5).



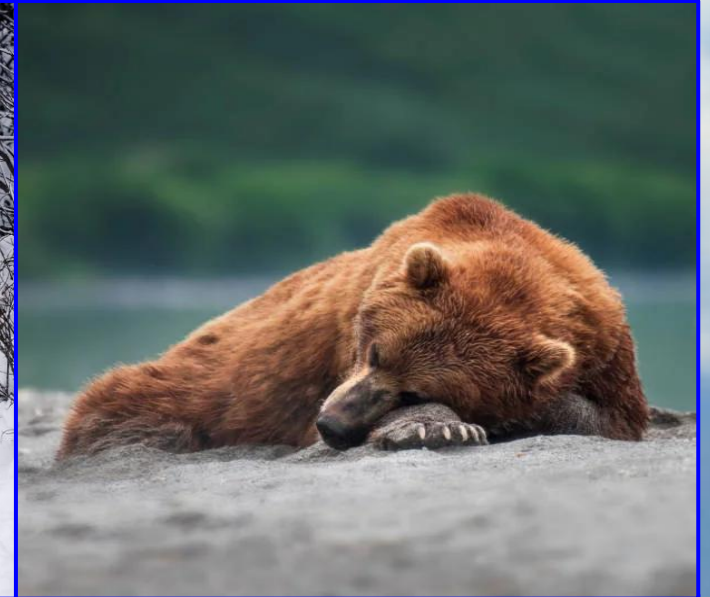

Bears that live in cold climates almost always have a time of sleep. Bears found in warmer areas only have a brief sleep, while tropical bears do not sleep at all. The polar bears are active during the winter. These bears wander in the polar ice near the open water. There they find seals and other animals that come ashore for food.



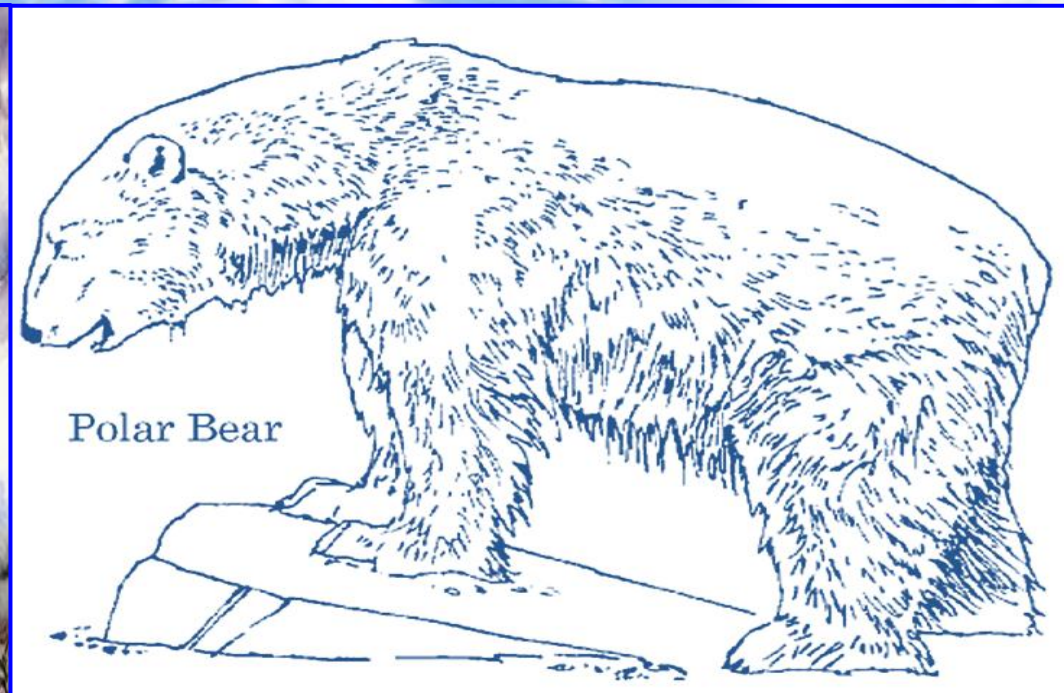
Polar Bear

Bear cubs must learn which foods are available at different seasons. They also have to learn where to find these foods and how to eat them. The bears' lives depend on proper eating habits. That is, they must eat the right kinds and the right amounts of food during each season to be properly prepared for hibernation. If they do not follow proper eating habits they would be forced to wander in search of food during months when there is none available. They would become severely malnourished or die if that was the case. It can remind us about the importance of maintaining proper spiritual eating habits. If we want to preserve our spiritual **health** we must eat God's Word regularly and store it in our minds, like a bear stores food in the form of fat. This



will prepare us for the time of trouble, a sort of spiritual winter, when we will not have an opportunity to feast on that Word, since our Bibles may be taken from us. Woe unto those who have not prepared for that day. *“Behold the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord. And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, and shall not find it”* (Amos 8:11-12).

Our First Word is, “Moderation!”

“MODERATION, n. [L. moderatio.]

1. Restraint of violent passions or indulgence of appetite. Eat and drink with moderation; indulge with moderation in pleasures and exercise.
2. Calmness of mind; equanimity; as, to bear prosperity or adversity with moderation.
3. Frugality in expenses.”

Chapter Sixty-Two - Eating to Live

“**Partake of This in Moderation.**--Parents often make a mistake by giving their children too much food. Children treated in this way will grow up dyspeptics. Moderation in the use of even good food is essential.

Parents, place before your children the amount they should eat.

Leave it not with them to eat just as much as they may feel inclined. . . . Parents, unless this point is guarded, your children will have dull perceptions. They may attend school, but they will be unable to learn as they ought; for the strength which should go to the brain is used in taking care of the extra food that burdens the stomach. Parents need to be educated to see that too much food given to children makes them feeble instead of robust.”

Our Second Word is, “Earnestness!”

“**EARNESTNESS**, n. ern'estness.

Ardor or zeal in the pursuit of any thing; eagerness; animated desire; as, to seek or ask with earnestness; to engage in a work with earnestness.

1. Anxious care; solicitude; intenseness of desire.
2. Fixed desire or attention; seriousness; as, the charge was maintained with a show of gravity and earnestness.”

Our Third Word is, “Prejudice!” Part 1

“**PREJUDICE**, n. [L. prejudicium; proe and judico.]

“A man has strong prejudices in favor of his country or his party, or the church in which he has been educated; and often our prejudices are unreasonable. A judge should disabuse himself of prejudice in favor of either party in a suit.”

PREJUDICE v.t. “To prepossess with unexamined opinions, or opinions formed without due knowledge of the facts and circumstances attending the question; to bias the mind by hasty and incorrect notions, and give it an unreasonable bent to one side or other of a cause. Suffer not any beloved study to prejudice your mind so far as to despise all other learning.

1. “To obstruct or injure by prejudices, or an undue previous bias of the mind; or to hurt; to damage; to diminish; to impair; in a very general sense. The advocate who attempts to prove too much, may prejudice his cause.”

Our Third Word is, “Prejudice!” Part 2

He lifts men from the narrow circle that their selfishness prescribes; He abolishes all territorial lines and artificial distinctions of society. He makes no difference between neighbors and strangers, friends and enemies.

He teaches us to look upon every needy soul as our neighbor and the world as our field.”

A BEAR'S LIFESTYLE, PART I

KNOW YOUR POLAR BEARS... NEED SEA ICE



Polar bears live in the Arctic and are actually marine mammals. They have adapted to a life dependent on the sea.



Polar bears can swim 50 miles per day, but they require sea ice to rest and find food.



Polar bears primary food source is seals, but they must wait for the sea ice to form to be able to hunt.



POLAR BEAR
(*Ursus maritimus*)
VULNERABLE



Despite being an apex predator, 9 out of 10 hunts are unsuccessful.



Polar bears feed almost exclusively on the calorie-rich fat of the seals they hunt.



The high calorie meals they consume out on the sea ice get polar bears through the lean summer months where they essentially live off their fat reserve until the sea ice returns.

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Climate change is shortening the sea ice season and increasing the warmer months. This reduces the time polar bears have to hunt and build up precious fat reserves. In order to save the polar bear, we must make positive changes to mitigate climate change and protect the sea ice they depend on for existence.

The Polar Bear is a marine animal that relies on sea ice to find food, mate and sometimes den.

2

Its main prey are Ringed and Bearded Seals which are rich in fat. Healthy bears sometimes only eat the calorie-rich blubber.

3

It uses its great sense of smell to locate prey. It typically stalks a seal at the seal's breathing hole, patiently waiting to attack when the seal surfaces to breathe.

4

It can eat up to 100 pounds (45 kg) in a single meal.

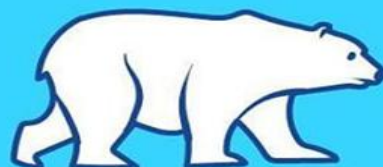

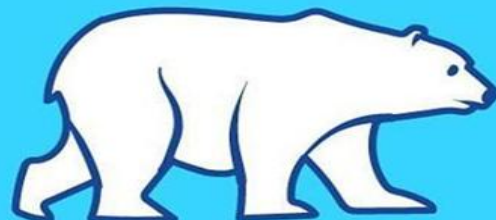

Polar Bear Life Cycle

Polar bear mothers will begin to carve out dens during the winter to prepare for the birth of their cubs.



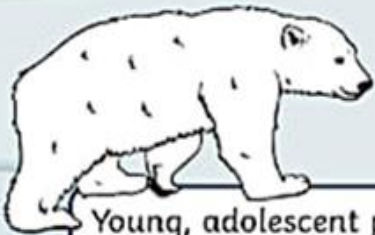
After birth, cubs stay in their den for about four months and are fed by the mother's milk. Polar bear mothers normally give birth to 2-3 cubs.



The mother will teach them how to hunt when the cubs grow and leave the den. The cubs will typically stay with their mothers for about two years.



Polar bears are considered an adult at around 3-5 years old and continue to explore and hunt for food. They have a lifespan between 20-30 years.



Young, adolescent polar bears will leave their mother in this stage and begin their own life exploring the Arctic. They will hunt and catch food independently.

“Polar Bear Life Cycle

➤ 1. What is the Life Cycle of a Polar Bear?

The life cycle of a polar bear is the series of changes that a polar bear goes through in its life.

It consists of six different stages:

- Birth
- Childhood
- Adolescence
- Adulthood
- Mating
- Death”



A BEAR'S LIFESTYLE, PART 2

Description: (i.e. In other words,/that is)

“Stage 1: Birth in Winter

In the wild, polar bears are mostly born in **December**.

The mother gives **birth 1 to 3 cubs at a time**.

Giving birth to twins is more often.

The mother along with its cub stay in the den till end of **March or start of April**.

During this period, the mother feed its cub with milk without eating and drinking anything.

The polar bear cubs when born are about **30 to 35 cm in length** i.e. **12 to 14 inches** and their weight is about one pound i.e. almost **half kilogram**.”



A BEAR'S LIFESTYLE, PART 3

“Stage 2:

- When born the cubs have short fur, no teeth and they are completely blind.
- The cubs depend upon their mother for food and heat.
- The cubs' growth is very fast due to its mother's fat rich milk (**about 31% fat**).
The mother nurse its cubs for **20 months**.”
